adj. having a negative or pessimistic attitude or outlook;lacking in enthusiasm or optimism; (noun, of music) thefirst beat, often emphasized more than the other beats

synonym: negative, pessimistic, gloomy

(1) **downbeat** mood, (2) **downbeat** figure
Her **downbeat** attitude made it difficult for others to feel optimistic.
