### specific

#### carve

granite

 to create something by cutting wood or stone; to turn sharply

synonym: sculpt, engrave, cut

- (1) **carve** a statue, (2) **carve** my name on the plate This statue is **carved** from a single tree trunk.
- a tough, durable, and coarse-grained igneous rock often used in construction for buildings, monuments, and sculptures

*synonym*: stone, rock, boulder

The countertop was polished **granite**, giving it a sleek and modern look.

### lump

 a small, irregularly shaped mass or piece, typically of a soft substance such as coal, flour, or dough

synonym: mass, clump, ball

#### discrete

adj. separate and distinct; not continuous; individually distinguishable

synonym: separate, distinct, individual

 an advantage or something extra, such as money or goods, you receive as well as your wages for doing a

#### lexicographer

 a person who compiles or edits dictionaries, often by studying and documenting the meanings, origins, and usage of words and phrases

#### snug

adj. comfortably warm and cozy; fitting tightly and comfortably; compact and efficient in design

#### whistle

v. to make a high-pitched sound by forcing breath through a small opening, usually with the lips or fingers; (noun) a piece of equipment that forces air or steam against an edge or into a cavity and so produces a loud shrill sound

*synonym*: sound, honk, tweet

#### traffic

n. the movement of vehicles, people, or goods along a route or through a transport system; the amount of such movement in a particular place or at a particular time

#### uniform

### occupation

n. a person's job or profession; the act of taking possession

### metaphor

 a figure of speech in which an expression is used to refer to something that it does not denote to suggest a similarity

synonym: conceit, analogy, symbol

### fishery

 an area of water where fish are caught in large quantities for living; a business or practice of catching and selling fish

synonym: fishing, piscary, angling

#### marvelous

adj. causing wonder or astonishment; excellent synonym: wonderful, amazing, superb

#### creature

a living being, especially an animal synonym: being, animal, organism

(1) creature of habit, (2) artificial creature The deep sea **creature** was unlike anything the scientists had ever seen before.

### drag

- to pull or haul with force synonym: haul, pull, draw
- (1) **drag** a chair over, (2) **drag** a team down He **dragged** the heavy suitcase behind him as he walked.

### blame

- to think or say that someone or something did something wrong or is responsible for something bad synonym: condemn, rebuke, find fault with
- (1) **blame** circumstances for the failure, (2) **blame** the lack of knowledge

era

- a period that is distinct from others, typically in history synonym: epoch, age, period
- (1) dawn of a new era, (2) the era of the Renaissance Political corruption was common throughout the postwar era.

#### editorial

adj. relating to the expression of opinions or interpretations in the media

synonym: comment, opinion, critique

(1) gain editorial help, (2) an editorial article The newspaper published an editorial on the current state of the economy.

### responsible

adj. answerable or accountable for something within one's power, control, or management

synonym: accountable, answerable, liable

(1) **responsible** action, (2) **responsible** for a customer service

She's a **responsible** pet owner who ensures her dog gets enough exercise and a healthy diet.

### modernity

- n. the quality or condition of being modern; the state or era
   of being up-to-date in technology, science, and culture
   synonym: contemporaneousness, present-day, contemporaneity
- (1) spirit of **modernity**, (2) path toward **modernity**He was fascinated by the contrasts between traditional life and the city's **modernity**.

### virtually

adv. almost completely

synonym: almost, basically, nearly

(1) **virtually** all countries, (2) **virtually** identical **Virtually** all the parties signed the contract.

#### curve

 a bend or angle in a line or surface that deviates from a straight or flat path; a gradual or smooth change in direction or shape

synonym: bend, arc, turn

(1) learning curve, (2) yield curve

The **curve** in the road was so sharp that I had to slow down to navigate it safely.

### hunger

 a strong desire or craving for something; a feeling of discomfort or weakness caused by lack of food; a chronic condition of insufficient food intake and malnutrition

*synonym*: appetite, craving, starvation

(1) **hunger** pangs, (2) chronic **hunger**Many people in the world suffer from **hunger** and malnourishment every day.

strike

- v. to wallop somebody or something with the hand, fist, or weapon; to have an emotional or cognitive impact upon synonym: hit, impact, influence

#### process

n. a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

### merge

 to combine or integrate things, or to cause this to happen

### propulsion

 the act or process of propelling or driving something forward, often using a motor, engine, or other mechanical means

*synonym*: propelling, driving, actuation

### steampunk

a subgenre of science fiction or fantasy that incorporates technology and aesthetic designs inspired by
 19th-century industrial steam-powered machinery and Victorian fashion

*synonym*: retro-futurism, neo-victorianism

(1) **steampunk** fashion, (2) **steampunk** novel

The **steampunk** genre combines Victorian-era design with futuristic technology.

#### engine

 a machine that converts thermal energy to mechanical work; something that has an important role used to achieve a purpose

synonym: motor, locomotive, driver

a steam engine,
 an air-cooled engine
 the policies he announces can be the engine of economic growth in the country.

### pertain

 to be relevant or applicable to a particular subject or situation; to belong to or be connected with something

synonym: relate, concern, apply

(1) **pertain** to the case, (2) **pertain** to the topic The new regulations **pertain** to all employees, regardless of their position.

### hedgehog

n. a small, spiny mammal that rolls itself into a ball for protection when threatened; a person who is solitary, introverted, and lacks social skills, often displaying sharp or prickly behavior

synonym: porcupine, spine-fellow

(1) wild **hedgehog**, (2) **hedgehog** habitat The **hedgehog's** spines provide an effective defense mechanism against predators.

### expand

 to increase or to make something greater in size, number, or importance

synonym: extend, grow, boost

chart

 a visual display of information such as a diagram, lists of figures, etc.; a map designed to assist navigation by air or sea

synonym: diagram, graph, map

### replicate

v. to make an exact copy of something; to repeat a process or experiment to confirm the results

synonym: duplicate, imitate, reproduce

(1) replicate the cell, (2) replicate data

The experiment was **replicated** several times to ensure accuracy.

### improve

v. to make or become better

*synonym*: enhance, ameliorate, enrich

(1) **improve** a process, (2) **improve** the test score We want to **improve** ties between our two countries.

### advantage

 a condition or circumstance that puts one in a favorable or superior position; a beneficial feature or asset that someone or something has

synonym: benefit, edge, asset

(1) score an **advantage**, (2) take **advantage** of his weak points

One of the main **advantages** of the new product is its increased efficiency.

### serendipity

 n. the occurrence and development of events by chance in a happy or beneficial way; a fortunate accident or discovery

synonym: luck, chance, fortune

(1) **serendipity** moment, (2) **serendipity** discovery The discovery of penicillin was a result of **serendipity**.

#### damn

v. to express disapproval of or disappointment in something or someone; to condemn or to curse; (a swear word) an expression of anger

synonym: curse, condemn, denounce

(1) **damn** the consequences, (2) **damn** with faint praise The company's poor financial performance is likely to **damn** the CEO's chances of being re-elected to the board.

#### butt

v. to strike or push something with the flat end of your hip or buttocks; to hit or knock forcefully; (noun) the remaining end of a smoked cigarette

synonym: hit, punch, strike

#### delicious

adj. exceptionally pleasing to taste or smellsynonym: appetizing, mouthwatering, delectable

### nightclub

- n. (also "nightspot") a venue that typically operates late into the night, offering music, dancing, and drinkssynonym: discotheque, club, dance hall

#### conclude

v. to come to an end or close; to reach a judgment or opinion by reasoning

#### inexorable

 adj. describing a process or situation that is impossible to stop, prevent, or change; relentless, unyielding, or unstoppable in force or effect

synonym: relentless, implacable, unyielding

His **inexorable** determination to succeed made him a force to be reckoned with.

#### counterintuitive

*adj.* contrary to what common sense would suggest *synonym*: unreasonable, paradoxical, nonsensical

(1) counterintuitive results, (2) counterintuitive behavior

The **counterintuitive** nature of quantum physics has been a source of confusion for scientists for decades.

#### dominant

adj. more important, influential, or easy to notice than anything else of the same type

synonym: chief, predominant, prevailing

(1) achieve a **dominant** share, (2) **dominant** force Her company soon won a **dominant** market share.

### transport

- n. a system for moving people or products from one location to another using automobiles, roads, and so on synonym: shipment, transit, conveyance
- (1) **transport** facilities, (2) access to public **transport** Enhanced rail **transportation** is crucial for our business.

### prototype

- n. a first or preliminary example of something such as a device or vehicle from which other forms are developedsynonym: mock-up, precursor, model

#### artificial

adj. not natural and made by human beings; not real but produced to resemble something

synonym: synthetic, man-made, manufactured

#### constraint

 a limit or restriction on something, such as an action, behavior, or thought

synonym: limitation, restriction, bound

constraint on business activity, (2) strict time

The budget **constraint** forced them to make difficult decisions.

#### arbitrary

adj. based on chance, or individual whim rather than any reason

synonym: autocratic, dictatorial, whimsical

(1) **arbitrary** size and shape, (2) the **arbitrary** rule of a dictator

He collected data to avoid **arbitrary** decisions.

#### distinction

- n. a difference or contrast between similar things or people synonym: eminence, noteworthiness, excellence
- (1) important distinction,(2) draw a distinctionI can't see any distinction between these two concepts.

#### skew

v. to turn or place at an angle; to make biased or distorted with the result that it is not accurate, fair, normal, etc.

synonym: slant, tilt, distort

The results of the poll are **skewed** because it only surveyed a small group of people.

#### worldview

 a particular philosophy or cognitive orientation of life or conception of the world

synonym: perspective, position, viewpoint

The war between the two countries was also a battle between competing **worldviews**.

### biology

- n. the scientific study of life and the natural processes of living things
- (1) evolutionary **biology**, (2) cell and molecular **biology** In junior high school, we had to dissect a frog in **biology** class.

#### aesthetic

- adj. connected with the enjoyment or study of beauty synonym: beautiful, artistic, esthetic
- (1) aesthetic value, (2) aesthetic feeling

### judgment

 the ability to form valuable opinions and make reasonable decisions

synonym: conclusion, decision, determination

#### cute

adj. attractive, especially in a childlike or youthful way synonym: attractive, charming, adorable

(1) act cute, (2) super cute dress

#### charismatic

adj. having a strong and magnetic personality that attracts and influences others

synonym: mesmerizing, alluring, captivating

### megafauna

 a term used to describe large animals that lived during the Pleistocene epoch, such as mammoths, mastodons, and saber-toothed tigers, and that are now extinct

synonym: large animals, large mammals

(1) **megafauna** extinction, (2) **megafauna** fossils Many prehistoric **megafaunas**, such as mammoths and saber-toothed tigers, are now extinct.

### expression

n. the act of conveying thoughts, feelings, or ideas using words, facial expressions, body language, or art; a look or gesture that conveys a particular emotion or mood

synonym: statement, utterance, remark

(1) artistic **expression**, (2) **expression** of interest His facial **expression** showed a mix of surprise and confusion.

#### humble

adj. having or showing a modest or low estimate of one's quality or importance

synonym: modest, unpretentious, abject

(1) a humble cottage, (2) humble opinion

The nobler, the more **humble**.

#### tolerance

the willingness to accept or tolerate something, especially something that is different or unpleasant

synonym: acceptance, patience, forbearance

(1) religious tolerance, (2) tolerance for risk

The school's diversity program aimed to promote tolerance and understanding among the students.

#### structure

the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts

synonym: construction, architecture, establishment

(1) the structure of a machine, (2) structure and function of the brain

The organizational **structure** of start-ups is often flat and straightforward.

### writ

- a written legal order or command
- synonym: legal document, order, legal process
- (1) a writ of summons, (2) issue a writ

He was served with a writ of eviction, giving him the notice to vacate the property.

#### screwdriver

a tool used for turning screws, typically consisting of a handle and a metal rod with a flattened tip that fits into the slot on the head of a screw; a popular cocktail made with vodka and orange juice

synonym: screw, driver, wrench

(1) open the can with a **screwdriver**, (2) electric

#### screwdriver

I need a flathead **screwdriver** to tighten the loose screws on this cabinet.

### sledgehammer

*n.* a large, heavy hammer typically used for breaking up rock, concrete, or other hard materials

synonym: mallet, hammer, crusher

(1) sledgehammer blow, (2) sledgehammer workout

The construction worker violently swung the **sledgehammer**, demolishing the old wall.

#### transcend

- v. to rise above or go beyond the limits of something synonym: surpass, exceed, overcome
- (1) **transcend** boundaries, (2) **transcend** limits

  The music **transcended** cultural barriers and reached audiences globally.

#### touched

adj. affected emotionally or mentally; moved; showing a slight change or alteration

synonym: affected, moved, emotional

(1) **touched-hearted** audience, (2) emotionally **touched** by the speech

He gave a **touched** smile as he read the heartfelt message in the card from his daughter.

#### context

 the circumstances, facts, or conditions that surround a particular event, situation, or statement and that give it meaning

synonym: background, setting, environment

(1) historical context, (2) legal context

It's important to understand the **context** of a situation before making a decision.

#### connote

v. to suggest or imply something in addition to its literal or primary meaning; to imply something beyond the literal or primary meaning

*synonym*: imply, suggest, signify

(1) connote emotion, (2) connote symbolism

The word 'home' **connotes** a sense of warmth and comfort.

#### verb

- a word or phrase that describes an action, state, or experience
- complex verb, (2) an auxiliary verb
   use a singular verb if the subject is singular.

#### intersection

a point where two or more roads, lines, etc., cross each other

synonym: crossroad, junction, hub

(1) busy **intersection**, (2) the **intersection** of coordinate axes

Take a right turn at the next intersection.

#### confuse

v. to mistake one thing for another; to make somebody hard to understand

synonym: confound, obscure, disorient

(1) **confuse** the listener, (2) **confuse** fantasy with reality Her remarks **confused** the debate.

### eyeball

- the round part of the eye of a vertebrate that is usually inside the head and, therefore, cannot be seen
- (1) **eyeball** motion, (2) redness of the **eyeball** Increased **eyeball** pressure leads to the development of glaucoma.

#### congress

 a formal meeting of the representatives of different countries, constituent states, organizations, trade unions, political parties, or other groups

synonym: legislature, parliament, assembly

(1) an international **congress**, (2) peace **congress Congress** must consider this proposal in an unusual situation.

### equivalent

- n. having the same value, quality, meaning, purpose, etc.synonym: equal, counterpart, match
- (1) **equivalent** amounts, (2) **equivalent** in meaning
  The European Central Bank is Europe's **equivalent** of the

#### Federal Reserve.

#### abridge

v. to shorten or condense a book, a play, a speech, etc., while maintaining its essence

synonym: condense, shorten, abbreviate

(1) abridge a biography, (2) abridge a speech

I had to **abridge** the novel to fit it into the time allotted for the movie.

arch

 a curved structure with two supports that holds the weight of something above it, such as a bridge or the upper part of a building

synonym: turn, bow, arc

(1) the **arch** of a person's foot, (2) an **arch-shaped** stone structure

The **arch** bears the weight of the overhead bridge.

### polysemy

n. the condition of having multiple meanings or interpretations, often referring to words or symbols that can have different associated meanings in different contexts or situations

synonym: ambiguity, multiple meanings, semantic flexibility

(1) the **polysemy** of common words, (2) multiple **polysemy** The word "light" is a classic example of **polysemy** in English.

greedy

adj. having or showing an intense or insatiable desire for wealth, status, power, or food

synonym: avaricious, covetous, grasping

(1) greedy person, (2) greedy for money

His **greedy** behavior led him to steal from the company.

## badger

n. a small, burrowing mammal with short legs and a distinctive striped face; a person or thing that persistently annoys or bothers someone; (verb) to pester or harass someone persistently, typically with a series of annoying requests, questions, or demands

synonym: nuisance, annoyance

(1) **badger** territory, (2) **badger** him with questions The **badger's** thick fur and tough skin make it well-suited for digging and burrowing in rough terrain.

#### burrow

- v. to excavate a hole or make a tunnel in the ground by digging, typically for use as a dwelling of an animal synonym: tunnel, dig, excavate
- (1) **burrow** through the forest, (2) **burrow** into a mystery You can't **burrow** through solid metal.

### pleat

 a fold or crease made in cloth or paper by doubling or bending over one part of it and pressing it down; a ridge or a raised line on a surface

synonym: fold, plait, tuck

(1) pleat skirt, (2) accordion pleat

The dress had a **pleat** in the front that added some elegant detail.

#### Elizabethan

- n. pertaining to the reign of Queen Elizabeth I of England (1558-1603); relating to the culture, literature, and history of that time period
- (1) Elizabethan religious settlement, (2) Elizabethan theatre

The **Elizabethan** era is known for its rich literature and theatrical productions.

#### numb

 adj. unable to feel physical sensation and movement; not showing human feeling or sensitivity
