photosynthesis

- n. the process through which plants and other organisms transform light energy into chemical energy, which is then released through cellular respiration to power the organism's activities.
- (1) oxygenic **photosynthesis**, (2) process of **photosynthesis**

In **photosynthesis**, plants use carbon dioxide to feed themselves.

stabilize

v. to become or cause to become steady or unlikely to give way

synonym: brace, steady, secure

The raising of interest rates **stabilizes** the inflation rate.

slideshow

 a presentation of a series of images, typically with accompanying music, that can be displayed on a computer or other device

synonym: presentation, visual display

panoramic

adj. relating to an unobstructed and wide view of an extensive area; all-encompassing

synonym: expansive, wide-ranging, scenic

(1) **panoramic** landscape, (2) **panoramic** camera We hiked to the top of the hill for a **panoramic** view of the city below.

dataset

 a structured collection of data that is compiled and processed in a computer system or program, typically for analysis, research, or machine learning purposes

synonym: data array, database

(1) dataset analysis, (2) publicly available dataset
The scientist analyzed the large dataset to conclude the experiment.

cathedral

- n. the main Christian church of a bishop's diocese, which is often the largest and most important church in the areasynonym: church, basilica, temple
- (1) **cathedral** school, (2) **cathedral** choir
 The **cathedral's** stained glass windows depicted scenes from the Bible.

scrape

v. to draw something along a rough or hard surface, typically to remove dirt or other matter

synonym: scratch, graze, rub

(1) **scrape** meat off a bone, (2) **scrape** a hole in the ground He **scraped** the mud off his boots before entering the house.

gratify

v. to give pleasure or satisfaction to; to provide someone with what they want or need; to indulge or satisfy a desire or appetite

synonym: please, satisfy, fulfill

(1) gratify desires, (2) gratify curiosity

I always try to **gratify** my boss by achieving the sales target every month.

occlude

- v. to obstruct or block something, usually a passage or opening, in a way that prevents normal flow or access
 synonym: block, obstruct, close
- (1) **occlude** a blood vessel, (2) **occlude** the ureteral orifice The traffic jam **occluded** the road and caused a significant delay in the journey.

emergent

adj. starting to exist or view, or to become knownsynonym: coming, appearing, developing

(1) **emergent** repair of an aorta, (2) an **emergent** republic Extensive areas of **emergent** plants are usually called marsh.

enrich

 to make better or improve in quality by adding something else

synonym: enhance, improve, augment

- (1) **enrich** a gas with a balloon, (2) **enrich** public services Reading not only increases knowledge but also **enriches** life.
- adj. pertaining to or involving a higher or more abstract level of analysis, interpretation, or self-reference, often used to describe aspects of gaming, social media, or other online communities that involve self-conscious or self-referential elements

synonym: self-referential, introspective, recursive

multimodal
