The ballerina's **supple** movements left the audience mesmerized.

condom

 a thin rubber or plastic sheath worn over the penis during sexual intercourse to prevent pregnancy or the transmission of sexually transmitted infections (STIs) between partners *synonym*: prophylactic, rubber, sheath

(1) condom brand, (2) safe condom use

Using a **condom** during sexual activity is one of the most effective ways to prevent unwanted pregnancies and sexually transmitted infections.

contraceptive

adj. relating to a method or object used to prevent pregnancy; serving to prevent or reduce the likelihood of conception

synonym: preventive, prophylactic, antifertility

(1) **contraceptive** measures, (2) hormonal **contraceptive** The **contraceptive** patch offers a convenient and effective method of birth control.

Catholic

- adj. universal and including many different types of things;
 related to or associated with the part of the Christian
 Church that has the Pope as its leader
- (1) **catholic** in his tastes, (2) the **Catholic** Church Sociologists are now interested in **catholic** world peace.

monk

- a member of a religious community of men living under vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience
- synonym: friar, cleric, brother
- monk lifestyle, (2) cloistered monk
 The ascetic monk spent his days in prayer and contemplation in the monastery.

sprinkler

 a device that sprays water over a large area used especially for watering crops or gardens or for firefighting

synonym: sprayer, irrigation system

road sprinkler, (2) sprinkler irrigation
 The sprinkler system kept the lawn green and healthy.

sanctity

 n. the quality of being sacred, holy, or blessed; the state of being pure, untainted, or inviolable; the ultimate importance or reverence attributed to something synonym: holiness, sacredness, purity

(1) sanctity of life, (2) violate the sanctity

The **sanctity** of human life is a fundamental principle of many religions.

vasectomy

 a surgical procedure involves cutting or blocking the vas deferens (= the tubes that carry sperm from the testicles to the urethra), which is a form of male birth control, resulting in permanent sterilization

synonym: sterilization, sterilizing operation, vas opera

- (1) **vasectomy** procedure, (2) reversible **vasectomy** Many couples choose **vasectomy** as a permanent form of contraception.
- a young boy or man, often used in an informal or affectionate way

synonym: boy, youth, youngster

microcredit

lad

n. small loans, typically less than \$50,000, given to individuals or groups, particularly those who lack access to traditional banking services, to start or expand small businesses or other income-generating activities

synonym: microfinance, microloan, small loan

The government has established a **microcredit** scheme to stimulate entrepreneurship and create job opportunities.

villager

 a person who lives in a village or small rural community;
 a person who is part of a close-knit and traditional community

synonym: resident, inhabitant, countryperson

(1) villager community, (2) local villager

The rural **villagers** were saddened by the destruction of their homes in the natural disaster.

ballroom

a large room for dancing

synonym: dance hall, assembly hall

(1) ballroom dance, (2) ballroom floor

The grand **ballroom** was filled with twirling couples and the sound of music.

airwave

 a system of transmitting sound, video, or other data through the air using radio waves or other electromagnetic waves

synonym: broadcast, transmission, radio signal

(1) walkie-talkie **airwave**, (2) commercial **airwave**The radio station broadcasts my favorite song over the **airwaves**.

chairperson

- n. the officer who presides over organization meetingssynonym: director, head, leader
- (1) vice **chairperson**, (2) the meeting elected a **chairperson**

The **chairperson** has the authority to approve or deny any request.

threefold

adj. three times as great or as many

synonym: three, triple, three times

(1) rise nearly threefold, (2) threefold increase

The price of the item was reduced **threefold** after the sale.

lifesaver

 a device or person that saves someone's life, often in an emergency or dangerous situation

synonym: rescuer, savior, protector

(1) lifesaver ring, (2) emergency lifesaver

The GPS device was a **lifesaver** when we got lost in the middle of nowhere.

afterward

adv. after the time mentioned

synonym: later, thereafter, following

(1) a few years **afterward**, (2) go there **afterward**

We will explain the countermeasure concerning this problem afterward.

gore

v. to pierce with a sharp object, causing injury or death; (noun) coagulated blood from a wound

synonym: pierce, stab, puncture

gore him with a weapon, (2) gore scene
 The hunter gored the deer with an arrow.

olympiad

- n. a period of four years, originally the time between the ancient Olympic Games and now commonly used to refer to the modern Olympic Games, which are held every four years

impair

mushroom

scot


