## courtship

the period of time when two individuals go through the process of getting to know each other, often with the intent of forming a romantic or intimate relationship

synonym: romance, wooing, lovemaking

pup

n. a young dog, seal, or other animals

synonym: puppy, whelp, cub

icy

synonym: frosty, cold, glacial

#### mammal

- any animal of which the female gives birth to live young, not eggs, and feeds her young on milk from her own body

#### disturb

#### umbilical

## frantic

#### tuna

- a large fish of the mackerel family, found in warm seas;

## numb

adj. unable to feel physical sensation and movement; not showing human feeling or sensitivity

#### sushi

 a Japanese dish consisting of vinegared rice, often combined with fish or vegetables and sometimes wrapped in seaweed synonym: raw fish, sashimi, nigiri

#### equator

- an line of latitude that separates Earth's northern and southern hemispheres and has a radius of around 40,075 kilometers (24,901 miles)

## bycatch

#### shovel

He's utterly **obsessed** with his promotion.

#### outlaw

v. to make something illegal; (noun) a person who has committed a crime or has been legally convicted of a crime

*synonym*: ban, prohibit, (noun) bandit

(1) **outlaw** racial discrimination, (2) **outlaw** cloning of human cells

Some communities began to **outlaw** alcohol consumption.

## longline

- n. a type of fishing gear consisting of a long main line with many smaller baited lines attached to it at intervals; a type of clothing or fashion style that is distinguished by long, flowing lines and loose, comfortable shapes

**Longline** fishing gear has been criticized for its impact on marine ecosystems.

## portray

#### strobe

a device that produces a rapid series of intense flashes of light, often used in photography or entertainment; an instrument for studying the motion of a rapidly moving object by flashing a light on it at regular intervals synonym: flash, flicker

A **strobe** light lit up the party, creating a pulsing and energetic atmosphere.

#### elusive

adj. difficult to find, define, achieve, or remember synonym: mysterious, ambiguous, inapproachable

(1) an **elusive** criminal, (2) track down an **elusive** fact The physicist who found the **elusive** particle won the Nobel Prize.

#### hammerhead

- a type of hammer with a head that is wider than the handle; a type of shark with a distinctive hammer-shaped head

## solitary

adj. existing, living, or doing without others synonym: lonely, unsociable, singular

adj. relating to or characteristic of the ocean or its inhabitants; having to do with the vast expanse of saltwater that covers most of the Earth's surface

The **oceanic** waves crashed against the shore, creating a mesmerizing sight.

## pelagic

adj. relating to or inhabiting the open ocean, specifically referring to marine organisms that live or swim in the upper layers of the water column rather than close to the shore or sea floor

## mangrove

## moonlight

synonym: moonshine, moonbeam, moon glow

## lifespan

#### condominium

n. a type of real estate property in which individuals own their own living spaces, usually within a larger complex or building where common areas such as pools and hallways are shared; a type of joint ownership arrangement

## longevity

 a young bird, reptile, or fish that has emerged from its egg

synonym: nestling, fledgling, chick

#### saltwater

adj. of or connected with seawater or water containing salt; living in or found in the sea

synonym: marine, naval, maritime

(1) a saltwater fish, (2) saltwater crocodile

#### perilous

adj. involving a high degree of risk or danger; hazardous or fraught with potential harm

synonym: risky, dangerous, hazardous

#### predator

- n. an animal whose natural behavior is to prey on otherssynonym: vulture, bloodsucker

#### charismatic

## megafauna

 a term used to describe large animals that lived during the Pleistocene epoch, such as mammoths, mastodons, and saber-toothed tigers, and that are now extinct

synonym: large animals, large mammals

## entangle

scar

a mark that remains on the skin after a wound has healed

synonym: blemish, imperfection, blotch

#### lobster

 a marine crustacean with a hard, often brightly colored shell, a pair of large pincers, and a tail used for swimming

synonym: crustacean, crawfish, crayfish

nova

 a star that suddenly becomes brighter, typically because of an explosion in its interior; a sudden increase or burst of activity or growth

The astronomer spent months studying the **nova's** light spectrum to learn more about its properties.

#### autopsy

## beleaguer

## pristine

## humming
