#### meme

n. a cultural idea, value, or pattern of behavior that is passed from one generation to another by imitation rather than genetic means; (as an Internet meme) an image, a video, a piece of text, etc. that is remixed, copied, and circulated in a shared cultural experience online

synonym: buzzword, trend

### slogan

 a short, catchy phrase or motto that is used by a person, organization, or company to promote a particular product, cause, or idea

synonym: catchphrase, tagline, motto

The company spent months researching and testing different brand **slogans** before finally settling on 'Just Do It' as their new tagline.

# pathfinder

n. a person or thing that leads the way or explores new territory; someone who finds or discovers a new route or method; a person or vehicle used to navigate or explore unfamiliar or dangerous areas

synonym: trailblazer, pioneer, explorer

(1) adventurous **pathfinder**, (2) a **pathfinder** in the tech industry

The company's new **pathfinder** project explores new ways to use renewable energy.

# impenetrable

*adj.* not able to be passed through, entered, or understood *synonym*: impassable, insurmountable, impregnable

#### maze

synonym: labyrinth, puzzle, network

synonym: stimulate, incite, encourage

### tempt

synonym: entice, lure, attract

#### narrator
