heap

lord

 a person who has general authority, control, or power over others; a man of noble rank or high office

synonym: master, noble, peer

The feudal **lord** had ruled the land for many years.

pillage

n. the act of looting or plundering, particularly during times of war or conflict; the theft or destruction of property or

valuables; (verb) to rob, loot, or plunder a place or area, usually in a violent and destructive way

synonym: looting, plunder, raid

(1) violent **pillage**, (2) **pillage** gold and other treasures The army's village **pillage** left the residents without food or shelter.

destroy

 to ruin or damage severely or completely; to eradicate or eliminate completely

synonym: demolish, ruin, obliterate

destroy the ecosystem, (2) destroyed evidence
 The building was destroyed in the fire and had to be rebuilt.

improvisation

 the act of making something up on the spot or creating or performing something without preparation

synonym: spontaneity, ad-lib, extemporization

(1) **improvisation** on stage, (2) jazz **improvisation** He created a beautiful piece of music using only **improvisation**.

spinning

n. the act of rotating rapidly around an axis; in the context of textiles, the process of twisting fibers together to form thread or yarn

synonym: whirling, rotating, spinning wheel

(1) **spinning** machine, (2) **spinning** wheel She took a **spinning** class at the gym to improve her cardiovascular fitness.

plat

 a map or a plan that shows the division and layout of land into lots or parcels; a piece of land typically used for building or agricultural purposes

synonym: map, chart, diagram

(1) **plat** book, (2) a former **plat** of farmland The city planning department keeps detailed **plats** of all the local properties.

procrastinate

v. to postpone doing what you should do, often because it is unpleasant or boring

synonym: delay, dawdle, hesitate

(1) **procrastinate** about a big challenge, (2) **procrastinate** on my homework

He **procrastinated** the matter until it was almost too late.

debate

n. a formal discussion or argument of opposing viewpoints, often to persuade others to adopt a specific position; a public discussion, often on an issue of current interest, in which participants offer opinions and differing perspectives

synonym: argument, discussion, dispute

(1) debate topic, (2) debate competition

The **debate** over climate change continues to be a hot topic in politics.

mate

a person's partner in marriage or romantic relationship;
 an animal's sexual partner; a peer or friend; (of the game of chess) checkmate, which is the winning condition of the game

synonym: companion, partner, spouse

(1) smoking mate, (2) dog-loving mate

I need to find a **mate** for my female guinea pig so she doesn't get lonely.

roll

v. to move in a particular direction by turning over and over or from side to side

synonym: spin, swirl, wheel

(1) roll a ball, (2) roll down his cheeks

He was exhausted and **rolled** into bed as soon as he got home.

reef

- a long chain or range of rocks or sand near the ocean's surface
- (1) barrier reef, (2) coral reefs

The vessel ran aground on a reef.

rum

 a distilled alcoholic beverage made from sugarcane or molasses, often aged and typically with a sweet, rich, or spicy flavor

synonym: liquor, spirits, alcohol

(1) rum cocktail, (2) spiced rum

The **rum** in the pina colada gave the drink its signature kick.

twin

- *n.* either of two children born at the same time from the same mother
- (1) a **twin-lens** camera, (2) a **twin** room Its **twin** brothers are difficult to tell apart except for their parents.

tattoo

 a form of body modification made by inserting ink, dyes, or pigments, either permanent or temporary, into the skin to form a design

synonym: emblem, symbol

(1) a **tattoo** artist, (2) a person who has a **tattoo**Any activity on the Internet will be stored as a digital **tattoo** for life.

bum

 a person who is homeless or lives in poverty; a lazy, shiftless, or worthless person; a beggar; a person who spends time doing nothing productive

synonym: hobo, vagrant, tramp

(1) homeless bum, (2) lazy bum

He used to be a successful businessman, but now he's a washed-up **bum** with nothing to show.

chum

 a close friend; a companion; also refers to bait used in fishing to attract fish

synonym: friend, companion, mate

(1) school chum, (2) new chum

He always had a **chum** to play with when he was a child.

relative

adj. considered and evaluated through comparison with something else

synonym: comparative, proximate, congeneric

(1) a remote **relative**, (2) **relative** factors

Most countries prohibit sexual activity between certain close relatives.

grieve

v. to feel or show great sadness or sorrow, especially for someone who has died

synonym: mourn, lament, sorrow

(1) **grieve** for loss, (2) **grieve** at the sad news

She **grieved** the loss of her parents.

crocodile

 a large, carnivorous reptile with powerful jaws and a long, scaly body; native to tropical regions and often found in rivers and freshwater habitats

synonym: alligator, gator, croc

(1) **crocodile** hide, (2) saltwater **crocodile**

The **crocodile** attack left the villagers in a state of shock and fear

sealed

adj. closed or secured with

synonym: closed, impenetrable

(1) sealed orders, (2) sealed jar

We packed and shipped the product in sealed containers.

poem

 a piece of writing that emphasizes the expression of feelings and ideas by paying particular attention to diction (sometimes rhyme), rhythm, and imagery

synonym: ballad, lyric, verse

(1) a narrative **poem**, (2) **poem** to the dead

A great **poem** is a fountain forever overflowing with the waters of wisdom and delight.

probable

adj. likely to happen or likely to be true

synonym: likely, possible, potential

(1) **probable** outcome, (2) **probable** cause of a fire It seems **probable** that he has forgotten our scheduled

meeting.

frail

adj. weak, delicate, and easily broken or worn out; lacking physical, mental, or emotional strength

synonym: weak, delicate, fragile

(1) frail body, (2) frail condition

My grandfather's health has declined, and he is now quite frail.

platinum

n. a dense, precious, silvery-white metal with the atomic number 78 and the symbol Pt that is highly resistant to corrosion and tarnishing, often used in jewelry, coins, and industrial applications

synonym: Pt, white gold

(1) platinum record, (2) platinum jewelry

The chemist worked with a **platinum** catalyst to speed up the reaction.

helmet

 a protective covering for the head, worn for safety or as part of a uniform or ceremonial dress

synonym: headgear, head protector, safety hat

(1) **helmet** size, (2) safety **helmet**

The worker survived the impact because they were wearing sturdy **helmets**.

row

- n. an arrangement of objects or people side by side in a line; (verb) to propel a boat through the water using oarssynonym: line, sequence, layer
- (1) criminal on death **row**, (2) a **row** of cherry trees He was the leader of the demonstrators and spoke out against the war in the front **row**.

thatch

 a material, such as straw or reeds, used to cover the roofs of houses or other buildings

synonym: straw, grass, reed

(1) cover with **thatch**, (2) **thatch** of hair

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The thatch roof was made from local grasses and was a

traditional design.

creed

- n. a system of beliefs or principles
- synonym: doctrine, belief, principle
- (1) political creed, (2) creed of faith

The **creed** of the organization emphasized hard work and dedication.

haunt

- v. to frequent or visit repeatedly, often in a way that is disturbing or unsettling; to occupy or fill the mind, often in a way that is unpleasant or persistent
- synonym: stalk, spook, obsess
- (1) haunt memories, (2) haunt my conscience

The crowd's boos and jeers continued to **haunt** the performer long after the show ended.

succumb

- to fail to oppose something, such as desire, pressure, or some other opposing force; to die or suffer badly from the effect of a disease or injury
- synonym: surrender, break down, die
- (1) **succumb** to cancer, (2) **succumb** to old age He finally **succumbed** to temptation.

gorgon

- in Greek mythology, a female creature with snakes for hair whose gaze turned people to stone; something or someone that causes terror or fear
- synonym: medusa, monster, demon
- (1) gorgon hair, (2) gorgon stone

After that last exam, the professor was a total **gorgon** to anyone who tried to ask for clarification.

stare

- v. to gaze or look fixedly and intently at someone or something, often in a questioning, curious, or suspicious manner; (noun) a fixed, intense, and prolonged gaze or look
- synonym: gaze, look, gawk
- (1) **stare** blankly, (2) give a menacing **stare**

He couldn't help but **stare** at the beautiful sunset over the ocean.

surrender

v. to cease resistance to an enemy or opponent and submit to their authority

synonym: yield, submit, relinquish

(1) **surrender** at discretion, (2) **surrender** an insurance policy

The enemy was forced to **surrender** after a long battle.

retreat

 n. the act of moving back or withdrawing from a position or situation; a period of rest or relaxation away from work or everyday life

synonym: escape, withdrawal, vacation

(1) **retreat** deeper into their territory, (2) **retreat** in a mountain region

Many people go on a **retreat** to recharge and reconnect with themselves.

acknowledge

v. to accept or admit the existence, reality, or truth of something; to accept that someone or something has a particular authority or quality; to express obligation, thanks, or gratitude for someone's help, commitment, etc.:

synonym: accept, agree, declare

(1) **acknowledge** the deed, (2) **acknowledge** his help He never **acknowledged** his fault.

gentle

adj. having or showing a kindly or tender nature; soft and mild

synonym: mild, delicate, soft

(1) in a **gentle** voice, (2) **gentle** downward slope Her **gentle** manner relaxed everyone there.

commerce

 the activity of buying and selling things, especially on a large scale

synonym: trade, transaction, dealings

(1) interstate **commerce**, (2) the local chamber of **commerce**

This company has invested heavily in Internet commerce.

cosmetic

adj. relating to treatment aimed at restoring or improving a person's appearance and attractiveness; (noun) a substance that you put on your face or body to enhance its appearance and make it more attractive

synonym: adoring, embellishing, ornamental

(1) minor **cosmetic** changes, (2) **cosmetic** fenders on cars **Cosmetic** surgery is becoming more common in Asia due to lowering prices.

surgeon

 a doctor who is trained to perform medical operations that involve cutting open a person's body

synonym: sawbones, doctor

(1) an excellent brain **surgeon**, (2) army **surgeon**He is a skilled **surgeon** that has many years of training and experience.

railroad

- n. metal tracks laid with rails on which trains run; a system of tracks with the trains operated by an organizationsynonym: railway, track, railway system
- (1) coast-to-coast **railroad**, (2) **railroad** industry

 The town was founded in the 19th century as a stop on the **railroad**, and it grew rapidly as a result.

stoke

- v. to add fuel to the fire or furnace; to increase the intensity or strength of something, such as an emotion or conflict synonym: stir up, fuel, ignite
- (1) **stoke** a fire, (2) **stoke** passions

The artist used bright colors and bold brushstrokes to **stoke** a sense of vibrancy in their painting.

qualm

 an uneasy feeling of doubt, uncertainty, or apprehension, often about the morality or propriety of action; a sudden fit or attack of pain or nausea synonym: unease, apprehension, doubt

(1) qualms of conscience, (2) moral qualms

The politician didn't seem to have any **qualms** about lying to his constituents.

hell

n. the place thought to be where bad people go and are punished after death, often depicted as being located beneath the earth; an extraordinarily unpleasant or difficult place

synonym: inferno, agony, misery

(1) run like hell, (2) hell broke loose

The battlefield became **hell** on earth.

weep

- v. to cry tears because of sadness, rage, or pain synonym: cry, sob, mourn
- (1) **weep** bitter tears, (2) **weep** for joy I'm easily moved to tears, so I would **weep** in sympathy if I saw that movie.

folly

 a lack of good sense or judgment; foolishness or absurdity; specifically, a costly, useless, or pointless building or project that has been created or undertaken for no practical purpose or benefit

synonym: absurdity, foolishness, irrationality

alone.

(1) economic **folly**, (2) act of **folly**It was **folly** for the hiker to climb the dangerous mountain

wage

- n. a particular amount of money that somebody earns, usually every week or every month, for work or services
 synonym: payment, compensation, salary
- (1) unpaid **wages**, (2) increase in the minimum **wage** His **wages** continued to rise as his skills improved.

vain

adj. having an excessively high opinion of oneself;
 excessively concerned with one's appearance or achievements; producing no result or effect, or being

unsuccessful

synonym: conceited, narcissistic, egotistic

(1) vain hope, (2) vain pursuit

He is in **vain** searching for a new job since he has no experience in the field.

stitch

- n. one of the tiny thread lines visible on a piece of fabric after it has been sewn
- (1) a stitch in a garment, (2) pattern stitch

The wound was so deep that it needed a surgical procedure and **stitches**.

nip

 to pinch or squeeze with the fingers or a tool; to seize suddenly or quickly; to give a small bite or pinch; to decrease or reduce the size or amount of something by a small amount

synonym: pinch, squeeze, bite

(1) **nip** a bud, (2) **nip** into the room

I need to **nip** the thread to sew this button on.

tuck

v. to push a stray piece of clothing or material into a particular area or position, especially to make it more orderly or comfortable

synonym: insert, wrap, pinch

(1) **tuck** a baby in the blanket, (2) **tuck** into another cigarette

You should **tuck** your shirt into your trousers.

crack

to break or cause to break without dividing into separate parts; (noun) a line on the surface of something along which it has separated without breaking

synonym: snap, burst, break

(1) crack an eggshell, (2) a crack in a board

He that would eat the kernel must **crack** the nut.

doom

 death, destruction, or some other terrible situation that cannot be avoided synonym: judgment, destiny, fate

(1) economic **doom**, (2) prophet of **doom**

Everyone was aware of the impending **doom** but was unable to prevent it.

foretell

womb

v. to predict or reveal something that will happen in the future

synonym: predict, prophesy, forecast

- (1) **foretell** the attack, (2) **foretell** the end of the world The fortune teller was able to **foretell** the future by reading tarot cards.
- n. the organ of a woman or female mammal in which a baby develops before birth

synonym: uterus, matrice

(1) tumor of **womb**, (2) **womb** transplant
The fertilized egg implanted itself in the **womb**.

forswear

- v. to renounce or reject something, particularly under oath or to break a promise; to give up or swear off something synonym: renounce, abandon, reject
- (1) **forswear** tobacco, (2) **forswear** his criminal lifestyle I will **forswear** all unhealthy habits and commit to a healthier lifestyle.

shrink

v. to become smaller, or to make something smaller in size or amount

synonym: decrease, diminish, shy away

(1) **shrink** the tumor, (2) **shrink** with fear

This shirt will **shrink** in the wash.

caress

v. to touch or stroke gently and affectionately; to express love or tenderness with physical contact

synonym: stroke, fondle, pet

(1) caress her hair, (2) caress his cheek

The mother gently caressed her child's forehead to soothe

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their fever.

cease

- v. to stop an action or event synonym: stop, end, terminate
- (1) cease to exist, (2) cease drinking

The company decided to **cease** production of the product.

lean

- adj. having a noticeably small amount of body fat; (verb) to bend or move from a straight to a sloping posturesynonym: skinny, slender, (verb) slant
- a lean horse, (2) lean athletic figure
 Lean operational improvements often lead to better environmental performance.

calm

adj. not excited, angry, or nervous; free from wind, large waves

synonym: quiet, peaceful, tranquility

(1) calm sea, (2) calm manner

It was the first time in a long time that I felt truly **calm** and at peace.

blessing

- a gift or favor from a higher power or force; an act or expression of approval, encouragement, or gratitude; something that brings happiness or good fortune
- synonym: favor, benediction, boon
- (1) count your **blessings**, (2) bestowed **blessings**Receiving support from his friends was a great **blessing** in his time of need.

fin

 a thin flat part on the body of a fish or other aquatic animal used for propulsion or balance

synonym: flipper, appendage, stabilizer

(1) back fin, (2) a fin of a plane

The shark's powerful **fins** allowed it to swim at high speeds.

automatically

adv. without needing a direct human control

synonym: mechanically, unconsciously, spontaneously

(1) record driving automatically, (2) automatically adjusted Our subscription plan is **automatically** renewed.

defend

to protect someone or something from attack, criticism, ν. danger, etc.

synonym: protect, guard, support

- (1) **defend** my country, (2) **defend** against a threat International law allows each nation to **defend** itself when its rights and interests are illegally violated.
- to show contempt or ridicule for someone or something ν. through a facial expression or tone of voice; (noun) a contemptuous or scornful smile or remark

synonym: mock, deride, ridicule

(1) **sneer** openly at him, (2) **sneer** hatefully She **sneered** at his attempts to impress her.

trump

- a playing card with a picture of a trumpeter on it, used in n. certain card games
- (1) trump card, (2) choose trump The **trump** suit in the game of bridge is determined at the beginning of each hand.

empire

- a group of countries ruled by one leader or government *synonym*: imperium, conglomerate, kingdom
- (1) empire building, (2) empire of the Maya He has built a thriving e-commerce **empire**.

definition

a concise explanation of the meaning of a word, phrase, or symbol

synonym: description, connotation, meaning

(1) a precise **definition**, (2) the **definition** of a word Parallel lines are, by **definition**, lines on the same plane that never cross.

sneer

bumble

v. to move or act clumsily or awkwardly; to speak or behave in an inept or confused manner

synonym: stumble, fumble, blunder

(1) **bumble** his way into a high-paying job, (2) **bumble** through his speeches

She tends to **bumble** through her work, making careless errors along the way.

bully

 a person who uses strength or power to harm or intimidate those who are weaker; (verb) to intimidate, harass, or mistreat someone weaker or less powerful

synonym: tormentor, intimidator, aggressor

(1) **bully** bystander, (2) **bully** the weak

The schoolyard **bully** terrorized the other children and made their lives miserable.

bureaucracy

 a system of government in which most of the important decisions are made by state officials rather than by elected representatives

synonym: administration, government, system

(1) government **bureaucracy**, (2) arbitrary **bureaucracy**The bumbling **bureaucracy** made it difficult to get the permits we needed.

affair

 event, situation, or subject that is significant from a political or public perspective; a secretive or illicit sexual relationship

synonym: matter, incident, fling

(1) current **affairs**, (2) domestic **affairs**Some critics say this exhibition will be a big **affair**.

infancy

- n. the state or period of being a baby or very young childsynonym: childhood, babyhood, juvenescence
- (1) infancy stage, (2) in early infancy

The technology is still in its **infancy** and has much room for improvement.

corrupt

adj. characterized by dishonest behavior or actions, often involving bribery, fraud, or the abuse of power for personal gain; morally or ethically flawed or polluted; (verb) to make someone or something morally depraved or causing it to become dishonest

synonym: dishonest, unethical, immoral

(1) **corrupt** good manners, (2) **corrupt** discipline

The **corrupt** politician was finally exposed and faced criminal charges.

dot

- n. a very small circular mark, especially one that is printedsynonym: drop, dab, fleck
- (1) connecting the **dots**, (2) **dot** blot method

The wallpaper had a pattern of pink **dots** on a white surface.

historic

- adj. famous or significant in history, or potentially so synonym: memorable, momentous, historical
- (1) **historic** accomplishment, (2) achieve the **historic** feat The Chinese people have accomplished several **historic** feats.

sin

 the offense against a religious or moral law or against God

synonym: misdeed, guilt, wrong

(1) forgive a **sin**, (2) **sin** of omission

Some overzealous environmentalists claim celebrities are committing carbon dioxide **sins**.

moderate

- adj. being within reasonable limits; not excessive or extreme synonym: average, middle-of-the-road, tempered
- (1) moderate growth, (2) moderate risk

He had a **moderate** understanding of the topic but needed further research.

pervasive

adj. spreading or existing throughout every part of a thing or place

synonym: extensive, ubiquitous, prevalent

(1) **pervasive** language, (2) the **pervasive** odor of garlic Suspicion and worry were **pervasive** in our minds.

blunt

adj. having a dull or rounded edge or point; not sharp;
 straightforward in speech or manner, often to the point of being rude or insensitive

synonym: dull, obtuse, insensitive

(1) blunt criticism, (2) blunt force

The **blunt** knife made it difficult to cut through the tough steak.

ignorant

 adj. lacking knowledge or awareness in general; uneducated or unsophisticated; unaware of certain facts or information

synonym: uninformed, uneducated, unaware

(1) **ignorant** remark, (2) blissfully **ignorant**He was **ignorant** of the fact that the meeting had been moved to a different location.

hail

v. to call out to someone to get their attention, often from a distance; to greet or welcome someone, especially with enthusiasm or admiration; (noun) precipitation in the form of small balls or lumps of ice that fall from the sky

synonym: greet, salute, welcome

(1) **hail** the victorious team with cheers, (2) **hail** forecast People in the area were forced to **hail** a taxi due to the lack of public transportation options.

reign

- n. the period of time during which a monarch or government holds power; (verb) to be the king or queensynonym: rule, governance, sovereignty
- (1) **reign** of a dictator, (2) **reign** as sovereign The dictator's **reign** was characterized by widespread human rights abuses and suppression of political opposition.

supreme

adj. highest in rank, level, or importance *synonym*: foremost, highest, greatest

(1) the **supreme** commander, (2) justice of the **supreme** court

The **supreme** pleasure of life is the conviction that we are loved.

Jovian

adj. relating to Jupiter or its characteristics synonym: Jupiter, giant planet

(1) Jovian satellites, (2) Jovian planet

The **Jovian** moon Europa is believed to have an ocean beneath its icy surface.

sorcery

 n. the use of magic, often associated with evil or supernatural powers; witchcraft

synonym: magic, witchcraft, enchantment

(1) mystical sorcery, (2) dark sorcery

He claimed that he could perform sorcery and cast spells.

profit

 money that is earned in business or by selling things after deducting the costs involved

synonym: earnings, gain, proceeds

(1) gross profit, (2) make a profit

This business yields little **profit**.

celebrity

n. someone who is well-known, particularly in the entertainment industry

synonym: figure, star, VIP

(1) baseball **celebrity**, (2) **celebrity** known worldwide

The popularity of the show made her an instant **celebrity**.

worship

v. to have or show a strong feeling of profound respect and admiration for a religious entity such as God or a god

synonym: adore, idolize

(1) worship god, (2) absolutely worship

They traditionally worship their guru.

cult

a small religious group, especially one that is not part of a larger religion and that is regarded as outside the norm; followers of an exclusive system of beliefs and practices

synonym: sect, faith, religion

(1) cult members, (2) cult's practices

The **cult** leader promised his followers that they would achieve enlightenment if they followed his teachings.

titanic

adj. of or having a great size, power, or influence; of or relating to Titanium (= a light, strong grey, lustrous, corrosion-resistant metallic element)

synonym: colossal, massive, immense

(1) titanic battle, (2) titanic compound

The **titanic** ship sank on its maiden voyage.

siren

a device that emits a loud, piercing sound, typically used n. as a warning or to get attention; historically, a creature in Greek mythology whose enchanting voice would lure sailors toward danger

synonym: alarm, warning, alert

(1) fire truck siren, (2) police siren

I heard the **siren** of an ambulance and moved my car to the side of the road.

temple

a place of worship, especially one that is associated with a particular religion or faith; the flat area on either side of the forehead

synonym: shrine, mosque, synagogue

(1) **temple** complex, (2) a tour guide at the **temple** He visited the **temple** to pray and make offerings to the gods.

the quality of being fair and reasonable and treating people equally according to their due

synonym: fairness, equity, impartiality

(1) criminal **justice**, (2) **justice** of Heaven

The judge's ruling was based on the principles of justice and

justice

fairness.

servant

 a person who performs duties for others, especially a person employed in a house on domestic duties or as a personal attendant

synonym: attendant, helper, assistant

(1) servant of God, (2) fellow servant

The faithful **servant** had been working for the family for many years and was well-trusted.

enslave

brand

v. to make someone a slave; to deprive someone of their freedom of choice or action

synonym: coerce, deprive, imprison

- (1) **enslave** poor peasants, (2) **enslave** indigenous people Her beauty **enslaved** me completely.
- a type of product, service, etc., made by a particular company and sold under a specific name; identification mark on the skin of livestock, criminals, etc., made by burning

synonym: trademark, label, symbol

(1) create a **brand** logo, (2) the **brand** of the new car There's a new **brand** of hero in the movies now.

label

 a small piece of paper, fabric, or other material attached to an object and giving information about it; (verb) to assign to a category

synonym: tag, mark, identifier

(1) a mailing **label**, (2) **label** a bag with my name The **label** on the food package lists the ingredients and nutritional information.

upstart

 a person who has recently risen to a position of power, especially one who behaves arrogantly; an ambitious or presumptuous newcomer
