survey

 an investigation of the opinions, behavior, etc. of a particular group of people, made by asking people questions

synonym: study, examination, poll

punch

v. to strike someone or something with one's fist; to make a hole in something

synonym: hit, strike, slap

government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

synonym: administration, regime, state

(1) **government** bureaucracy, (2) **government** funding The federal **government** is planning to increase taxes for the next fiscal year.

agency

 an organization or business that is responsible for specific activities or services, especially when representing other organizations or businesses; the capacity or power to act or exert influence; the ability to make decisions and take action

synonym: organization, bureau, institution

ripple

 a small wave on the surface of a liquid, typically caused by an object falling into it or a slight wind
