## surgery

medical treatment of injuries or diseases involving an incision with instruments and often removing or replacing some parts of the body; the branch of medical science that treats disease or injury by operative procedures

synonym: operation, (medical) procedure

cardiac surgery,
 the professor of surgery
 had undergone heart surgery years before.

#### backward

adv. at, to, or toward the direction or place that is behind or rear

synonym: back, rearward, in reverse

(1) walk backward, (2) backward angle

She falls over **backward** when she sees her mother-in-law.

# asleep

adj. in a state of sleep

synonym: sleeping, fallen, at rest

(1) asleep at the wheel, (2) dead asleep

He lay down and fell **asleep** immediately.

#### anesthesia

- a state of controlled, temporary loss of bodily sensation or awareness that is induced for medical purposes
- (1) anesthesia for surgery, (2) local anesthesia

He is in general anesthesia under the surgeon.

# complicated

adj. involving a lot of different things or parts in a way that is difficult to understand or analyze

synonym: complex, convoluted, intricate

(1) a **complicated** process, (2) become increasingly **complicated** 

He did **complicated** pen-and-ink drawings in just a few days.

#### unconscious

adj. in the state of lacking awareness and the capacity for sensory perception, especially as the result of a head injury or illness

synonym: comatose, paralyzed, senseless

(1) **unconscious** bias, (2) a person who is **unconscious** I know his **unconscious** habit that he touches his face when he lies.

hop

to jump lightly and quickly on one foot or both feet; to move rapidly from one place to another; to travel using an aircraft, bus, etc.

synonym: jump, bounce, skip

(1) **hop** on one foot, (2) **hop** from one place to another The rabbit **hopped** over the fence.

# process

n. a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

synonym: procedure, method, system

(1) **process** improvement, (2) decision-making **process** The **process** for applying for a visa can be lengthy and complicated.

#### traumatic

adj. relating to or caused by injury, especially emotional injury

synonym: distressing

(1) traumatic event, (2) traumatic brain injury

The experience was so **traumatic** that it left a lasting impact on the survivor's mental health.

#### ancient

adj. relating to the long ago, particularly the historical period preceding the fall of the Western Roman Empire; very old

*synonym*: archaic, age-old, obsolete

(1) pre-Christian ancient, (2) ancient stories

They have been living near water since **ancient** times.

## medical

adj. relating to the treatment of illness or injuries; relating to the practice of medicine

synonym: health, disease, treatment

(1) a **medical** opinion, (2) temporary **medical** treatment The **medical** team worked quickly to save the patient's life.

#### anesthetic

 a substance that is administered to a person or an animal to produce a loss of sensation or consciousness so that medical or surgical procedures can be performed without causing pain

synonym: sedative, anesthesia, painkiller

(1) anesthetic injection, (2) local anesthetic

The dentist administered an **anesthetic** to numb the patient's mouth before the procedure.

## opioid

- substances that have an effect similar to opium, such as morphine, used in medicines to treat severe pain, but some people take them illegally for pleasure and become addicted
- (1) an **opioid** analgesic, (2) **opioid** receptor Treatment for **opioid** dependence may be a long-term process.

#### poppy

 a plant with large, showy flowers of various colors, including red, pink, yellow, and white, and a capsule containing small seeds, and some species of poppy are used to produce opium and its derivatives

(1) poppy tea, (2) poppy seeds

She wore a red **poppy** on her lapel to honor the veterans.

#### mandrake

- a plant with a forked root that is said to resemble the human body and that has long been used in traditional medicine and folklore
- (1) mandrake cultivation, (2) mandrake plant

The **mandrake** root has been used in traditional medicine for centuries.

#### alcohol

 a clear liquid that can make people drunk and is used in medicines, cleaning products, etc.

synonym: booze, liquor, ethanol

(1) stop drinking **alcohol**, (2) diluted **alcohol**There is a clear association between **alcohol** consumption and cognitive decline.

# anesthesiologist

 a medical doctor who specializes in administering anesthesia to help control pain and monitor the vital signs of patients during procedures and surgeries

synonym: anesthetist, pain specialist, sedationist

(1) specialized anesthesiologist, (2) clinical anesthesiologist

The experienced **anesthesiologist** monitored the patient's vital signs throughout the procedure.

#### combine

- v. to join or merge to form a single thing or group synonym: coalesce, cohere, blend
- (1) **combine** chemically with another substance,
- (2) combine augmented reality

Hydrogen and oxygen combine to form water.

## inhale

- v. to breathe in air or a different substance, such as smoke synonym: breathe in, take in, draw in
- (1) **inhale** the smoke, (2) **inhale** the aroma

He **inhaled** deeply, trying to calm down.

#### venous

adj. relating to, situated in, or carrying blood through the veins of the body

synonym: vascular

(1) **venous** blood, (2) **venous** thrombosis

The patient was diagnosed with a **venous** clot in his leg, requiring immediate medical attention.

# agent

n. a person who represents and negotiates on behalf of someone else, such as a literary agent or talent agent; (of chemistry and medicine) a substance that brings about a chemical or physical effect; (of computer science) a piece of software that performs a task autonomously

synonym: representative, delegate, envoy

(1) agent system, (2) antidiarrheal agent

The FBI **agent** went undercover to infiltrate the criminal organization.

## balance

 a condition in which everything has the same weight or force; something left after other parts have been taken away

synonym: equilibrium, counterpoise, remainder

(1) the **balance** of power, (2) asset on the company's **balance** sheet

Try to keep a balance between work and off.

# specific

adj. clearly defined or particular to a certain thing or situation; distinct, explicit, and precise

*synonym*: particular, definite, distinct

(1) **specific** instructions, (2) industry- **specific** regulations The scientist conducted a study that provided **specific** details about the species' behavior.

## brain

n. the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feeling

synonym: intellect, mind, encephalon

basic brain function, (2) permanent brain damage
 rays revealed a small tumor in his brain.

#### mess

n. a state of confusion, dirtiness, or untidiness; (verb) to fail to do something or to make something dirty or untidy

synonym: disarray, confusion, predicament

(1) have a whole **mess**, (2) get into a **mess** He made a frightful **mess** in his room.

#### nervous

adj. worried and anxious about something; relating to the nerves

synonym: neural, anxious, uneasy

(1) development of the **nervous** system, (2) get **nervous** He suffers from **nervous** breakdowns.

#### electrical

adj. relating to electricity

(1) an **electrical** storm, (2) degree in **electrical** engineering Actuators convert **electrical** pulses into motion.

# impulse

 a sudden strong and unreflective wish or need to do something; the electrical discharge that travels along a nerve fiber

synonym: stimulation, provocation, urge

(1) a combative **impulse**, (2) profound religious **impulses**Nerve **impulses** cross a synapse through the action of neurotransmitters.

#### barricade

 a barrier, often improvised or temporary, used to block passage or protect against danger or attack

synonym: barrier, obstacle, blockade

(1) **barricade** fencing, (2) police **barricade**The protestors built a **barricade** to prevent police from entering the area.

## bind

v. to tie or fasten someone or something tightly with rope, string, etc. so that they cannot move or are held together

# strongly

synonym: tie, stick to, adhere

(1) **bind** the man's hands, (2) **bind** old letters into a bundle The company's rules **bind** the employee's working hours.

## protein

- a molecule made up of a long chain of amino acids,
   which is essential for the structure and function of the body's tissues
- (1) stress **protein**, (2) **protein** synthesis The body needs a certain amount of **protein** to build and repair tissues.

#### neuron

- a cell that is specialized to carry information within the brain and between the brain and other parts of the body
   synonym: nerve cell
- (1) excite the **neurons**, (2) **neuron** cell body Our body transfers information along each **neuron** using an electrical impulse.

## membrane

- n. a soft, thin layer that forms animal or vegetable tissuesynonym: tissue layer
- (1) cell **membranes**, (2) nuclear **membrane**Loud noises might harm the fragile ear **membrane**.

# particle

- a small piece of something; a word or piece of a term with grammatical function but little or no significance
   synonym: atom, grain, bit
- (1) charged **particle**, (2) **particle** energy
  We can calculate the position of the **particles** statistically.

# posit

v. to suggest or accept something as fact or as a basis for argument or consideration

synonym: assert, declare, assume

(1) **posit** the existence of life after death, (2) **posit** the premise

We should **posit** several hypotheses to discuss the matter.

## compound

 an item composed of two or more distinct elements combined; a chemical formed by the combination of two or more elements

synonym: combination, mixture, blend

(1) aquatic **compound**, (2) harmful **compound**. Common salt is a sodium and chlorine **compound**.

#### cocaine

n. a highly addictive stimulant drug that is derived from the leaves of the coca plant, often used recreationally for its euphoric effects but also used in medicine as a local anesthetic and vasoconstrictor

synonym: narcotic, coke, snow

(1) powder **cocaine**, (2) **cocaine** overdose

The drug dealer was arrested for possession of **cocaine**.

# painkiller

- n. medicine used to relieve physical pain synonym: anesthetic, anodyne, analgesic
- (1) a strong **painkiller**, (2) take a **painkiller** beforehand Over-the-counter **painkillers** are less effective for patients who have taken many in the past.

# discovery

 the act or process of finding information, a place, or an object, or learning about something that was previously not known

synonym: finding, uncovering, detection

(1) a scientific **discovery**, (2) the great **discovery** of the century

Her research team made an important **discovery**.

#### accident

an unfortunate event, especially one causing damage or injury

synonym: calamity, casualty, chance

(1) cause an **accident**, (2) injury in a car **accident**The **accident** partially destroyed my vehicle.

# ophthalmology

 the branch of medicine that deals with the anatomy, physiology, and diseases of the eye synonym: eye care, optometry, eye medicine

(1) **ophthalmology** practice, (2) **ophthalmology** clinic My grandfather had a problem with his eyes and went to an **ophthalmology** specialist.

#### intern

to put someone in prison, especially for political or military reasons; (noun) a student or trainee who works, sometimes for free, to get work experience or to fulfill qualification criteria

*synonym*: apprentice, trainee, student

(1) intern civilians, (2) medical intern

The navy **interned** ships of defeated nations.

# tongue

 a moveable mass of muscle tissue covered with mucous membrane that is in the mouth; a language

synonym: lingo, language, vocabulary

(1) native **tongue**, (2) **tongue** cancer

The **tongue** is boneless, but it is as strong as bones.

# occasionally

adv. now and then; sometimes but not often

synonym: periodically, sometimes, from time to time

(1) **occasionally** dine with friends, (2) **occasionally** change the routine

She still occasionally writes a short romance novel.

#### chemical

adj. relating to or connected with chemistry;

synonym: chemic, synthetic

(1) toxic chemicals, (2) a chemical compound

The firm has grown into a large chemical manufacturing.

#### structure

 the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts

synonym: construction, architecture, establishment

(1) the **structure** of a machine, (2) **structure** and function of the brain

The organizational **structure** of start-ups is often flat and straightforward.

## medicinal

adj. of or relating to the treatment or cure of disease synonym: curative, therapeutic, healing

(1) **medicinal** chemistry, (2) traditional **medicinal**The **medicinal** properties of this herb have been known to

help with various ailments.

# ethyl

- n. a chemical compound derived from ethane, used in producing many industrial chemicals and as a solvent, commonly used as a prefix for chemicals containing one or more ethyl groups
- (1) ethyl group, (2) ethyl acetate

The laboratory uses **ethyl** alcohol as a cleaning solvent for equipment.

## ethereal

adj. delicate, light, and airy; extremely refined or subtle; heavenly or spiritual

synonym: airy, delicate, celestial

(1) ethereal beauty, (2) ethereal light

The **ethereal** music created a dreamlike atmosphere in the concert hall.

#### recreational

adj. relating to or for leisure or pleasure; done for enjoyment rather than work or duty

synonym: leisure, fun, entertaining

(1) a recreational center, (2) recreational drugs

I enjoy **recreational** activities such as hiking and swimming.

# injury

n. harm done to a person's or an animal's body caused by an accident or an attack

synonym: wound, damage, hurt

(1) without **injury**, (2) a fatal **injury** 

My accidental **injury** got better right away.

#### influence

n. the ability to affect someone's or something's character, growth, or behavior, or the effect itself

synonym: power, leverage, effect

(1) **influence** a child's future, (2) **influence** the daily life The former emperor had a particular **influence** even after he abdicated.

#### sedate

adj. calm, tranquil, and composed, often as a result of being under the influence of a sedative or tranquilizer; unhurried, deliberate, and without excessive movement or activity

synonym: calm, composed, tranquil

sedate atmosphere, (2) sedate patient
 sedate environment of the library was perfect for studying.

# patient

 a person who is receiving medical treatment, care, or attention from a healthcare professional, such as a doctor, nurse, or therapist; a personal quality or characteristic

synonym: client, recipient, subject

(1) **patient** in the hospital, (2) **patient** with weight loss. The doctor carefully examined the **patient's** medical history.

## dental

adj. of or relating to teeth
synonym: oral, tooth, mouth

(1) dental hygiene, (2) dental care

I have a **dental** appointment at 2 pm to get my teeth cleaned.

#### extract

a short passage taken from a book, piece of music, etc.;
 a substance obtained from something through a specific process; (verb) to obtain from something or to remove something by effort or force

synonym: excerpt, quote, distillation

(1) a brief **extract** from the book, (2) botanical **extract** Anesthetize the gum before **extracting** the teeth.

#### oxide

- a chemical compound that contains at least one oxygen atom and one other element
- (1) silver **oxide**, (2) combined **oxide**

The blood's red coloring comes from iron **oxide**.

#### derivative

 something which is based on another thing or word or idea; a financial instrument whose value is based on another security

*synonym*: by-product, spin-off, offshoot

(1) derivative works, (2) derivative products

French is a **derivative** of Latin.

# supplement

 something that is added to something else to make it better or complete it

synonym: complement, addendum, accessory

(1) wage **supplement**, (2) use of dietary **supplements** Certain **supplements** may promote tumor growth.

# develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) develop a strategy, (2) develop a skill

We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

#### sedative

 a drug or medication that has a calming or sleep-inducing effect on the body and mind; something that soothes or pacifies

synonym: calmative, tranquilizer, sleeping pill

(1) **sedative** medication, (2) take a **sedative** 

The doctor prescribed a **sedative** to help me sleep.

#### induce

v. to persuade someone to do something; to cause to act in a specific manner

synonym:

# cause, encourage, persuade

(1) **induce** a crisis, (2) **induce** him to see a doctor

The lack of sleep **induces** both physical and psychological diseases.

# fentanyl

 a potent synthetic opioid pain medication often used to treat severe or chronic pain, which is highly addictive and can be very dangerous or lethal in high doses

synonym: opiate, narcotic, painkiller

(1) **fentanyl** patch, (2) **fentanyl** overdose

The abuse of **fentanyl** has reached epidemic proportions in some parts of the country.

# normally

adv. usually; under normal conditionssynonym: commonly, generally, naturally

(1) complete **normally**, (2) not **normally** drink much I don't **normally** take a vacation in the middle of summer.

## chaotic

adj. without any order or organization; extremely disorganized, unpredictable, and confusing

synonym: disorderly, cluttered, topsy-turvy

(1) the **chaotic** economic situation, (2) **chaotic** theory Change is also occurring in Turkey as a result of **chaotic** reform.

#### chorus

a group of singers or speakers who perform together,
 typically in a musical or dramatic production; the part of
 a song where a soloist is joined by a group of singers

synonym: ensemble, choir, group of singers

(1) a mixed **chorus**, (2) a quintet **chorus**The **chorus** of the song was catchy and easily memorized.

# communicate

v. to share or exchange information with others by speaking, writing, moving your body, or using other signals

*synonym*: convey, share, transmit

- (1) **communicate** his anxieties to the psychiatrist,
- (2) communicate well with my advisor

Dolphins use sound to **communicate** with each other.

# connectivity

n. the state or quality of being connected or interconnected; the ability of devices, systems, or networks to communicate with and exchange information with each other

synonym: linkage, network

(1) digital **connectivity**, (2) global **connectivity**The hotel offers high-speed internet **connectivity** for all its guests.

## anesthetize

v. to administer a drug or other substance that causes a loss of sensation or consciousness, often to perform a medical procedure; to numb or dull a physical or emotional sensation

synonym: numb, sedate, drug

- (1) **anesthetize** a patient, (2) **anesthetize** a wound The dentist will **anesthetize** your mouth before removing your wisdom teeth.
- adj. not excited, angry, or nervous; free from wind, large waves

synonym: quiet, peaceful, tranquility

(1) calm sea, (2) calm manner

It was the first time in a long time that I felt truly **calm** and at peace.

## organ

calm

 a part of the body of an animal or plant that has a particular purpose and performs a specific job

synonym: function, structure

(1) **organ** bleeding, (2) damage to internal **organs**These infections have the potential to impact practically every **organ** system.

sever

v. to break or separate something by cutting, especially suddenly and forcibly

synonym: cut apart, separate, detach

(1) **sever** a rope, (2) **sever** a positive relationship He **severed** a branch from a tree quickly.

receptor

- an organ having nerve endings that respond to stimulation such as heat or cold and makes the body react in a particular way
- (1) cellular **receptor**, (2) **receptor** for HIV in humans Hay fever occurs when a substance called histamine binds to **receptors** in the nose and eyes.

gateway

n. an entrance, door, or other openings that lead to a larger space, particularly one that serves as an entry point or access point to a larger area or system; a route, means, or method used to gain access to or acquire something

synonym: portal, entrance, access

(1) gateway drug, (2) airport gateway

The **gateway** to the city was a beautiful archway made of stone.

# negative

- adj. having the quality of something bad or harmful; expressing refusal
- synonym: minus, adverse, pessimistic
- (1) have a **negative** effect, (2) a **negative** number The movie has received almost universally **negative** criticism.

jam

 a situation in which something becomes stuck because of a dense crowd of people, vehicles, etc.; a preserve of crushed fruit

*synonym*: difficulty, mess, preserve

(1) a traffic **jam**, (2) a jar of **jam** 

The shredder in the print room often has paper **jams**.

#### transmit

v. to send or forward an electronic signal; to pass something from one person or thing to another

*synonym*: convey, share, dispatch

(1) **transmit** the disease, (2) **transmit** information

Parents often **transmit** their characteristics to their children.

# pathway

 a track that constitutes or serves as a path; an approach or a way of doing something

synonym: route, footpath, trail

(1) **pathway** to understanding, (2) cellular signaling **pathways** 

When the first molecule in the **pathway** receives a signal, it activates other molecules.

## movement

 a group of people working together to achieve a shared goal, especially a political, social, or artistic one; the process of moving or being moved, physically or figuratively

synonym: motion, progression, action

(1) a circular **movement**, (2) **movement** of troops

The **movement** of the dancers on stage was graceful and

elegant.

#### conscious

adj. being aware of and able to respond to what is happening around you

synonym: aware, cognizant, deliberate

(1) **conscious** effort, (2) **conscious** of having succeeded He became **conscious** that he was being followed.

# probable

adj. likely to happen or likely to be true

synonym: likely, possible, potential

(1) **probable** outcome, (2) **probable** cause of a fire It seems **probable** that he has forgotten our scheduled meeting.

## lung

 either of the two organs in the chest that people and some animals use for breathing (1) **lung** capacity, (2) do **lung** transplantation He has terminal **lung** cancer.

vital

poison

adj. necessary for the success or continued existence of something

synonym: critical, crucial, invigorating

- (1) play a **vital** role, (2) **vital** for a healthy society Perseverance and optimism are **vital** to success.
- n. a substance that can cause illness, injury, or death when ingested, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin; something harmful, malicious, or toxic; the act of damaging or ruining a relationship; (verb) to introduce a substance into something or someone harmful and potentially deadly

synonym: toxin, venom, pollutant

(1) **poison** ivy, (2) **poison** bilateral relations

The plant's leaves contain a deadly **poison** that can cause hallucinations and seizures.

hemlock

- a poisonous plant with a characteristic odor, having white or purple flowers and finely divided leaves
   synonym: conium, devil's porridge
- (4)
- (1) **hemlock** grove, (2) poison **hemlock Hemlock** trees are often used as ornamental plants but can be dangerous if ingested.

aconite

n. a highly toxic plant of the buttercup family, also known as monkshood or wolfsbane, containing alkaloid poisons, historically used as a poison or in traditional medicine for its sedative and analgesic properties

synonym: monkshood, wolf's bane

(1) aconite extract, (2) aconite plant

The detective suspected **aconite** poisoning when the victim showed severe gastrointestinal distress and respiratory failure symptoms.

#### modern

adj. of or belonging to the present time or recent timessynonym: contemporary, stylish, current

(1) **modern** poetry, (2) pre- **modern** agricultural society Their headquarters are in a **modern** skyscraper.

#### feat

 a notable or impressive achievement, especially one that requires great skill or bravery

synonym: achievement, accomplishment, exploit

(1) intellectual **feat**, (2) **feat** accomplishment It is an incredible **feat** to climb Mount Everest, the highest mountain in the world.

#### monitor

v. to observe, check, and track the progress or quality of something over a period of time

synonym: proctor, check, observe

(1) **monitor** an exam, (2) **monitor** the data carefully They used a special receiver to **monitor** police radio channels.

# adjust

v. to make a minor modification to something to make it more suited for a new set of conditions or to make it function better.

synonym: adapt, alter, acclimate

(1) **adjust** a schedule, (2) **adjust** the rearview mirror You have to **adjust** your content to the age of the audience.

mixture

 a combination of different elements, substances, or entities, usually in non-uniform proportions, resulting in a homogeneous or heterogeneous blend of physical or chemical properties

*synonym*: blend, amalgam, concoction

(1) mixture of emotions, (2) perfect mixture

The paint was a **mixture** of different pigments to achieve the desired color.

# technique

a particular way or art of doing something that needs skill

synonym: approach, procedure, strategy

(1) a **technique** in martial arts, (2) the **technique** applied to construction

Jockey's superior **technique** brought him victory.

## surgeon

 a doctor who is trained to perform medical operations that involve cutting open a person's body

*synonym*: sawbones, doctor

(1) an excellent brain **surgeon**, (2) army **surgeon**He is a skilled **surgeon** that has many years of training and experience.

# routinely

adv. on a regular or habitual basis; in a manner that is customary or expected

synonym: habitually, regularly, customarily

(1) **routinely** check, (2) **routinely** scheduled maintenance They **routinely** conduct fire drills to ensure everyone in the building knows what to do in an emergency.

#### cesarean

adj. (also known as "C-section") relating to the delivery of a baby through a surgical incision made in the mother's abdomen and uterus rather than through vaginal birth

synonym: C-section, surgical birth

(1) **cesarean** delivery, (2) emergency **cesarean**The **cesarean** recovery period can be longer and more challenging than a vaginal birth recovery.

artery

n. one of the thick tubes in humans and most other animals that takes blood away from the heart to one or more parts of the body such as tissues, lungs, brain, etc.

synonym: blood vessel, channel, roadway

(1) **artery** blockage, (2) risk of coronary **artery** disease Continuous consumption of fatty foods leads to the hardening of the **artery**.

# replace

v. to take the place of something

synonym: substitute, supersede, displace

(1) <b>replace</b> one word with another,	(2) <b>replace</b> a phone
Eventually, the new design will repla	ace all older models.

dam

a wall constructed over a river to block the flow of water, mainly used to generate energy

synonym: barricade, barrier, embankment

- (1) dam-building program, (2) dam collapsing
- The break in the **dam** threatened the valley.

liver

- a large organ in the body, involved in many metabolic processes, such as detoxification of the organism, and the synthesis of proteins
- (1) liver disease, (2) fatty liver The patient will undergo **liver** transplant surgery tomorrow.

kidney

- either of a pair of small organs in the body that filter waste products, especially urea, from the blood and excrete them and water in urine
- (1) an artificial **kidney**, (2) chronic **kidney** disease The surgeon removed the healthy **kidney** from the donor.

lifesaving

- the act or process of rescuing someone else's life, especially from drowning
