synonym: health, disease, treatment

adj. showing unaffected simplicity and lack of experience, wisdom, or judgment

insure

- v. to provide coverage in the event of loss or damagesynonym: protect, guard, safeguard

angioplasty

a medical procedure used to widen or unblock narrowed or obstructed blood vessels, especially arteries, typically involving the insertion of a thin tube (catheter) into the affected area and the inflation of a balloon to reopen the vessel or the placement of a stent to keep the vessel open

synonym: stent placement, vascular intervention

nonprofit

adj. not established for commercial profit

- adv. in a way that relates to the practice of medicine and the treatment of illness and injury

slide

motto

synonym: slogan, catchphrase, phrase

epidemic

 n. the widespread outbreak of a particular disease in a large number of people at the same time

synonym: outbreak, contagion, plague

(1) a worldwide **epidemic**, (2) health **epidemic**The disease is now reaching **epidemic** proportions in our country.

obesity

n. the condition of being significantly overweight, typically defined as having a body mass index (BMI) of 30 or greater.

synonym: overweight, corpulence, fattiness

loneliness

 a state or feeling of being unhappy because you have no connection with other people

 a mental condition in which a person feels very unhappy and without hope for the future; a severe recession in an economy or market

cigarette

 a small cylindrical roll of finely cut tobacco leaves wrapped in paper for smoking

erectile

adj. characterized by the ability to become physically erect, particularly in sexual function

synonym: raised, standing, cavernous

dysfunction

 a problem or fault in a system, organism, or part of the body or machine
