synonym: earth, world, globe

#### astronaut

 a person trained by a space agency to travel outside the Earth's atmosphere

synonym: spaceman, cosmonaut

#### fiddle

v. to continuously touch or manipulate something with someone's hands, mainly when bored or nervous; to act dishonestly to try to get money, information, etc., or gain an advantage

synonym: tinker, diddle, play

(1) **fiddle** with a PC, (2) **fiddle** away the whole afternoon She was able to **fiddle** a free trip to the United States.

## synthesizer

 an electronic musical instrument that generates audio signals and is used to create a wide range of sounds, from imitations of traditional instruments to entirely new sounds

synonym: sampler, sequencer, module

(1) synthesizer bass, (2) music synthesizer

The electronic **synthesizer** created a range of unique sounds for the music.

#### **furnace**

 an enclosed chamber for heating metal or glass to very high temperatures *synonym*: incinerator

(1) electrical furnace, (2) gas-fired furnace In the **furnace**, the metal gleamed with radiance.

dazzle

to cause someone to lose clear vision temporarily, ν. especially from bright light; to amaze or bewilder somebody with your brilliant wit, intellect, beauty, skill, etc.

synonym: sparkle, flash, astonish

- (1) dazzle his eyes, (2) dazzle all who see it The audience was **dazzled** by her realistic acting.

synonym: gemstone, jewel, precious stone
