predominant

adj. having control, authority, or influence that is greater than that of others; prevailing or vastly more abundant than others of the same kind

synonym: cardinal, prevailing, superior

adj. enough or more than enough; having plenty of something

synonym: plentiful, rich, sufficient

carbon

- a chemical element that can be found in pure form as diamond or graphite, and it is also an essential part of coal and oil and is found in all plants and animals
