synchronicity

n. the simultaneous occurrence of seemingly unrelated events that are connected in a meaningful way, suggesting the presence of a deeper, more significant pattern or purpose

synonym: coincidence, simultaneity, concurrence

(1) **synchronicity** theory, (2) **synchronicity** effect The occurrence of events in **synchronicity** is often taken as a sign of divine intervention.

sink

to submerge or go down below the surface of a liquid or substance; to decline or deteriorate; to cause something to go down into a liquid substance or sink into something else

drift

release

- v. to set free or allow to escape from confinement synonym: free, let go, discharge

forehead

n. the part of the face above the eyebrows and below the hairline; the upper part of the face that extends from the eyes to the hairline

upward

 adv. toward the top or highest point, or a higher position or level; (adjective) extending or moving toward a higher place

gesture

a movement of the hands, head, or face that express a particular meaning

synonym: motion, expression, gesticulation

downward

adj. moving towards a lower position or a lower level synonym: lower, earthward, descending

(1) a **downward** slope, (2) maintain **downward** compatibility

snap

v. to record on photographic film; to make a sudden, sharp sound; (noun) the act of catching an object with the hands

synonym: break, crack, fracture

hell

the place thought to be where bad people go and are punished after death, often depicted as being located beneath the earth; an extraordinarily unpleasant or difficult place

synonym: inferno, agony, misery

The battlefield became **hell** on earth.

crazy

adj. stupid or not sensible; very angrysynonym: insane, absurd, bizarre

solid

adj. hard or firm; characterized by good substantial quality synonym: stable, reliable, hard

chant

 a simple melody or tune, typically one that is repeated or sung in a monotonous way; (verb) recite with musical intonation

synonym: hymn, mantra, (verb) recite

The soccer game crowd broke into a **chant** of "Go, team, go!"

kinetic

adj. of or relating to motion or the forces that cause motion synonym: active, dynamic, lively

(1) kinetic friction, (2) kinetic motion

The kinetic energy of the falling object increased as it fell.

paranormal

adj. relating to phenomena or experiences that are beyond scientific explanation or understanding, often associated with forces or entities that are outside the realm of normal human perception or understanding, such as ghosts, psychic abilities, or supernatural occurrences

synonym: supernatural, mystical, otherworldly

(1) **paranormal** experience, (2) **paranormal** phenomena The haunted house was said to be a hotspot for **paranormal** activity.

influence

n. the ability to affect someone's or something's character, growth, or behavior, or the effect itself

synonym: power, leverage, effect

process

n. a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

synonym: procedure, method, system

(1) **process** improvement, (2) decision-making **process** The **process** for applying for a visa can be lengthy and complicated.

magician

 a person who performs magic tricks or illusions to entertain an audience; typically involves sleight of hand or deception to create seemingly impossible or supernatural effects

synonym: illusionist, conjurer, wizard

The children were delighted with the **magician's** clever tricks.

mentalist

 a performer, artist, or person with interest in mentalism or the art of using mental powers and illusions to create the impression of extraordinary psychic or paranormal abilities

melt

shard

a small, sharp piece of something that has been broken, especially a material like glass, pottery, or metal

relation

v. to study or consider a person or object attentively and thoroughly to learn something about them
