organization

proportion

applied

disconnect

addition

government

the group of people with authority to control a country or state

synonym: administration, regime, state

warn

to make someone aware of potential danger or difficulty, particularly one that may occur in the future

synonym: alert, caution, admonish

merger

the process of two or more companies joining together n. and becoming one entity, often to improve their competitive position or achieve synergies in operations or distribution

herald

appreciate

potent

adj. having great power, influence, or effect; highly effective or influential; having the ability to cause change or produce a particular result

virgin

 a person who has never had sex; (adjective) being used or worked for the first time

Atlantic

- adj. relating to or located near the Atlantic Ocean, which is the second-largest ocean on Earth, located between the continents of North and South America to the west and Europe and Africa to the east
- (1) Atlantic breeze, (2) Atlantic salmon

The **Atlantic** hurricane season runs from June to November each year.

mischievous

 adj. causing or showing a fondness for playfully causing trouble; harmful or troublesome, especially in a playful or amusing way

engrave

metal

synonym: raise, elevate, move up

(1) **lift** sagging skin, (2) **lift** a ban on alcohol The drought **lifted** the prices of grain globally.

individual

- n. a single person or thing, as distinct from a group synonym: person, being, self
- (1) a private **individual**, (2) **individual** freedom
 As an **individual**, he had the right to make his own decisions and live his life as he saw fit.

garage

 a building or part of a building used to store a vehicle or vehicles, typically a car

synonym: carport, shed, barn

suppose

grand

mezzanine

n. an intermediate story, floor, or level between two main floors in a building; a balcony or platform that overhangs the main floor area in a theater or concert hall

funk

 a feeling of sadness or depression; a low or unenergetic mood; a type of music that combines jazz, soul, and R and B

rhythm

 a strong regular repeated pattern of sounds, words, or musical notes that are used in music, poetry, and dancing

blues

install

memorable

- adj. worth remembering or likely to be remembered, especially because of being very important or remarkable
- synonym: extraordinary, noteworthy, unforgettable
- (1) create **memorable** experiences, (2) least **memorable** song

His passionate speech makes a **memorable** impression.

renovate

v. to improve or restore something to a better or more modern condition; to revamp or update something old, outdated, or in disrepair

synonym: renew, restore, revamp

(1) **renovate** a house, (2) **renovate** an office We need to **renovate** the kitchen before moving into the new house.

doll

 a child's toy that typically represents a human figure, especially a young girl; an attractive woman; a woman who is subservient or passive

synonym: puppet, dolly, toy

The antique **doll** was worth thousands of dollars.

resemble

- v. to look like or be similar to someone or somethingsynonym: look like, be similar to
- resemble each other, (2) resemble her mother
 The brothers resemble each other in the hobby.

trivial

adj. of little value or importance

synonym: insignificant, minor, unimportant

(1) a trivial man, (2) for trivial reasons

The problem seemed **trivial** initially, but it became a significant issue.

eradicate

v. to get rid of or destroy something completely, especially something bad

synonym: destroy, eliminate, exterminate

(1) **eradicate** the deficit, (2) **eradicate** racial discrimination We are trying to **eradicate** this disease from the world.

poverty

- n. the condition of being extremely poor synonym: deprivation, destitution, poorness
- (1) **poverty** alleviation, (2) the cycle of **poverty**Many studies have investigated the relationship between **poverty** and academic achievement.

develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

fascinate

context

embarrass

encourage

v. to give someone support, confidence, or hope; to persuade someone to do or continue to do something by making it easier for them and making them believe it is a good thing to do

inoculate

 to introduce a vaccine into the body to produce immunity to a specific disease

economics

 the branch of social science that deals with the production, consumption, and transfer of goods and services

synonym: social science, finance, business

moth

- an insect with wings similar to a butterfly that travels at night and is attracted to light
- (1) moth larva, (2) moth attracted to the light

confidence

secondly

incentivize

v. to make someone want to do in a particular way by offering them a reward

synonym: encourage, motivate

lentil

 a small, flat, round legume that is cooked and often used in soups, stews, salads, and other dishes, and which is a good source of protein, iron, and other nutrients

synonym: pulse, legume, bean

participate

v. to take part in something

confident

crack

v. to break or cause to break without dividing into separate parts; (noun) a line on the surface of something along which it has separated without breaking

synonym: snap, burst, break

aggrandize

v. to make someone or something appear more important, powerful, or successful than they are; to exaggerate or embellish someone or something's achievements, reputation, or status

synonym: augment, enhance, magnify

The CEO is trying to **aggrandize** his power by buying out rival companies.

attach

uncomfortable

adj. providing or feeling physical discomfort or slight pain synonym: comfortless, discomforting, painful

immense

terminal

syndrome
