#### distinct

*adj.* noticeable from something else of a similar type *synonym*: different, special, characteristic

(1) **distinct** difference, (2) **distinct** from each other It is essential to keep these two issues **distinct**.

### biosphere

 the part of the Earth and its atmosphere in which living organisms exist, including plants, animals, and microorganisms

synonym: ecosphere, ecospace, ecosystem

(1) terrestrial biosphere, (2) artificial biosphere
The balance of the biosphere is crucial for the survival of species.

### hop

v. to jump lightly and quickly on one foot or both feet; to move rapidly from one place to another; to travel using an aircraft, bus, etc.

synonym: jump, bounce, skip

(1) **hop** on one foot, (2) **hop** from one place to another The rabbit **hopped** over the fence.

#### harvest

 n. yields of plants in a single growing season; the period of the year when gathering occurs on a farm

synonym: crop, reaping, yield

(1) a scanty harvest, (2) reap a harvest

During harvest, farmers are incredibly busy.

### wheat

 a cereal plant that is the most important kind grown in temperate countries, the grain of which is ground to make flour for bread, pasta, pastry, etc

synonym: grain, cereal

(1) harvesting wheat, (2) wheat crop

The farmer grew **wheat** on his land.

### dough

 a mixture of flour, liquid, and other ingredients, typically used to make bread, pastry, or pasta

*synonym*: flour, mix

(1) work **dough**, (2) **dough** for pastry

She mixed flour, yeast, sugar, and water to make **dough** for the bread.

### essentially

*adv.* relating to the essential features or concepts of anything *synonym*: fundamentally, basically, virtually

(1) **essentially** correct, (2) become **essentially** same **Essentially**, a society is an organism.

#### acre

- a unit of land area in the US Customary System and the British Imperial System, equal to 4,840 square yards (= 4,047 square meters)
- (1) half- **acre** parcel, (2) an **acre** of forest The farm covers over 200 **acres** of land.

### entirely

adv. completely

*synonym*: completely, fully, totally

(1) **entirely** satisfied with the meal, (2) he was **entirely** to blame

Later, his claim was found to be **entirely** false.

#### sealed

adj. closed or secured withsynonym: closed, impenetrable

(1) sealed orders, (2) sealed jar

We packed and shipped the product in **sealed** containers.

#### miniature

adj. being on a very small scale

synonym: mini, scaled-down, pint-sized

(1) miniature camera, (2) miniature version

He did complicated pen-and-ink drawings like medieval **miniatures**.

steel

 a strong metal alloy made up of iron with typically a few tenths of a percent of carbon used for making things that need a strong structure

*synonym*: iron

(1) magnetic **steel**, (2) **steel** beam

This bridge is the third largest **steel** bridge in the world.

#### underneath

adv. under or below something else

synonym: below, under, beneath

(1) **underneath** the surface of the water, (2) **underneath** the laughter

The penny fell underneath the piano.

### rainforest

- a forest rich in biodiversity that is generally found in tropical settings with heavy annual rainfall
- (1) rainforest destruction, (2) tropical rainforest

The destruction of the **rainforest** is a ticking time bomb for the Earth.

coral

- a rock-like substance created in the sea by groupings of specific types of small animals, commonly used in jewelry
- (1) coral island, (2) coral ornament

She is wearing a coral necklace.

reef

- a long chain or range of rocks or sand near the ocean's surface
- (1) barrier **reef**, (2) coral **reefs**

The vessel ran aground on a reef.

#### savannah

n. a mixed forest and grassland ecosystem where the trees are far enough apart that the canopy doesn't closesynonym: grassland, plain

(1) savannah region, (2) tropical savannah

The birds live in tropical forests, **savannahs**, and arid semi-desert environments.

#### marsh

a type of land that is always wet and has soft soil;
 swamp or bog

synonym: bog, swamp, fen

(1) marsh bird, (2) river-delta marsh

Environmentalists are concerned about the harm to the marsh.

#### desert

- arid land with little or no vegetation often covered with sand or rocks
- (1) **desert** basin, (2) oasis in the **desert** This region is predominantly **desert**.

#### habitat

 the type of natural environment in which an organism or group usually lives or occurs

synonym: dwelling, environment, home ground

(1) a marine habitat, (2) threatened habitat

The **habitat** of this bird is freshwater areas and saltwater marshes.

### quest

- n. a long or challenging search for somethingsynonym: exploration, inquisition, pursuit
- (1) the **quest** for truth, (2) on a **quest** for happiness That adventurer traveled in **quest** of buried treasure.

### sphere

 a round object or geometric shape that is three-dimensional and symmetrical around a central point; a particular aspect or scope of life or activity

synonym: ball, globe, scope

(1) **sphere** of influence, (2) business **sphere** The **sphere** of the earth is divided into several layers including the crust, mantle, and core.

### specific

decide

adj. clearly defined or particular to a certain thing or situation; distinct, explicit, and precise synonym: particular, definite, distinct

- (1) **specific** instructions, (2) industry- **specific** regulations The scientist conducted a study that provided **specific** details about the species' behavior.
- to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options synonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

### energetic

adj. possessing or exerting or displaying energy synonym: active, animated, lively

(1) energetic density, (2) energetic dog This process caused an **energetic** chemical reaction.

### planet

any of the nine large celestial bodies that circle in the solar system; any celestial body that revolves around a star

synonym: earth, world, globe

(1) planet like the Earth, (2) save the planet Mercury is the closest **planet** to the sun.

chamber

- a large room used for a formal, public, or particular n. purpose; one of the parts of a parliament synonym: association, cabin, legislature
- (1) a gas chamber, (2) the lower chamber The surgeon made an incision in the **chambers** of the patient's heart.

#### module

 a self-contained unit or component of a larger system or structure; a standardized unit of computer hardware or software designed to perform a specific function

synonym: component, unit, segment

(1) module software, (2) audio module

I must install a new programming **module** for my computer program to function properly.

### fellow

adj. someone who has the same job or interests as you, or is in the same class, profession, or situation as you

synonym: buddy, mate, affiliate

(1) junior **fellow**, (2) nice **fellow** 

He is the kind of **fellow** who only works for his success.

### bacteria

n. single-celled or noncellular spherical or spiral or rod-shaped organisms that exist in large numbers in the air, water, and soil, and also in living and dead creatures and plants, and are often a cause of disease

synonym: microorganism, microbe

(1) pathogenic **bacteria**, (2) harmless **bacteria Bacteria** prevalent in hospitals are often resistant to antibiotics.

### incredibly

adv. in a way that is very difficult to believe; exceedingly or extremely

synonym: enormously, exceptionally, extraordinarily

(1) **incredibly** cheerful character, (2) get **incredibly** insecure

Several cities are experiencing **incredibly** high unemployment rates.

#### concerned

adj. feeling worry or interest about something; showing interest or attention

synonym: worried, caring, involved

 persons concerned, (2) concerned citizen
 am concerned about the safety of the children playing in the park.

#### succumb

v. to fail to oppose something, such as desire, pressure, or some other opposing force; to die or suffer badly from the effect of a disease or injury

synonym: surrender, break down, die

(1) **succumb** to cancer, (2) **succumb** to old age

He finally **succumbed** to temptation.

#### dreadful

*adj.* very bad, unpleasant, or causing fear *synonym*: terrible, horrible, awful

(1) dreadful accident, (2) dreadful news

The conditions of the prison were **dreadful** and inhumane.

#### toxin

 a poisonous substance produced by a living organism, such as a plant, animal, or microorganism; a chemical compound that can cause harm or illness to a living organism

*synonym*: poison, venom, contaminant

(1) toxin exposure, (2) toxin production

Mold exposure can release dangerous **toxins** into the air.

### lung

- either of the two organs in the chest that people and some animals use for breathing
- (1) **lung** capacity, (2) do **lung** transplantation He has terminal **lung** cancer.

### choke

v. to prevent or obstruct the normal breathing or swallowing of someone or something

synonym: strangle, suffocate, clog

(1) **choke** with anger, (2) **choke** off the blood supply The baby started to **choke** on a piece of apple.

fungus

 a type of organism that includes yeasts, molds, and mushrooms, which are heterotrophic, meaning they do not produce their food and must consume organic matter to survive

synonym: mold, mildew, yeast

(1) fungus infection, (2) symbiotic fungus

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Certain types of **fungus** can be toxic to humans, causing severe illness if ingested.

### ensue

v. to happen or follow as a result or consequence of something

synonym: follow, occur, result

(1) **ensue** within a few years, (2) predict what will **ensue** A power outage **ensued** after the storm knocked out the electricity.

### saga

 a long, detailed story or account of heroic deeds, family history, or notable events, often consisting of a series of connected episodes

synonym: epic, tale, chronicle

(1) fantasy saga, (2) historical saga

The epic **saga** of the family's journey through time captivated readers worldwide.

#### malleable

adj. able to be easily shaped, molded, or manipulated, particularly in a physical or metaphorical sense; capable of being adapted or changed according to different circumstances or situations

synonym: flexible, adaptable, pliable

(1) malleable clay, (2) malleable attitude

Gold is a **malleable** metal that can be easily shaped into different forms.

### evolve

v. to develop gradually, or to cause the development of something or someone gradually

synonym: develop, mature, grow

(1) **evolve**, (2) **evolve** over the past decade

Eyeless fish **evolved** in dark caves.

### jam

 a situation in which something becomes stuck because of a dense crowd of people, vehicles, etc.; a preserve of crushed fruit

synonym: difficulty, mess, preserve

(1) a traffic **jam**, (2) a jar of **jam** The shredder in the print room often has paper **jams**.

#### survive

- to live or exist despite a dangerous event or period synonym: endure, persist, stay
- (1) **survive** a blizzard, (2) **survive** a plane crash These birds can only **survive** in temperate climates.

### universe

everything that exists, especially all physical matter, including planets, stars, galaxies, and all other forms of matter and energy

synonym: cosmos, macrocosm

- (1) theory of the **universe**, (2) expansion of the **universe** The **universe** is about 13.8 billion years old.
- to damage or spoil the appearance or surface of something

synonym: damage, deface, disfigure

(1) mar a proper relationship, (2) mar the reputation The scratches on the car **marred** its otherwise perfect appearance.

#### instance

- a particular example or single occurrence of something *synonym*: example, sample, illustration
- (1) for **instance**, (2) notable **instance** These articles cite five **instances** of climate change.

### maid

- a girl or young woman employed to do domestic work synonym: servant, housekeeper, domestic
- (1) maid service, (2) a waiting maid The live-in **maid** came in to clean the room every day.

### voyage

- a long journey, especially by sea or in space synonym: journey, trip, excursion
- (1) a **voyage** of discovery, (2) take a **voyage** The astronaut trained for years before embarking on her

mar

### voyage to the International Space Station.

### thereby

adv. as a result; consequence of a particular action or set of conditions

synonym: thus, hence, as a result

(1) **thereby-obtained** data, (2) **thereby** improving overall health

The new software will streamline the workflow, **thereby** increasing productivity.

### negate

v. to make something ineffective or null; to deny the truth of something

synonym: refuse, nullify, annul

(1) **negate** the possibility, (2) **negate** the existing system Drinking may **negate** the beneficial effects of the drug.

### concept

- n. an idea or principle associated with something abstractsynonym: idea, notion, vision
- learn new concepts, (2) concept car
   One such rapidly growing concept is quantum cryptography.

#### human-made

adj. created or produced by humans; artificial synonym: artificial, unnatural, manufactured

(1) **human-made** climate change, (2) the worst **human-made** disaster

The bridge is a **human-made** structure and was built to span the river.

### pump

v. to cause water, air, gas, etc. to move from one place to another by using mechanical equipment; to get or supply something such as money, information, etc. in significant quantities

synonym: drain, inject, send

(1) **pump** a secret out of success, (2) **pump** blood throughout the body

He was alert and could not pump any critical information out

of him.

#### valve

 a device for controlling the flow of a fluid or gas through a pipe or duct by means of a movable part that opens, closes, or restricts the opening

synonym: tap, spigot, faucet

(1) electromagnetic valve, (2) valve control

The **valve** on the pipeline was leaking, so maintenance had to shut it off to make repairs.

### handle

- v. to deal with a situation, problem, or strong emotion synonym: control, manage, deal with
- (1) **handle** a precious object, (2) **handled** the incident We all should learn how to **handle** stress.

#### aircraft

 any vehicle that can fly and carry things or passengers, such as a plane or helicopter

synonym: airplane, plane, airliner

an aircraft landing, (2) aircraft control system
 The marine aircraft manufacturer demonstrated their newest

hydroplane.

### laboratory

*n.* a workplace for doing scientific research or teaching science; a lab

synonym: lab, workshop, testing room

(1) **laboratory** accident, (2) anthropology **laboratory**Animal protection groups call for an end to animal testing in a **laboratory**.

### agriculture

 the practice or science of cultivating the land or raising stock

synonym: farming, husbandry, agribusiness

organic agriculture,
 intensive agriculture
 agriculture
 organic agriculture

### organic

adj. of or derived from biological substance; producing plants and animals for food and other items without the use of

### synthetic chemicals

synonym: biological

(1) organic soils, (2) eat organic food

The kidney is an **organic** component of the body.

### atmosphere

n. the mass of air that surrounds the Earth; the pervading tone or mood of a place, situation, or creative work

synonym: air, ambiance, circumstances

(1) carbon dioxide in the **atmosphere**, (2) a convivial **atmosphere** 

The spaceship began to burn up as it approached the Earth's **atmosphere**.

### abstract

adj. based on general ideas, feelings, or qualities and not on any a physical or concrete existence

synonym: conceptual, theoretical, ideational

(1) an abstract noun, (2) abstract science

The invention of the camera triggered the development of **abstract** painting.

### **literally**

adv. in the real or original meaning of a word or phrase; in a literal sense or way; not figuratively

synonym: actually, truly, verily

(1) translate **literally**, (2) bite his tongue **literally** 

He literally jumped out of his chair when he heard the news.

#### awful

adj. causing fear, dread, or terror; very bad or unpleasant synonym: terrible, appalling, horrible

(1) an awful error, (2) do awful damage

I regretted making an **awful** mistake in my final exam.

#### carbon

- a chemical element that can be found in pure form as diamond or graphite, and it is also an essential part of coal and oil and is found in all plants and animals
- (1) carbon dioxide, (2) carbon emission

Trees absorb **carbon** dioxide and give off oxygen.

#### bizarre

adj. very strange or unusual

synonym: abnormal, freaky, outlandish

(1) the story is bizarre, (2) bizarre behavior

The truth was more **bizarre** than expected.

### oxygen

- the chemical element with the symbol O that is present in air and water and is necessary for people, animals, and plants to live
- (1) the hydrogen binds the **oxygen**, (2) lack of **oxygen** The passenger grabbed for the **oxygen** mask.

### sequester

v. to take temporary possession of someone's property until a debt is paid.

synonym: isolate, set apart, segregate

- (1) **sequester** ten percent of the annual carbon emissions,
- (2) **sequester** myself from the world

He approved their requests to **sequester** the jury.

#### lord

 a person who has general authority, control, or power over others; a man of noble rank or high office

synonym: master, noble, peer

(1) a young lord, (2) lord of castle

The feudal lord had ruled the land for many years.

#### crazy

adj. stupid or not sensible; very angry

synonym: insane, absurd, bizarre

(1) **crazy** about cars and racing, (2) a **crazy** scheme The rain and thunder are **crazy** today.

#### biomass

- the total quantity of living matter in a given unit of environment, including plants, animals, and microorganisms
- (1) biomass energy, (2) fuel biomass

The **biomass** in a forest can be measured by collecting and weighing all living plants within a specific area.

#### basement

 a room or a part of a building that is partly or entirely below ground level

synonym: cellar, storage, vault

(1) four **basement** floor, (2) church **basement** Underground rivers flow over a **basement** layer that is impervious to water.

### irrigate

- v. to supply water to land to help plants grow synonym: water, drench, soak
- (1) **irrigate** fields, (2) **irrigate** the flowers and plants
  The water shortage in the region has made it difficult for farmers to **irrigate** their crops.

#### soil

- n. the top layer of Earth in which plants grow synonym: earth, ground, mud
- (1) **soils** retentive of moisture, (2) parched **soil Soil** moisture is another significant component controlling soil respiration.

### greenhouse

- n. a building with walls and roof made chiefly of transparent material, such as glass, for growing plants in synonym: conservatory
- (1) exotic plants in a **greenhouse**, (2) emissions of **greenhouse** gases

The **greenhouse** effect is a phenomenon that happens naturally.

### unexpected

adj. not anticipated or regarded as likely to happen synonym: surprising, unanticipated, incredible

(1) an **unexpected** visitor, (2) some **unexpected** events
The **unexpected** rainstorm caused the collapse of the corral.

### tandem

 a device or arrangement that allows two or more things to be connected or work together in a coordinated manner; a bicycle built for two people to ride in a line, with one behind the other

synonym: bicycle built for two, double, tandem bike

(1) tandem approach, (2) tandem skydiving

The **tandem** bike ride was fun for the couple to enjoy together.

atomic

adj. of or relating to atom (= the smallest component of an element)

synonym: tiny, microscopic, nuclear

(1) atomic nucleus, (2) atomic bomb

Carbon has an **atomic** mass of 12.

#### hide-and-seek

- a popular children's game in which one player closes their eyes for a brief period of time while the other players hide
- (1) enjoy a game of **hide-and-seek**, (2) **hide-and-seek** champion

We played **hide-and-seek** in the park until it got too dark.

clue

 an object, a piece of evidence, or some information that helps someone to find the answer to a problem, question, or mystery

synonym: hint, indication, inkling

(1) a **clue** about the crime, (2) a **clue** to the diagnosis. The police couldn't find a **clue** to her whereabouts.

drag

v. to pull or haul with force

synonym: haul, pull, draw

(1) drag a chair over, (2) drag a team down

He **dragged** the heavy suitcase behind him as he walked.

apnea

 a temporary cessation of breathing, especially during sleep; a medical condition characterized by the repeated occurrence of such interruptions

*synonym*: breathing interruption, suspension of breath

(1) apnea treatment, (2) epileptic apnea

Sleep **apnea** is a severe condition that causes a person to stop breathing while asleep.

### gasp

v. to inhale sharply and audibly, often in response to strong emotion or sensation; to catch one's breath suddenly, often due to shock or surprise

synonym: breathe, pant, heave

(1) gasp for air, (2) gasp in shock

The audience **gasped** when the magician made the rabbit disappear from the hat.

### breath

the air that is taken into and expelled from your lungs;
 the process of taking into and expelling air from your lungs

synonym: air, puff, whiff

(1) hold your **breath**, (2) **breath** of wind He bated his **breath** when talking about this affair.

### chemistry

- the branch of the natural sciences dealing with the composition of substances and their properties and reactions
- (1) professor of **chemistry**, (2) the **chemistry** of soil He is familiar with **chemistry** and biology.

### irritating

adj. causing annoyance, frustration, or exasperation; provoking impatience or irritation

synonym: annoying, bothersome, vexing

(1) irritating noise, (2) irritating behavior

The garbage can in the kitchen has been producing an **irritating** smell for days.

### mum

n. a British term for "mom" or "mother"; (adjective) failing to speak or communicate when expected to do so

synonym: mother, silent, soundless

(1) mum's cooking, (2) keep mum

My **mum** always knew how to comfort me when I was feeling down.

### susceptible

adj. easily influenced, harmed, or affected by something synonym: exposed, liable, gullible

(1) a **susceptible** young woman, (2) **susceptible** of proof Well-stretched muscles are less **susceptible** to injury.

fig

- a sweet and soft edible fruit with many seeds or a tree on which these grow
- (1) **fig** marigold, (2) **fig** tree

He ate the dried **figs** he had preserved.

### terrifying

adj. very frightening or intimidatingsynonym: frightening, intimidating, alarming

terrifying experience, (2) terrifying events
 Large earthquakes often generate terrifying tsunamis.

### airlock

- a chamber between two areas that can be sealed against pressure, allowing the passage of people and objects to go from one area to the other
- an airlock chamber, (2) airlock module
   The mechanic has just inspected the jammed airlock.

### crank

 a mechanical device that converts rotary motion into linear motion or vice versa; an eccentric or unpredictable person

synonym: eccentric, oddball, kook

(1) crank handle, (2) crank caller

The fishing reel had a **crank** that made it easy to reel in the catch.

#### concrete

 adj. existing in a physical or material form rather than an abstract one; based on facts rather than ideas or guesses; made of or covered with cement

synonym: actual, factual, hardened

(1) a **concrete** noun, (2) **concrete** examples The president asked for a more **concrete** plan.

### compost

 a mixture of organic matter, such as food scraps, yard waste, and manure, that is allowed to decompose and is used as fertilizer for plants and garden soil synonym: fertilizer, humus, manure

(1) organic compost, (2) compost pile

You can add coffee grounds and crushed eggshells to your **compost** to improve the pH balance.

### straightforward

*adj.* easy to do or understand, or simple; free from ambiguity *synonym*: honest, candid, forthright

(1) **straightforward** manner, (2) make a **straightforward** dash

The defendant gave a **straightforward** and accurate description of the accident.

#### elated

adj. extremely happy, joyful, or excited, often as a result of success or achievement

synonym: joyful, thrilled, ecstatic

(1) **elated** mood, (2) **elated** expression

She was **elated** when she found out she got the job she had hoped for.

### discovery

 the act or process of finding information, a place, or an object, or learning about something that was previously not known

synonym: finding, uncovering, detection

(1) a scientific **discovery**, (2) the great **discovery** of the century

Her research team made an important **discovery**.

### emerge

v. to move out of or away from something and become visible

synonym: arise, occur, appear

- (1) **emerge** as a butterfly, (2) **emerge** from poverty During colonial eras, new migratory patterns **emerged**.
- a feeling of extreme and sudden excitement and pleasure; to cause someone to feel sudden intense sensation or emotion

synonym: exhilaration, delight, rush

### thrill

(1) the <b>thrill</b> of speed,	(2) incredible thrill
Skydiving is an overwhelming thrill for many people	

#### recoil

- v. to spring or flinch back, as in surprise, fear, or pain synonym: flinch, shy, shrink
- (1) **recoil** in horror, (2) **recoil** from a snake The gun **recoiled** with a loud bang.

### stink

- v. to emit a strong, unpleasant odor; to have a strong offensive smell; to be corrupt or unethicalsynonym: reek, smell, odor
- stink up the place, (2) stink badly
   The garbage in the alley began to stink after a few hot days.

### armpit

- n. the hollow under the arm where it joins the shoulder synonym: underarm, axilla
- (1) hair of the **armpits**, (2) **armpit** area This stick will deodorize your **armpits**.

### deodorant

- n. a product applied to the body, typically under the arms, that helps to eliminate or mask unpleasant body odorsynonym: antiperspirant, scent, fragrant
- (1) deodorant stick, (2) spray deodorantMake sure to apply deodorant before going to the gym.

### perfume

 a liquid that emits and diffuses a pleasant smell, usually used on the skin

synonym: scent, aroma, bouquet

(1) a subtle **perfume**, (2) **perfume** every day He sniffed the **perfume** voluptuously.

### recognize

v. to acknowledge or realize something or someone; to identify, remember, or become aware of something that was previously known or encountered

synonym: acknowledge, identify, admit

(1) recognize talent, (2) recognize achievement

It's important to **recognize** your strengths and weaknesses.

#### aisle

 a passage between rows of seats in a theater, airplane, or other public building, typically one of two or more running parallel with the main body of the structure

synonym: corridor, passageway, gangway

(1) **aisle** seat, (2) the center **aisle** of a church. She walked down the **aisle** to the front of the church.

### astonishing

adj. surprising or shocking; difficult to believesynonym: surprising, shocking, astounding

(1) **astonishing** achievement, (2) make **astonishing** gains The news of her sudden death was **astonishing** to everyone who knew her.

#### visceral

 adj. relating to or affecting the internal organs; instinctive or emotional rather than rational; characterized by deep-seated emotional reactions or responses

synonym: instinctive, intuitive, gut

(1) visceral organ, (2) visceral fear

After watching the horror movie, she had a **visceral** reaction and couldn't sleep all night.

### paragon

 a person or thing that is regarded as a perfect example of a particular quality or characteristic; a model of excellence or perfection

synonym: model, exemplar, ideal

(1) **paragon** of wisdom, (2) **paragon** of virtue

She is considered a **paragon** of beauty and grace in her

community.

## develop
