# quotation

 a group of words taken from a text or speech and repeated by someone other than the original author or speaker

synonym: excerpt, passage, quote

(1) double **quotation** marks, (2) take a **quotation** He included a **quotation** from the book in his essay.

### separate

- v. to force, take, or pull apart; mark as different synonym: disunite, isolate, ramify
- (1) **separate** video into chapter, (2) **separate** cream from milk

We need to **separate** the aspect of his personality from the part of his competence when making an investment decision.

# optical

adj. of or relating to or light or the ability to see; (noun) the science of light and vision, and to instruments and techniques used in the study and application of light

synonym: visual, ocular

(1) new optical glasses, (2) optical fiber

The **optical** illusion made it appear like the building was floating in midair.

### delusion

*n.* a false belief or impression that is firmly held despite evidence to the contrary

*synonym*: hallucination, illusion, fantasy

(1) grand **delusion**, (2) labor under a **delusion** He had a **delusion** that he was a millionaire.

### conscious

adj. being aware of and able to respond to what is happening around you

synonym: aware, cognizant, deliberate

(1) **conscious** effort, (2) **conscious** of having succeeded He became **conscious** that he was being followed.

### restrict

- v. to limit someone's actions or movements, or to limit something to lessen its size or prevent it from increasing synonym: limit, confine, hinder
- (1) **restrict** an Internet access, (2) **restrict** the use of this parking lot

We **restrict** the number of students per course to twenty.

### desire

- n. a strong feeling of wanting to have or do somethingsynonym: ambition, appetite, greed
- (1) unsatisfied **desire**, (2) fleshly **desire**Low sexual **desire** typically correlates with low testosterone levels.

### affection

n. a feeling of fondness, love, or attachment towards someone or something; a gentle or tender feeling; often used to describe a warm or caring relationship between individuals

synonym: love, fondness, tenderness

(1) deep affection, (2) show affection

Her unwavering **affection** for animals led her to become a veterinarian.

### widen

 to become or make something broader, wider, more extensive

synonym: broaden, enlarge, extend

(1) **widen** in excitement, (2) **widen** a narrowed heart valve He **widened** his investigation into a medical clinic.

# compassion

 a strong feeling of sympathy and sadness for another's suffering or bad luck

synonym: pity, empathy, understanding

(1) feel **compassion** for the poor, (2) have **compassion** toward the accident

His infinite love and **compassion** for everyone never weary.

#### embrace

v. to accept something willingly and enthusiastically; (noun) the act of clasping another person in the arms as in greeting or affection

synonym: grasp, hold tightly, accept

(1) **embrace** an opportunity, (2) a warm **embrace** The woods **embrace** the house.

### creature

- n. a living being, especially an animalsynonym: being, animal, organism
- (1) creature of habit, (2) artificial creature

The deep sea **creature** was unlike anything the scientists had ever seen before.

# insight

 the ability to gain an accurate and deep understanding of people or situations; an accurate and deep understanding of what something is like

synonym: wisdom, discernment, understanding

(1) a profound **insight**, (2) share my **insights** 

We gained various **insights** by analyzing the vast amount of data owned by the company.

# uncanny

adj. strange or mysterious, often in a way that is unsettling synonym: arcane, astonishing, eerie

(1) in an **uncanny** manner, (2) **uncanny** resemblance She has an **uncanny** sense of who is telling a lie.

# psychology

- n. the scientific study of mind and behavior
- (1) **psychology** experiment, (2) **psychology** of crowd She had a master's degree in **psychology**.

### wherein

adv. in or during which; in the place, time, or situation that

(1) progress to a level **wherein**, (2) **wherein** he is mistaken The court ruled in favor of the plaintiff, **wherein** they were awarded damages for the defendant's negligence.

### define

 to state or explain precisely the nature, scope, or meaning of something

synonym: characterize, depict, express

(1) **define** a word, (2) **define** my position

To advance this discussion, we must **define** "success" rigorously.

# sensitivity

 the ability to perceive or respond to subtle differences or changes; the ability to understand and respond to the needs and feelings of others

synonym: alertness, attentiveness, sympathy

(1) **sensitivity** analysis, (2) become full of **sensitivity** The instrument has a high **sensitivity** to temperature changes.

### suffer

v. to experience pain, distress, or hardship; to undergo or endure something painful or unpleasant

synonym: endure, undergo, tolerate

(1) suffer a setback, (2) suffer bad grades

The older man **suffers** from arthritis and finds it difficult to move around.

# corresponding

adj. similar to, connected with, or accompanying something, especially in position or purpose

synonym: matching, equivalent, analogous

(1) find a **corresponding** lack, (2) the **corresponding** word in Spanish

The **corresponding** number on the dial was 3.

### oppose

v. to be against or in conflict with something or someone; to resist or to try to prevent something from happening

*synonym*: match, resist, confront

(1) **oppose** a decision, (2) publicly **oppose** 

I strongly **oppose** the new proposed law that would harm our environment.

#### selfish

adj. concerned primarily with one's profit or pleasure without regard for others; forming or arising from a person's self or interest

synonym: egocentric, self-centered, narcissistic

(1) **selfish** motive, (2) **selfish** desire

His **selfish** ambition caused him to step on others to climb the corporate ladder.

### indicate

v. to show, point out, or make known something, often through a sign or a symbol; to suggest or imply something without stating it directly

synonym: hint, suggest, show

(1) indicate a preference, (2) indicate an error

The data **indicates** that the company's profits have steadily increased over the past quarter.

# cycle

an interval during which a recurring sequence of events occurs; a bicycle or motorcycle

synonym: revolution, rotation, bike

(1) the **cycle** of the seasons, (2) go to the workplace by **cycle** 

The food chain causes a material cycle.

# helpless

adj. unable to take care of oneself or to do things without help

synonym: defenseless, powerless, susceptible

(1) **helpless** baby, (2) **helpless** victims

I feel so **helpless** without you.

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# compassionate

adj. feeling or showing sympathy and concern for the suffering or bad luck of others

synonym: empathetic, sympathetic, merciful

(1) a **compassionate** heart, (2) **compassionate** leave My father has a serious and **compassionate** personality.

# implicit

adj. suggested but not directly expressed synonym: implied, unstated, hinted

(1) **implicit** bias, (2) give **implicit** consent The **implicit** meaning behind his words was clear, even though he did not explicitly say it.

### statistics

- the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data
- (1) **statistics** for cancer, (2) official **statistics**The **statistics** demonstrate that poverty and unemployment are genuine problems.

# overwhelm

- v. to defeat someone or something by using a great deal of force; to have a strong emotional effect on somebodysynonym: conquer, crush, dominate
- (1) he was **overwhelmed** with gratitude, (2) **overwhelm** opponents by numbers

Too much variety may **overwhelm** and confuse viewers.

# grief

- n. a very great sadness, especially when somebody diessynonym: anguish, desperation, dismay
- (1) have **grief** and sorrow, (2) a lot of **grief** Each person has a unique **grief** experience.

# despair

n. the feeling that there is no hope and you cannot do anything to improve a difficult situation

synonym: dismay, anguish, misery

(1) **despair** at the future, (2) untold **despair** His friend's death drove him to **despair**.

### absolute

adj. perfect or complete or to the most considerable degree possible

*synonym*: complete, infrangible, indisputable

(1) absolute loyalty, (2) an absolute must

Gandhi had an **absolute** zeal for nonviolence.

### broaden

v. to make or become wider or more extensive; to make or become more tolerant or liberal.

synonym: expand, widen, enlarge

(1) **broaden** students' knowledge, (2) **broaden** their horizon The company **broadened** its product line to include more customer options.

#### awareness

the fact or state of knowing something exists and is important

synonym: understanding, cognition, knowledge

(1) **awareness** of my ignorance, (2) raise public **awareness** There has been a gradual but steady rise in environmental **awareness**.

### perpetrator

- n. a person who carries out a harmful or illegal act, particularly one that involves violence or deceptionsynonym: culprit, wrongdoer, offender
- (1) perpetrator identity, (2) culprit perpetrator

The police have not yet caught the **perpetrator** of the crime.

# misery

- n. a state of ill-being due to affliction or misfortunesynonym: affliction, despair, anguish
- (1) live in **misery**, (2) untold **misery**

Our company suffered **misery** from incurring a heavy loss.

#### mass

 a large amount of a substance with no definite shape or form; a large number of people or things grouped or crowded together

synonym: abundance, crowd, mob

(1) a mass of molten rock, (2) critical mass

The **mass** of people who do not own property is politically impotent.

### enormous

adj. extremely large or great synonym: huge, giant, gigantic

(1) **enormous** amount, (2) **enormous** potential Shakespeare's output of poetry was **enormous**.

### monumental

adj. great in importance or influence, size, extent, or solidity; massive

synonym: massive, awesome, enormous

(1) monumental task, (2) monumental sculpture

Everyone, even non-scholars, knows Einstein's **monumental** contributions to physics.

### broad

adj. very wide; general

synonym: wide, expansive, comprehensive

(1) attract **broad** attention, (2) a **broad** mind

He accumulated wealth across a **broad** spectrum of assets.

# immediately

adv. now or without delay

synonym: directly, instantly, promptly

(1) **immediately** recall a product, (2) write him an answer **immediately** 

A suspension order from the court is effective **immediately**.

#### cheer

- v. to give a loud shout to show support, praise, or approval synonym: comfort, encourage, hearten
- (1) **cheer** for the home team, (2) **cheer** me up Supporters in the stands **cheered** at every goal.

### courage

 n. the ability to face danger, difficulty, uncertainty, or pain without being overcome by fear or despair; the quality of being brave or courageous

synonym: bravery, valor, fearlessness

(1) mental **courage**, (2) inspire **courage** 

It takes a lot of **courage** to stand up for what you believe is right.

# stimming

a behavior often exhibited by individuals on the autism spectrum characterized by repetitive bodily movements or sounds, such as hand flapping or rocking, often used as a form of self-regulation or sensory stimulation

synonym: self-stimulation, repetitive behaviors

(1) autistic **stimming**, (2) **stimming** therapy

Autistic children may engage in **stimming** behaviors, such as rocking or hand flapping, to self-regulate.

### occasion

 a time or event that is suitable or appropriate for something to happen or be done; a particular event or circumstance that requires or allows for something to be done

*synonym*: event, time, occurrence

(1) a glad **occasion**, (2) as **occasion** demands She wore her best dress for the special **occasion**.

doorway

- n. an opening in a wall for a door to fit intosynonym: entrance, portal, gateway
- (1) a wide **doorway**, (2) **doorway** to success He leaned against the **doorway**, waiting for her to come home.

# colleague

 one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business

synonym: coworker, associate, fellow

(1) collaborate with colleagues,(2) former colleagueI decided to seek counseling on the advice of my colleague.

tradition

 a belief, custom, or way of doing something that has been passed down from generation to generation within a group or society

synonym: custom, practice, ritual

(1) a tradition of a culture, (2) against tradition

It is a **tradition** in many families to have a big Thanksgiving dinner with all their relatives.

#### saint

 a person who is recognized as having an exceptional degree of holiness, virtue, or devotion

*synonym*: holy person, martyr, angel

(1) saint statue, (2) the departed saint

The faithful follower venerated the **saint's** relic.

# contemporary

adj. belonging to the same or present time synonym: modern, stylish, coetaneous

(1) field of **contemporary** art, (2) **contemporary** leaders **Contemporary** music has gained different followers from existing music.

### discontented

adj. dissatisfied, unhappy, or restless; not content or pleased with a situation or condition

synonym: dissatisfied, unhappy, displeased

(1) **discontented** look, (2) **discontented** with the outcome The **discontented** customers demanded a refund for the poor quality of the product.

# religion

a deep conviction in a supernatural power that controls human destiny

synonym: faith, creed, belief

(1) **religion** sociology, (2) freedom of **religion**Their **religion** strictly prohibits them from drinking or gambling.

### doctrine

 a belief or set of ideas held and taught by a church, political party, or other groups

synonym: creed, principle, tenet

(1) religious **doctrine**, (2) **doctrine** of non-violence
The church **doctrine** teaches that all are equal in the eyes of God.

### wisdom

n. the quality of being wise, or the ability to use your knowledge and experience to make sensible decisionssynonym: sagacity, discernment, insight

(1) a fountain of **wisdom**, (2) **wisdom** literature

The community greatly respected and sought after the older adult's **wisdom**.

# enlightenment

 n. education that results in understanding and the spread of knowledge

synonym: civilization, awareness, sophistication

(1) spiritual **enlightenment**, (2) **enlightenment** activity He finally brought his **enlightenment** to perfection.

# pathetic

 adj. arousing pity, sorrow, or compassion; expressing or evoking sadness, weakness, or inadequacy; inadequate or inferior in quality or ability

synonym: pitiful, miserable, sad

(1) **pathetic** attempt, (2) **pathetic** display

The team's performance was **pathetic** and left the coach feeling disappointed.

### momentum

 n. the force or power that is gained by a moving object; a strength or impetus gained through a process of development or activity

synonym: impetus, drive, thrust

- (1) angular **momentum**, (2) **momentum** toward democracy The team gained **momentum** after scoring their first goal.
- n. (of various religious and mythological traditions) a place or state of existence considered to be the abode of the divine, the afterlife, or a higher realm of being; a state of great happiness, contentment, or beauty

synonym: paradise, nirvana, utopia

(1) ascend to **heaven**, (2) **heaven** on earth

He felt like **heaven** when he tasted the delicious chocolate cake.

#### ....

### heaven

#### retreat

 n. the act of moving back or withdrawing from a position or situation; a period of rest or relaxation away from work or everyday life

synonym: escape, withdrawal, vacation

(1) **retreat** deeper into their territory, (2) **retreat** in a mountain region

Many people go on a **retreat** to recharge and reconnect with themselves.

# meditation

n. the act of focusing one's mind on a particular object or thought; activity to train attention and achieve a mentally clear and emotionally calm and stable state

*synonym*: contemplation, reflection, introspection

(1) **meditation** training, (2) religious **meditation**The **meditation** instructor guided the group through the relaxation and breathing exercises.

# pray

- v. to make a request or petition to a higher power, especially in the form of a respectful or humble request synonym: implore, supplicate, entreat
- (1) pray devoutly, (2) pray for rain

She closed her eyes and **prayed** for strength to overcome difficult times.

#### reveal

 to make known or disclose something that was previously hidden, secret, or unknown; to unveil or show something that was concealed or not visible

synonym: disclose, unveil, expose

(1) reveal secrets, (2) reveal a plan

The detective carefully **revealed** the true identity of the murderer.

### revive

v. to bring back to life, consciousness, or strength; to restore

synonym: reanimate, rejuvenate, renew

revive my energy, (2) revive an old friendship
 They revived the tradition of holding a parade on the main

### street every year.

# disgust

- n. a strong feeling of dislike or disapproval
- synonym: nauseate, hate, dislike
- (1) public **disgust**, (2) show **disgust** at his actions

He was filled with **disgust** and fear for the threat of war.

# lump

- a small, irregularly shaped mass or piece, typically of a soft substance such as coal, flour, or dough
- synonym: mass, clump, ball
- (1) **lump** in the throat, (2) single **lump** sum

There is a small **lump** on my neck, and I'm concerned about it.

### rub

- v. to move one's hand or an object over the surface of something with pressure
- synonym: scrub, massage, stroke
- (1) rub shoulders, (2) rub a glass window

She **rubbed** the sore spot on her leg to ease the pain.

### needle

- a thin, pointed object typically used for sewing or medical purposes; a metal or plastic instrument used for administering injections or drawing blood
- synonym: thorn, spike, pin
- (1) needle prick, (2) sewing needle

The acupuncturist inserted **needles** into specific points on my body to alleviate my pain.

### ridiculous

- adj. very silly or unreasonable and deserving to be laughed at
- synonym: absurd, fatuous, foolish
- (1) a **ridiculous** amount of money, (2) a **ridiculous** suggestion

Everyone regarded the theory he advocated as **ridiculous** but was later proven correct.

cave

n. a large hole in the side of a hill, cliff, mountain, or under the ground

synonym: cavern, grotto, burrow

(1) domiciliary caves, (2) the mouth of the cave

Bats reside in sheltered caves.

vision

 n. the ability to think about or see the future with imagination and intelligence; the faculty of being able to see

*synonym*: sight, image, concept

(1) a prodigious **vision**, (2) telescopic **vision** 

Driving is difficult for me because of my poor vision.

nest

 a structure in which animals lay their eggs or give birth to their young

synonym: roost, perch, burrow

(1) bird's **nest**, (2) a **nest** of thieves

The female birds build a **nest** and lay their eggs in May.

cliff

 a steep rock face, especially one at the edge of the sea or a river

synonym: crag, escarpment, precipice

(1) a bold cliff, (2) cliff diving

He stood at the edge of the **cliff** and looked out to sea.

ledge

 a narrow, flat surface or shelf that juts out from a wall or cliff; a projecting rib or molding along the edge of a surface

synonym: shelf, edge, brink

(1) **ledge** overlooking the ocean, (2) wooden **ledge** He stood on the narrow **ledge**, looking down at the busy street below.

landing

n. the act of coming to rest on the ground or another surface after being in flight or jumping; a platform or area of ground where a plane or spacecraft can come to rest

synonym:

touchdown, arrival, descent

(1) landing gear, (2) emergency landing

The plane made a rough **landing**, and everyone clapped once we came to a stop.

twig

a small, thin, flexible branch or shoot of a tree or shrub;
 a slender, fragile, or delicate object or individual

synonym: branchlet, sprig, osier

(1) twig branch, (2) twig basket

The bird perched on a **twig** and sang a beautiful melody.

cleft

 a narrow opening or fissure, usually in a rock or the ground; also, a separation or division between two things or parts

synonym: split, crevice, fissure

(1) cleft chin, (2) cleft rock

The hiker stumbled and fell into the **cleft** between two large rocks.

generation

- n. all the people born and living at about the same time, regarded collectively; the production of heat or electricitysynonym: cohort, age group, era
- (1) **generation** gap, (2) the **generation** of electricity

  The younger **generation** has different values and beliefs than the older one.

drip

v. to fall in drops or make it fall in drops; (noun) liquid or moisture that falls in drops

synonym: drop, drizzle, trickle

(1) **drip** liquid, (2) **drip** from the vicious wound Water is **dripping** from the faucet.

giant

adj. enormous; much bigger or more important than similar items usually are

synonym: big, gigantic, huge

(1) giant trees, (2) giant tech company

The **giant** jets gradually dominate the world's airlines.

### stream

*n.* a small, narrow river; a continuous flow of something, such as liquid, gas, people, vehicles, etc.

*synonym*: flow, current, brook

(1) the **stream** of time, (2) an endless **stream** of cars

Jet **streams** are the common name for air currents that form high in the atmosphere.

#### freak

- n. an abnormality that is not typical or expectedsynonym: anomaly, deviation, oddity
- (1) a rock freak, (2) freak weather

The **freak** accident caused the car to flip over and land on its roof.

# encouraging

adj. giving hope, confidence, or support; inspiringsynonym: uplifting, inspiring, optimistic

(1) **encouraging** approval, (2) **encouraging** sign The test results were **encouraging** and showed improvement.

### attract

- v. to draw or entice someone or something towards them through the qualities they have, especially positive onessynonym: lure, entice, draw in
- attract attention, (2) attract customers
   The government is eager to attract international investment.

### quarter

- n. one of four equal parts; a fourth part or portionsynonym: fourth, one-fourth
- (1) a **quarter** mile, (2) end of the first **quarter**The unemployment rate in the first **quarter** was 2.3 percentage points higher than in the previous.

#### sore

adj. painful or sensitive to the touch; inflamed or irritated; feeling deep distress, grief, or regretsynonym: aching, tender, angered

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(1) sore throat, (2) sore back

After the workout, my muscles were **sore** and achy.

### gangrene

n. a condition in which body tissue dies due to a lack of blood supply, often resulting from injury, infection, or disease, typically characterized by discoloration, swelling, and a foul odor

synonym: necrosis, decay, putrefaction

(1) gangrene infection, (2) severe gangrene

Doctors were forced to amputate the infected limb to prevent the spread of **gangrene**.

# maggot

 the larval stage of a fly or other insect, typically characterized by its soft, legless body and often found in decaying organic matter or on living animals

synonym: larva, grub, worm

(1) maggot therapy, (2) wriggling maggots

The **maggot** infestation in the trash can was a clear sign that we needed to take out the garbage more frequently.

### flesh

 the soft substance composing the body of a person or animal, as opposed to bones and other structures

synonym: meat, muscle, tissue

(1) grow in **flesh**, (2) **flesh** eating

The **flesh** of the fruit is sweet and juicy.

# cute

adj. attractive, especially in a childlike or youthful way synonym: attractive, charming, adorable

(1) act cute, (2) super cute dress

The baby's chubby cheeks and big eyes made her look so cute.

### useless

adj. not serving any useful purpose; having no practical result

synonym: ineffectual, unhelpful, worthless

(1) **useless** information, (2) **useless** in the kitchen

The old, rusty tools were now **useless** and had to be thrown away.

# hopeless

adj. having no hope; despairing; having no chance of success

synonym: despairing, helpless, futile

(1) hopeless situation, (2) hopeless at everything

After months of job searching, he felt **hopeless** and unsure of his future.

### brilliant

adj. extremely clever, skilled, or impressive synonym: luminous, intelligent, clever

(1) brilliant idea, (2) brilliant performance

The more **brilliant** you are, the more people around you look at you with envy and jealousy.

### shard

- a small, sharp piece of something that has been broken, especially a material like glass, pottery, or metal
- synonym: break, fragment, shatter
- (1) broken **shard**, (2) **shard** of pottery

The artist used a **shard** of glass to create intricate designs on her sculptures.

# thigh

- n. the part of the human leg between the hip and the knee;in animals, the corresponding upper part of the hind legsynonym: thigh-bone, femur, upper leg
- (1) thigh muscle, (2) chicken thigh

The marathon runner felt a cramp in her **thigh** at the 20th mile.

### grab

v. to take hold of something or someone suddenly with a hand, especially in a violent way

synonym: clutch, snatch, grasp

(1) **grab** an audience, (2) **grab** an opportunity Shall we **grab** a bite to eat?

# apparently

adv. based on what you have heard or read synonym: evidently, obviously, supposedly

(1) **apparently** simple, (2) **apparently** unrelated The police **apparently** believed this explanation was plausible.

# wriggle

v. to twist and turn with quick, writhing motions; to move in a twisting or contorting manner

synonym: squirm, jerk, twist

(1) wriggle free, (2) wriggle in surprise

The child started to **wriggle** out of their seatbelt during the long car ride.

# tongue

 a moveable mass of muscle tissue covered with mucous membrane that is in the mouth; a language

*synonym*: lingo, language, vocabulary

(1) native **tongue**, (2) **tongue** cancer

The **tongue** is boneless, but it is as strong as bones.

# spit

v. to eject saliva or other liquid from the mouth

synonym: expectorate, saliva, spew

(1) spit a bullet, (2) spit a mouthful of saliva

She tried to spit out the gum that she had been chewing.

#### stick

v. to put something, usually a sharp object, into something; to restrict yourself to doing or using one certain thing and not change; (noun) a thin piece of wood or other material

synonym: pierce, adhere, stay

(1) stick a key in a lock, (2) fire stick

You **stick** a bill in the change machine, and the coins pop out.

# suddenly

adv. quickly and unexpectedly

synonym: abruptly, unexpectedly, unawares

(1) suddenly attacked by an enemy, (2) die suddenly

Who answers **suddenly** knows little.

### rainbow

 an arch of colors in the sky caused by the refraction and dispersion of sunlight through rain

*synonym*: spectrum, iridescence, prism

(1) marine **rainbow**, (2) **rainbow** after a storm She was mesmerized by the **rainbow's** colors.

# jewel

a precious stone that is cut and polished for use in jewelry

synonym: gem, precious stone, treasure

(1) **jewel** of the crown, (2) gleaming **jewel** 

She treasured the small **jewel** that her grandmother had given her.

# plasma

- n. (biology) the yellow-colored liquid component of blood, in which blood cells are suspended; (physics) one of the four fundamental states of matter consisting of positive ions and free electrons
- (1) **plasma** membrane, (2) high-temperature **plasma**Blood **plasma** makes up about half of the volume of blood.

# exquisite

- adj. extremely beautiful and delicate
- synonym: magnificent, glorious, gorgeous
- (1) **exquisite** crafts, (2) a man of **exquisite** sensitivity We can hear an **exquisite** piano melody from his room.

# mystic
