#### poisonous

# compost

(1) organic compost, (2) compost pile

You can add coffee grounds and crushed eggshells to your **compost** to improve the pH balance.

### egregious

adj. outstandingly bad or shocking; conspicuously or outrageously bad or reprehensible

synonym: atrocious, flagrant, heinous

(1) egregious claim, (2) an egregious error

It was an **egregious** mistake and caused significant harm to the company's reputation.

#### offend

- v. to cause someone to feel upset, angry, or annoyed synonym: insult, hurt, anger
- (1) **offend** his sensibilities, (2) **offend** a customer His rude comments **offended** many people at the party.

# gyre

 a circular or spiral motion, particularly a vortex or large-scale system of rotating ocean currents

synonym: spiral, vortex, whirl

(1) gyre movement, (2) subtropical gyre

The trash caught in the **gyre** in the ocean, forming a massive garbage patch.

# circulatory

- adj. relating to the system that moves blood through the body, which includes the heart, arteries, and veinssynonym: circulative, rotating
- (1) a **circulatory** disease, (2) cause **circulatory** failure shock

The **circulatory** system of the animal is also responsible for heat transportation.

# prolific

- *adj.* producing many works, results, or offspring *synonym*: productive, fertile, abundant
- prolific apple tree, (2) prolific period
   The prolific author had written over 20 books in just five years.

### styrene

a colorless, flammable liquid used in the production of resins, plastics, and synthetic rubber, which has a distinctive sweet smell and is commonly found in products like foam insulation or disposable cups (1) **styrene** monomer, (2) **styrene** production

The **styrene** foam was used as insulation to keep the house warm.

#### benzene

n. a colorless, flammable liquid hydrocarbon compound with a distinctive sweet odor; commonly used as an industrial solvent and as a starting material for the production of various chemicals

synonym: benzol, phenyl hydride

(1) **benzene** ring, (2) **benzene** molecule

Exposure to high levels of **benzene** can lead to several health issues.

# carcinogenic

adj. capable of causing cancer or promoting tumor growth; cancer-causing

synonym: cancer-causing, cancerous, malignant

(1) **carcinogenic** chemicals, (2) **carcinogenic** air pollution Long-term exposure to **carcinogenic** materials can result in serious health problems.

#### feedstock

 n. the raw material or substances that are used to make a product, particularly in industrial or manufacturing processes

*synonym*: raw material, input, supply

(1) **feedstock** supply, (2) **feedstock** procurement Corn is a common **feedstock** for ethanol production.

#### recycle

v. to sort and collect things to process them and produce valuable materials that can be used again

synonym: reclaim, reuse, reprocess

(1) **recycle** the cardboard boxes, (2) **recycle** milk packaging into new paper

We largely **recycle** the circuit board of cell phones because they contain a lot of valuable metals.

## topsoil

 the upper layer of soil that contains most of the nutrients and organic matter and is important for plant growth and cultivation; a shallow, loose layer of soil that can be easily removed or displaced by wind, water, or other factors

synonym: top layer, surface soil, humus

(1) topsoil erosion, (2) nutrient-rich topsoil

The farmer trucked in some fresh **topsoil** to improve the fertility of his fields.

# mycelium

- the vegetative part of a fungus, consisting of a mass of branching, thread-like hyphae
- (1) mycelium growth, (2) aerial mycelium

The **mycelium** of the mushroom spread through the soil, absorbing nutrients.

#### husk

 the dry, outer covering of a seed, grain, or fruit, such as the shell of a nut or the skin of a corn kernel

synonym: shell, covering, outer layer

(1) husk removal, (2) seed husk

The **husk** of the coconut was removed to reveal the fruit inside.

### chitin

 a tough, protective polysaccharide compound that forms the exoskeleton of arthropods and the cell walls of some fungi

synonym: exoskeleton material, insect shell

(1) **chitin** structure, (2) **chitin** synthesis

The lobster's **chitin-based** shell turns red when cooked due to heat-induced chemical changes.

#### mold

n. a hollow container used to give shape to liquid or soft substance, which then becomes solid in the same shape as the container; a soft, green, or gray growth that forms on stale food or objects exposed to warm, moist air for too long

synonym: cavity, cast, mildew

(1) a casting **mold**, (2) **mold** allergy

Mushrooms and **mold** are fungi.

#### industrious

adj. hardworking, diligent, and persistent in effort synonym: diligent, hardworking, assiduous

(1) **industrious** worker, (2) **industrious** student He was known to be very **industrious** and would often work late into the night.

#### insulate

v. to protect something by interposing material that prevents heat, noise, electricity, etc.

synonym: isolate, protect, seclude

(1) **insulate** the room from sound, (2) **insulate** electricity We had our bedroom **insulated** before winter came.

#### acoustics

- a branch of physics that deals with the study of mechanical waves in gases, liquids, and solids, including topics such as vibration, sound, ultrasound, and infrasound
- specialize in acoustics, (2) the engineer of acoustics
   The physicist specializes in acoustics.

# byproduct

- n. a secondary or incidental product produced in the manufacture or synthesis of something elsesynonym: side effect, spinoff, outgrowth
- (1) toxic **byproducts**, (2) **byproduct** of technology

  The **byproduct** of the energy production process is a large amount of carbon dioxide emissions.

#### buckwheat

- a plant with triangular seeds that are used to make flour and other food products; a type of grain that is often gluten-free and has a distinctive nutty flavor
- (1) **buckwheat** flour, (2) gluten-free **buckwheat**I made a delicious **buckwheat** pancake for breakfast this morning.

oat

 a species of cereal grain that seed is grown for making porridge and other dishes or being fed to animals

synonym: cereal, grain

(1) oat flour, (2) organic oat flake

Oat bran is a rich source of soluble dietary fiber.

#### pasteurize

to heat something (such as milk) to a specific ν. temperature for a set amount of time to destroy microorganisms that can cause spoilage or illness; to make something safe for consumption or use by eliminating harmful bacteria or other pathogens

synonym: sterilize, cleanse

(1) pasteurize milk, (2) pasteurize beer

It is advisable to pasteurize all homemade sauces to prevent the growth of bacteria.

#### inoculate

to introduce a vaccine into the body to produce immunity to a specific disease

synonym: vaccinate, immunize, protect

(1) **inoculate** against disease, (2) **inoculate** with a virus The doctor **inoculated** the child with a vaccine.

#### condense

to reduce the volume or size of something, often by removing water or other liquid; to make something shorter, more concise, or more concentrated

synonym: compress, compact, shorten

# lapse

#### crustacean

#### clog
