cyclone

n. a violent, rotating windstorm that forms over tropical waters and can cause extensive damage to coastal regions, also known as a hurricane or typhoon, depending on the region in which it occurs

synonym: tornado, twister, hurricane

secondly

adv. used to introduce the second point or item in a list or series of statements, considerations, etc.

synonym: in the second place, next, subsequently

opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

dowry

 property or money brought by a bride to her husband on their marriage, traditionally in some cultures

synonym: dower, portion, settlement

(1) dowry payment, (2) donate a dowry

Traditionally, a bride's **dowry** consisted of money, property, or other valuable possessions given to the groom's family.

racket

 a loud and unpleasant noise that is often repeated or sustained over a period of time; a tool or implement used in various leisure activities or sports, such as tennis or badminton

synonym: dissonance, noise, paddle

The sound of shelves crashing to the floor created a terrible **racket** in the grocery store.

extracurricular

adj. outside the regular curriculum or program of courses *synonym*: non-academic, non-curricular, outside

indefatigable

- adj. showing tireless and persistent effort; seemingly never getting tired or lacking energy, often used to describe someone who works hard and does not give up easily synonym: tireless, unwearied, inexhaustible
- (1) **indefatigable** energy, (2) an **indefatigable** pursuit Despite the long hours and difficult conditions, the rescue workers were **indefatigable** in their efforts to find survivors.

stamina

n. the physical or mental endurance and strength needed to sustain prolonged effort or activity; the ability to withstand fatigue, stress, or other challenges and continue functioning effectively

synonym: endurance, staying power, resilience

The athlete's **stamina** was tested during the grueling triathlon.

pun

 a humorous play on words or use of words that sound similar but have different meanings, often for a comedic effect; a form of wordplay

synonym: joke, quip, wordplay

The comedian's **pun** had the audience laughing out loud.

redefine

v. to change the meaning or interpretation of something; to make people think about something in a new or different way

synonym: reconsider, reformulate, alter

compassionate

adj. feeling or showing sympathy and concern for the suffering or bad luck of others

synonym: empathetic, sympathetic, merciful

indiscriminate

burglar

a person who unlawfully enters a building or other property to steal or commit another crime

synonym: thief, robber, intruder

ashram

 a secluded religious community or retreat center where people practice yoga, meditation, and other spiritual disciplines under the guidance of a teacher or guru synonym: meditation center, spiritual retreat, monastery

ombudsperson
