## symbiosis

### nocturnal

## anomaly

unison

 occurring or corresponding together, simultaneously, or exactly; (music) two or more sounds or tones at the same pitch or in octaves

*synonym*: harmony, accord, unanimity

#### quorum

the minimum number of people required to be present at a meeting to conduct official business or make decisions; the number of individuals necessary for an organized group to function

#### virulence

the degree or intensity of a pathogen's ability to cause disease or harm; the strength or power of a negative attribute or quality

among the population.

#### toxin

a poisonous substance produced by a living organism, n. such as a plant, animal, or microorganism; a chemical compound that can cause harm or illness to a living organism

## pathogen
