adventure

n. a journey or a series of events that is unusual, exciting, or dangerous

synonym: experience, happening, incident

crystal

 a solid material with many even sides that is formed naturally when the substance becomes solid and has a highly regular atomic structure; clear and colorless glass made of almost pure silica

synonym: quartz

A vast crystal chandelier glittered brightly above us.

planet

 any of the nine large celestial bodies that circle in the solar system; any celestial body that revolves around a star

synonym: earth, world, globe

insect

- any small creature that has six legs and a body divided into three sections
- (1) insect antenna, (2) insect biology

#### bacteria

n. single-celled or noncellular spherical or spiral or rod-shaped organisms that exist in large numbers in the air, water, and soil, and also in living and dead creatures and plants, and are often a cause of disease

synonym: microorganism, microbe

# politician

 a person who is a member of a government or law-making organization, especially as an elected member of parliament, etc.

# exciting

#### medicinal

adj. of or relating to the treatment or cure of disease synonym: curative, therapeutic, healing

# archaeology

- n. the branch of anthropology that studies prehistoric people and their cultures

# diverge

# significance

# plague

 any epidemic disease with a high death rate; (also called pest) a serious, sometimes fatal, infection spread by rats that causes fever and swellings on the body

synonym: epidemic, pandemic, pest

synonym: importance, value, worth

(1) catch the **plague**, (2) deadly **plague**Our farm experienced a **plague** of locusts this year.

# survive

- v. to live or exist despite a dangerous event or period synonym: endure, persist, stay
- (1) **survive** a blizzard, (2) **survive** a plane crash These birds can only **survive** in temperate climates.

#### mutation

 the way in which genes of a person, plant, animal, or other organism change and produce permanent differences

synonym: metamorphosis, transformation, alteration

(1) **mutation** of DNA, (2) hereditary **mutation**Radiation often promotes genetic **mutations** in plants and animals.

# receptor

- an organ having nerve endings that respond to stimulation such as heat or cold and makes the body react in a particular way
- (1) cellular **receptor**, (2) **receptor** for HIV in humans Hay fever occurs when a substance called histamine binds to **receptors** in the nose and eyes.

# passe

 adj. no longer fashionable or current; outdated; considered to be old-fashioned or out of date

# population

 the total number of people in a country, region, or location

# rage

*n.* a strong feeling of anger or violence

synonym: fury, anger, outrage

# malaria

- a severe disease caused by a parasite that is spread by the bite of an infected mosquito
- (1) malaria mosquitoes, (2) malaria-endemic area

## sickle

 a tool consisting of a short curved blade with a handle, used for cutting grass or grain; also a symbol associated with harvest or death

synonym: scythe, crescent, cutter

The blade of the **sickle** glinted in the sunlight as he swung it back and forth.

#### cancer

 abnormal growth of cells that can invade and destroy surrounding tissues and organs; a disease characterized by the uncontrolled growth and spread of abnormal cells

*synonym*: tumor, carcinoma, malignancy

(1) cancer diagnosis, (2) cancer research

Breast **cancer** is the most common type of cancer in women.

#### toast

- slices of bread browned on both sides that have been put near a high heat; a drink in honor of or to the health of a person or even

We made a **toast** with everyone.

## crick

n. sharp pain or stiffness in the neck or back that typically results from a sudden twisting or wrenching movement

synonym: cramp, kink, spasm

I woke up with a **crick** in my neck from sleeping in an awkward position.

# structure

 the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts

synonym: construction, architecture, establishment

(1) the **structure** of a machine, (2) **structure** and function of the brain

The organizational **structure** of start-ups is often flat and straightforward.

# discovery

 the act or process of finding information, a place, or an object, or learning about something that was previously not known

synonym: finding, uncovering, detection

(1) a scientific **discovery**, (2) the great **discovery** of the century

Her research team made an important discovery.

# nifty

adj. attractive and stylish; clever and ingenious; neat and handy

*synonym*: cool, clever, ingenious

(1) nifty gadget, (2) nifty idea

The car has a **nifty** feature that alerts you when you're about to veer off the road.

### abundant

adj. present in great quantity

synonym: ample, plentiful, generative

(1) live an **abundant** life, (2) an **abundant** supply of water The country has **abundant** oil and natural gas resources.

#### cockroach

 a flat, brown or black, chiefly nocturnal insects sometimes found in the home

synonym: roach

cockroach killer, (2) have a cockroach phobia
 Cockroaches sometimes cause allergic reactions in humans.

#### trillion

- n. the number 1,000,000,000,000; a million million
- (1) **trillion** cubic feet, (2) many **trillions** of dollars One light year is nearly 6 **trillion** miles.

#### ameba

 a single-celled organism that typically has the shape of a small, round blob and moves by means of temporary projections called pseudopodia

synonym: protozoan, single-celled organism, unicellular organism

dub

gene

 n. the fundamental unit of heredity and the sequence of nucleotides in DNA that codes for the creation of RNA or protein.

genome

- *n.* the complete set or sequence of genes of a human, animal, plant, or other living things

efficient

adj. performing at the highest level of productivity with the least wasted effort or resources; capable of achieving maximum output with minimum wasted effort, time, or materials

storage

 the act or process of putting in and keeping something in a particular place for use in the future; an electronic memory device that can store information synonym: storehouse, depository, warehousing

(1) a **storage** battery, (2) **storage** at low temperature We store customer data in cloud **storage**.

# mechanism

 a part of a machine, or a set of parts that performs a task; a natural or established process that occurs during a specific situation or reaction

synonym: means, method, system

(1) the **mechanism** for DNA replication, (2) defense **mechanism** 

He discovered unique **mechanisms** for photochemical reactions.

# chip

- n. a small fragment of something broken off from the whole; a long and thin piece of potato fried in oil or fat synonym: flake, fragment, chunk
- (1) a **chip** of wood, (2) I don't care a **chip**We can use this campaign as a bargaining **chip** in the negotiations.

#### funk

 a feeling of sadness or depression; a low or unenergetic mood; a type of music that combines jazz, soul, and R and B

synonym: melancholy, depression, gloom

(1) funk music, (2) get in a funk

When she heard about her friend's illness, she fell into a deep **funk** that lasted for days.

#### nuclear

adj. of or relating to or constituting the nucleus of an atom; deriving destructive energy from the release of atomic energy

synonym: atomic

(1) **nuclear** fusion, (2) use of **nuclear** power

Many countries have now agreed to a treaty banning the use of **nuclear** weapons.

#### reactor

 a device or structure that is designed to contain a controlled nuclear chain reaction, producing heat or power; a device that initiates, drives, or controls a specific chemical reaction or process

synonym: generator, engine, power plant

(1) reactor meltdown, (2) breeder reactor

The nuclear **reactor** was shut down for maintenance and safety checks.

# microscope

- n. an instrument used to see objects or substances that are too small to be seen with the naked eyesynonym: lens, magnifier, eyepiece

# n. the most essential or fundamental part of somethingsynonym: center, basis, heart

# radiology

core

 the branch of medicine that uses medical imaging technologies such as X-rays, CT scans, MRIs, and ultrasound to diagnose and treat diseases and injuries

synonym: medical imaging, radiography, radioscopy

(1) interventional **radiology**, (2) diagnostic **radiology**The patient underwent a **radiology** scan to diagnose their medical condition.

## backstroke

- n. a swimming stroke performed on one's back, in which
  the arms are alternately raised over the head and pulled
  through the water while the legs move in a flutter kick
   synonym: back crawl, reverse stroke, dorsal swim
- (1) win with backstroke,(2) perfect backstrokeI swam the backstroke for the entire length of the pool.

#### chromosome

a long and string-like DNA molecule containing the part or all of the genetic material of an organism that controls what an animal or plant is like

synonym: DNA

(1) a sex **chromosome**, (2) the end of **chromosome** Human females normally have two X **chromosomes**.

#### stitch

- one of the tiny thread lines visible on a piece of fabric after it has been sewn
- (1) a **stitch** in a garment, (2) pattern **stitch** The wound was so deep that it needed a surgical procedure and stitches.

## radiation

the energy that comes from a nuclear reaction in the form of rays, waves, or particles and that can be hazardous to health

*synonym*: dissemination, emission, irradiation

- (1) exposure to **radiation**, (2) electromagnetic **radiation** He tried every possible treatment, including chemotherapy and radiation therapy.
- an indirect suggestion; a slight but appreciable amount of something

synonym: clue, indication, suggestion

#### diverse

adj. including numerous categories of individuals or entities; various

synonym: manifold, various, myriad

(1) diverse backgrounds, (2) a person of diverse talents New York is a city with a **diverse** ethnic population.

- a long or challenging search for something synonym: exploration, inquisition, pursuit
- (1) the **quest** for truth, (2) on a **quest** for happiness That adventurer traveled in **quest** of buried treasure.

# trench

 a long, deep ditch made in the ground, usually parallel to a plate boundary and marking a subduction zone; a long ditch built in the ground for carrying away water

synonym: aqueduct, ditch, channel

(1) deep-sea trench, (2) trench excavator

A **trench** was being dug alongside the road by workers.

#### odd

adj. strange or unexpected; not divisible by twosynonym: strange, bizarre, abnormal

(1) in an **odd** way, (2) **odd** behavior

His grandfather was an **odd** man.

# equivalent

- n. having the same value, quality, meaning, purpose, etc.synonym: equal, counterpart, match
- (1) **equivalent** amounts, (2) **equivalent** in meaning
  The European Central Bank is Europe's **equivalent** of the
  Federal Reserve.

# battery

- a device that is placed inside a car, gadget, equipment,
   etc. and that provides electrical power to them
- synonym: electric cell, array, batch
- (1) a dry battery, (2) battery charging

The engine did not start because the battery was flat.

#### acid

 sour; water-soluble chemicals with a sour flavor; any of a variety of generally liquid compounds capable of reacting with and occasionally dissolving other materials

synonym: Sour

(1) an **acid** reaction, (2) good source of essential amino **acids** 

During pregnancy, the stomach generates less **acid** than usual.

#### excrete

v. to discharge waste matter, such as urine or feces, from the body or a cell or gland

synonym: eliminate, expel, secrete

(1) excrete a sticky liquid, (2) excrete waste products

The body **excretes** excess salt through urine to maintain proper electrolyte balance.

#### sulfur

- n. (also sulphur) a chemical element with the symbol S and atomic number 16, found in many minerals and sulfur compounds, often used in the production of fertilizers, rubber, paper, and other industrial applications
- (1) sulfur dioxide, (2) sulfur mine

The **sulfur** emissions from the nearby factory caused the rotten egg smell.

#### archaea

n. a group of single-celled microorganisms distinguished from bacteria by their unique cell wall structure and biochemical characteristics, which are found in extreme environments such as hot springs and salt flats

synonym: microbe, microorganism

(1) **archaea** microorganism, (2) thermophile **archaea**The study of **archaea** is important for understanding the origins of life on Earth

ancient

adj. relating to the long ago, particularly the historical period preceding the fall of the Western Roman Empire; very old

synonym: archaic, age-old, obsolete

pre-Christian ancient, (2) ancient stories
 They have been living near water since ancient times.

melt

v. to turn from something solid into something soft or liquid as a result of heating

synonym: disintegrate, soften, disappear

(1) melt the ice, (2) melt down gold

Her resistance melted under his persuasion.

# whale

 a very large sea mammal that has a streamlined body and breathes through a blowhole on the head; a very large person; impressive in size or qualities

synonym: porpoise, giant

# (1) a bull **whale**, (2) **whale** watching

Some countries have a culture of eating the flesh of a **whale**.

# dolphin

 a marine mammal that typically has a beaklike snout, a streamlined body, and flippers and that feeds on fish and squid

synonym: porpoise, cetacean, marine mammal

(1) dolphin show, (2) dolphin-watching tour

The large group of **dolphins** swam gracefully in the ocean, jumping out of the water now and then.

# temporal

adj. of or relating to time as opposed to eternity synonym: transient, fleeting, temporary

(1) a temporal restriction, (2) temporal history

The **temporal** nature of the universe is a subject of much debate among scientists.

# humming

adj. producing a continuous, low, vibrating sound like that of the bee

synonym: buzzing, droning, vibrating

(1) humming sound, (2) humming bird

The **humming** of the bees filled the air as she walked through the garden.

# intellect

n. the ability to think logically and comprehend information, especially at an advanced level

synonym: mind, brightness, cleverness

(1) enrich my intellect, (2) human intellect

Your **intellect** is capable of distinguishing among similar objects.

#### conservation

 the protection of something important, such as the natural environment or artificial structures, especially from the damaging effects of human activity

synonym: preservation, protection, saving

(1) soil **conservation**, (2) the **conservation** law of physics

The forest was recently designated a **conservation** area.

## breed

v. to keep animals for producing offspring in a regulated manner

*synonym*: raise, multiply, reproduce

(1) breed horses, (2) breed suspicion

This animal **breeds** in northern latitudes.

#### extinct

adj. no longer in existence

synonym: dead, obsolete, abolished

(1) **extinct** by human activity, (2) long- **extinct** volcano Many species have become **extinct** due to habitat destruction and other human activities.

# naturally

adv. as might be expected; by natural manners

synonym: by nature, inherently, intrinsically

(1) **naturally** arising, (2) **naturally** regenerated forest He was **naturally** gifted.

#### insert

v. to put something inside something else

synonym: introduce, add, embed

(1) insert coin, (2) insert a graphic

She **inserted** a new chapter into her manuscript.

### fertilize

v. to cause an egg, female animal, or plant to develop by joining sperm from the male with them; to add a natural or chemical substance to land to make plants grow well

*synonym*: pollinate, inseminate, enrich

(1) **fertilize** the soil, (2) **fertilize** the female egg
The couple decided to use the non-husband sperm to **fertilize** a wife.

COW

 a domesticated mammal with characteristic features such as a hump, large udders, and curved horns that is raised for its milk or meat

synonym: bovine, cattle, kine

(1) cow herd, (2) dairy cow

The farmer milked the **cows** every morning before breakfast.

# reprogram

- v. to modify or recreate a program
- *synonym*: recreate, modify, revamp
- (1) **reprogram** a device, (2) **reprogram** a database He **reprogrammed** the computer's operating system to remove the safeguard.

# experiment

 the scientific test conducted to observe what happens and gain new knowledge

synonym: experimentation, investigation

(1) **experiment** design, (2) series of **experiments** His **experiments** showed highly positive results.

eland

 a species of large African antelope known for its long, spiraled horns and being one of the slowest-running antelopes

synonym: eland antelope, giant eland, common eland

(1) eland population, (2) African eland

The **eland** herd moved gracefully across the savannah at dawn.

#### bless

 to make or pronounce holy; to hallow; to consecrate; to sanctify

synonym: sanctify, consecrate, hallow

(1) bless him in my heart, (2) bless you

The priest **blessed** the couple as they knelt before him.

gap

 a conspicuous disparity or difference separates something such as a figure, people, their opinions, situation, etc.

synonym: opening, lacuna, spread

(1) the **gap** between ideal and reality, (2) distance **gap**Many people are working together to close the gender **gap**.

#### deteriorate

- v. to become worse in quality; to decline or degeneratesynonym: decline, degenerate, regress
- (1) **deteriorate** at a slow pace, (2) **deteriorate** condition The patient's health **deteriorated** rapidly after being diagnosed with the disease.

# string

 long, thin material used for tying things together, composed of several twisted threads

synonym: line, wire, rope

(1) retie the **string** and make it strong, (2) tense piano **strings** 

She wore a **string** of pearls around her neck.

# dodo

 a flightless bird that was endemic to the island of Mauritius, characterized by its stout body, small wings, and hooked beak; an extinct bird species that was last seen in the late 17th century

synonym: extinct bird, flightless bird

(1) dodo population, (2) extinct dodo

The last known sighting of a flightless **dodo** was recorded in the late 17th century.

# primordial

 adj. existing from the beginning of time or the start of a particular process; relating to the earliest stage of the universe

synonym: ancient, original, primary

(1) primordial forms of life, (2) primordial gas

The discovery of the **primordial** soup was a crucial step in understanding the origins of life on Earth.

#### ancestor

- n. a person from whom one is descended; a forefathersynonym: forebear, forefather, progenitor
- (1) **ancestor** language, (2) earliest human **ancestor**My remote **ancestor** immigrated to the United States from Ireland in the 1800s.

#### evolve

v. to develop gradually, or to cause the development of something or someone gradually

synonym: develop, mature, grow

# collapse

ooze

v. to fall down or give way suddenly, often after breaking apart

*synonym*: tumble, spill, bankruptcy

### sequence

*n.* a series of related events, actions, numbers, etc., which have a particular order

facility

 a building or place that provides a particular service or is used for a particular industry

synonym: building, structure, installation

(1) a cell phone with an internet **facility**, (2) **facility** design This company has an entire recycling **facility**, including major reprocessing plants.

doll

 a child's toy that typically represents a human figure, especially a young girl; an attractive woman; a woman who is subservient or passive synonym: puppet, dolly, toy

(1) plastic **doll**, (2) rag **doll** 

The antique **doll** was worth thousands of dollars.

# boring

adj. lacking interest or excitement; tedious or dull synonym: dull, tedious, monotonous

(1) **boring** work, (2) **boring** day

The lecture was so **boring** that many people fell asleep.

neat

adj. clean or tidy, with everything in its placesynonym: tidy, uncluttered, refined

(1) a **neat** piece of work, (2) **neat** idea

She has **neat** habits.

# **Ebola**

 a highly contagious and often fatal viral disease that causes severe fever and internal bleeding, primarily occurring in remote areas of Central and West Africa

synonym: viral hemorrhagic fever, EVD

(1) **Ebola** epidemic, (2) **Ebola** virus

The **Ebola** outbreak in West Africa caused widespread panic and fear.

# deadly

adj. likely to cause or capable of causing death synonym: fatal, lethal, harmful

(1) fight against the **deadly** disease, (2) a **deadly** weapon The members of religious organizations released **deadly** poisonous gas on a subway train.

disease

 a disorder or illness that affects the body or mind, often characterized by specific symptoms or abnormal functioning of organs or systems

synonym: illness, ailment, affliction

(1) disease prevention, (2) disease control

The doctor diagnosed him with a rare **disease** that had no known cure.

# floppy

adj. not stiff or firm; hanging looselysynonym: limp, flaccid, pliable

(1) floppy infant, (2) floppy hat

The puppy's ears were still too long and **floppy** for its head.

disk

 a flat, circular plate, typically made of metal, glass, or plastic, used for storing data or playing music

synonym: record, platter, plate

(1) disk drive, (2) disk space

The computer's hard **disk** was full, so she had to delete some files.

absorb

- v. to take in a fluid or other substance gradually synonym: consume, soak, ingest
- (1) **absorb** energy, (2) **absorb** a shock The sponge **absorbs** water well.

execute

v. to kill someone, especially as a legal punishment; to carry out or perform an action, duty, etc.

synonym: direct, conduct, enforce

(1) **execute** a bold strategy, (2) **execute** a double play The mafioso who collaborated with the police was **executed**.

thump

v. to strike or hit heavily or repeatedly, often with a dull, resonating sound; to pound or beat forcefully

synonym: beat, thud, pound


