generation

- all the people born and living at about the same time, regarded collectively; the production of heat or electricitysynonym: cohort, age group, era

notion

 a general idea or understanding of something, particularly an abstract or complex concept; a belief or opinion, often one that is not based on solid evidence or facts

encounter

v. to face something, particularly something unpleasant or difficult, while attempting to do something else; to meet, especially unexpectedly

precondition

 a necessary condition or requirement that must be met for something else to happen or be possible

synonym: requisite, prerequisite, stipulation

decision

 the act or process of making up someone's mind about something; a choice or judgment reached after considering options

synonym: choice, determination, judgment

arbitrary

adj. based on chance, or individual whim rather than any reason

synonym: autocratic, dictatorial, whimsical

obvious

adj. easy to see, discover or understand synonym: apparent, conspicuous, evident

obsess

v. to fill the mind of someone continually so that one can't think of anything else

synonym: torment, beset, engross

convinced

adj. completely certain about something; having a strong belief or conviction in a particular religion

synonym: confident, positive, indoctrinated

advantage

 a condition or circumstance that puts one in a favorable or superior position; a beneficial feature or asset that someone or something has

synonym: benefit, edge, asset

One of the main **advantages** of the new product is its increased efficiency.

disadvantage

- n. a drawback or a negative aspect of something; (verb) to put someone or something in an unfavorable position
 synonym: detriment, drawback, (verb) disfavor

A lack of education can be a significant **disadvantage** in today's job market.

accident

an unfortunate event, especially one causing damage or injury

synonym: obtain, gain, acquire

 a person who collects and writes news stories or articles for newspapers, magazines, radio, television, or other online media

interrogate

devastating

conversation

 an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

adv. relating to the essential features or concepts of anything *synonym*: fundamentally, basically, virtually

v. to assert that something is true; to demand or request something as one's own; to lay legal or moral right to something; (noun) a demand or assertion of a right or something that one believes to be true

synonym: assert, declare, maintain

weird

adj. extraordinary, unexpected, or difficult to explain synonym: bizarre, creepy, peculiar

(1) a weird dress, (2) the state of being weird

My computer has been acting **weird** recently.

pause

 to take a short break from talking or doing something before continuing

synonym: halt, break, intermit

(1) pause a moment, (2) pause for a reaction

The man **paused** before opening the door.

critic

 someone who expresses opinions about the quality of books, music, etc.

synonym: pundit, analyst, attacker

(1) art critic, (2) severe critic

Advocates for legal reform hear less harsh words from their **critics**.

context

 n. the circumstances, facts, or conditions that surround a particular event, situation, or statement and that give it meaning

synonym: background, setting, environment

(1) historical context, (2) legal context

It's important to understand the **context** of a situation before making a decision.

intellect

n. the ability to think logically and comprehend information, especially at an advanced level

synonym: mind, brightness, cleverness

(1) enrich my intellect, (2) human intellect

Your **intellect** is capable of distinguishing among similar objects.

brilliant

adj. extremely clever, skilled, or impressive

synonym: luminous, intelligent, clever

ordinary

adj. not different, exceptional, or unexpected in any way, especially in quality, ability, size, or degree

extraordinary

adj. exceptional, unexpected, very unusual; surpassing the ordinary or usual

synonym: exceptional, noteworthy, astonishing

suppose

- v. to think that something is likely to be actual or possible synonym: guess, assume, presume
- (1) **suppose** you're right, (2) **suppose** beforehand What do you **suppose** the culprit's motive was?

silent

adj. without any or little soundsynonym: quiet, hushed, mute

silent reading, (2) give silent consent
 The politician remained silent despite intense media scrutiny.

subsequent

- adj. happening or occurring later or after something else synonym: later, following, ensuing

gruff

modest

 adj. having or showing a humble estimate of one's merits, importance, etc.; free from vanity, egotism, boastfulness, or great pretensions

synonym: unassuming, humble, unpretentious

(1) **modest** income, (2) only a **modest** fee

Despite his many achievements, he remained **modest** and down-to-earth.

assemble

- v. to collect in one place as a single group synonym: gather, congregate, collect
- (1) **assemble** your colleagues, (2) **assemble** a jigsaw puzzle

The president began to **assemble** an army.

shuck

v. to remove the shell or outer covering of something, such as a corn or an oyster; to discard or get rid of something, particularly something that is seen as useless or unwanted

synonym: peel, husk, shell

justify

to provide a valid or reasonable explanation, reasoning, or evidence in support of a belief, action, or decision; to

awful

barrier

 a fence or other obstruction that makes it hard to move or get in; any condition that makes it difficult to make progress or to achieve an objective

synonym: border, barricade, fence

(1) cost barrier, (2) information barrier

The police placed a **barrier** across the street to halt traffic.

reprogram

- v. to modify or recreate a program synonym: recreate, modify, revamp
- (1) **reprogram** a device, (2) **reprogram** a database He **reprogrammed** the computer's operating system to remove the safeguard.

commerce

the activity of buying and selling things, especially on a large scale

synonym: trade, transaction, dealings

(1) interstate **commerce**, (2) the local chamber of **commerce**

This company has invested heavily in Internet **commerce**.

embarrass

- v. to cause someone to feel awkward, worried, or ashamed synonym: disconcert, unsettle, agitate
- (1) **embarrass** political enemy, (2) **embarrass** my project He looked for an opportunity to **embarrass** that actor in public.

aggressive

probable

 adj. behaving in an angry, energetic, or threatening way towards another person; tending to spread quickly

synonym: assertive, combative, threatening

(1) an **aggressive** war, (2) an **aggressive** tumor

An **aggressive** tide wrecked the ship.

adj. likely to happen or likely to be true synonym: likely, possible, potential

(1) **probable** outcome, (2) **probable** cause of a fire It seems **probable** that he has forgotten our scheduled meeting.

cocoon

a protective covering spun by some insects and other invertebrates

synonym: chrysalis, pupa, case

(1) cocoon silk, (2) a dried cocoon

The caterpillar spins a **cocoon** around itself before turning into a butterfly.

entrenched

adj. established firmly and securely

synonym: deep-rooted, confirmed, ingrained

(1) entrenched ideas, (2) entrenched positions

The monarch exploited the peasants using its **entrenched** power.

shell

 hard outer covering or case of eggs, nuts, some seeds, and some animals

synonym: ammunition, armor, cover

(1) an egg shell, (2) a mollusk shell

The outermost electron **shell** determines the chemical properties of an atom.

determinant

 a factor, circumstance, or condition that contributes to the shaping, influencing, or determining of a particular outcome or result

synonym: cause, factor, element

(1) environmental **determinant**, (2) a **determinant** of crop yields

One **determinant** of success is having a positive attitude and a strong work ethic.

playwright

n. a person who writes plays

synonym: dramatist, scribe, librettist

(1) acclaimed **playwright**, (2) a **playwright** attached to the theatre

The **playwright's** work was praised by critics and audiences alike.

congressperson

 a person who belongs to a congress, especially a member of the US House of Representatives; congressman (congressperson is used to avoid gender discrimination)

synonym: lawmaker, politician, representative

(1) hawkish **congressperson**, (2) former **congressperson**The term of a **congressperson** is two years.

editorial

adj. relating to the expression of opinions or interpretations in the media

synonym: comment, opinion, critique

(1) gain editorial help, (2) an editorial article

The newspaper published an **editorial** on the current state of the economy.

vanity

 excessive pride in or admiration of one's appearance or achievements

synonym: conceit, egotism, self-importance

(1) out of vanity, (2) wounded vanity

His vanity prevented him from seeing his flaws.

phenomenal

adj. extremely good or impressive; outstanding *synonym*: extraordinary, remarkable, impressive

(1) phenomenal success, (2) phenomenal growth

The athlete's **phenomenal** performance broke all previous records.

incidentally

adv. by the way; as an aside or in passingsynonym: by chance, by accident, inadvertently

(1) **incidentally** discovered, (2) **incidentally** mentioned **Incidentally**, I know the answer to that question.

adore

- v. to have a deep love and admiration for someone or something; to regard with great affection and reverencesynonym: cherish, worship, idolize
- (1) truly **adore** him, (2) **adore** the way she styles her hair Children seem to **adore** chocolate ice cream no matter where they're from.

presence

 the fact or state that someone or something exists, occurs, or is present

synonym: existence, actuality, fact

(1) the evidence of the **presence**, (2) his majestic **presence**The path to a solid online **presence** necessitates a high technical ability.

preliminary

adj. serving as a preparation for something more important or extensive; introductory; taking place before the main event or decision

synonym: initial, preparatory, introductory

(1) **preliminary** investigation, (2) **preliminary** agreement Before starting the project, we need to go through some **preliminary** research and planning.

delight

- n. a feeling of great pleasure or happinesssynonym: pleasure, joy, satisfaction
- (1) a tremor of **delight**, (2) with **delight**The **delight** on the child's faces when they received the toy was priceless.

spectacular

adj. striking or impressive to look at or in performance or achievement

synonym: breathtaking, impressive, grand

(1) **spectacular** view, (2) achieve **spectacular** growth The **spectacular** fireworks display was the highlight of the festival.

gown

 a long, flowing garment worn on formal occasions, especially by women

synonym: dress, robe, garment

(1) a judge's **gown**, (2) **gown** for the prom She looked stunning in her long, flowing **gown** at the formal event.

proceed

v. to move forward or to continue with a process or action; to advance or progress

synonym: advance, progress, move ahead

(1) **proceed** with caution, (2) **proceed** to the next step We can now **proceed** with the next item on our agenda.

quest

- n. a long or challenging search for somethingsynonym: exploration, inquisition, pursuit
- (1) the **quest** for truth, (2) on a **quest** for happiness That adventurer traveled in **quest** of buried treasure.

stonewall

v. to refuse to answer questions or provide information; to delay discussion or decision

synonym: obstruct, block, impede

(1) **stonewall** the investigation, (2) **stonewall** their attempts The government **stonewalled** the opposition party's efforts to access information about the project.

unbelievable

adj. beyond belief or understanding and extremely surprising synonym: unimaginable, incredible, fantastical

(1) **unbelievable** beauty, (2) cause **unbelievable** damage He drinks an **unbelievable** amount of beer.

dismiss

v. to regard something or someone as not important and not worth considering; to terminate someone's employment

synonym: decline, disband, dissolve

(1) **dismiss** a person from the office, (2) **dismiss** a matter with a laugh

The committee has decided to **dismiss** the president from the post.

moderate

adj. being within reasonable limits; not excessive or extreme *synonym*: average, middle-of-the-road, tempered

(1) moderate growth, (2) moderate risk

He had a **moderate** understanding of the topic but needed further research.

entertainment

 public shows, films, television, or other performances or activities of enjoying people

synonym: amusement, recreation, enjoyment

(1) an elegant **entertainment**, (2) hour of **entertainment** The hotel is famous for its **entertainment**, including the casino.

onstage

adv. onto or on a stage in a theater; in front of an audience

(1) appeared **onstage**, (2) walk **onstage**

He performed his magic trick **onstage**, leaving the audience in awe.

absolutely

adv. without restriction or limitation; completely or utterly *synonym*: completely, utterly, definitely

(1) **absolutely** against, (2) **absolutely** obsessed with the girl

I am **absolutely** opposed to his idea because of morality.

competitor

 a person who participates in a sporting contest; a person or organization that competes with others, particularly in business

synonym:

opponent, contender, contestant

(1) beat **competitor** offer, (2) domestic **competitor**The gap between the company and its **competitors** has widened.

characteristic

 a typical feature or quality that can identify, tell apart, or describe something or somebody

synonym: feature, quality, attribute

(1) stripes **characteristic** of the zebra, (2) my friend's **characteristic** laugh

Bananas have their **characteristic** taste and odor.

actress

- n. a female actor, particularly in the theater or moviessynonym: performer, player, star
- (1) an **actress** of real quality, (2) a well-known **actress**The acclaimed **actress** received an Oscar for her outstanding performance in the film.

charity

 an organization that helps people in need, especially by providing food, shelter, or money; a kindly and sympathetic attitude toward people

synonym: philanthropy, benevolence, generosity

(1) charity work, (2) ask charity

She volunteers at a local **charity** every weekend to help those in need.

upstage

v. to distract attention from someone or something else, often intentionally; to move upstage in a theater, away from the audience, thus taking a more prominent position on the stage; (adverb) at or toward the rear of the stage

synonym: outdo, overshadow, eclipse

(1) upstage a co-star, (2) move upstage

The musician's incredible solo momentarily **upstaged** the lead singer.

wither

v. to gradually shrink, shrivel, or become weaker, often due to lack of nourishment, age, or disease; to lose freshness, vitality, or vigor

synonym: fade, wilt, shrivel

(1) **wither** corporate management, (2) **wither** in the heat The flowers in the garden began to **wither** due to lack of water.

contempt

n. the feeling that a person or thing is beneath consideration, worthless, or deserving of scorn

synonym: scorn, disdain, disrespect

The defendant's **contempt** for the court and its authority was evident in his behavior.

wrestling

n. a sport in which two contestants grapple and try to throw each other to the ground

synonym: grappling, fighting, brawling

(1) wrestling match, (2) arm wrestling

He had always been interested in sumo **wrestling** and decided to try it.

tribute

n. a payment, gift, or other forms of recognition made in honor of or submission to another person or entity

synonym: honor, accolade, recognition

The statue was built as a **tribute** to the soldiers who died in the war.

remarkable

adj. worthy of attention because unusual or special *synonym*: outstanding, exceptional, extraordinary

politically

adv. in a way that relates to the government or public affairs of a nation

(1) politically advantageous,	(2) become politically savvy

attract

- v. to draw or entice someone or something towards them through the qualities they have, especially positive ones synonym: lure, entice, draw in
- attract attention, (2) attract customers
 The government is eager to attract international investment.

brain

- n. the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feelingsynonym: intellect, mind, encephalon
- (1) basic **brain** function, (2) permanent **brain** damage X-rays revealed a small tumor in his **brain**.

tumor

- a mass of diseased tissue that forms when cells in the body divide and grow in an uncontrolled way
- synonym: neoplasm, mass, lump

invite

- v. to ask someone to come or join; to offer an opportunity or possibility for something to happen or take placesynonym: ask, request, summon

horrible

- adj. extremely unpleasant or bad; causing fear or disgust synonym: dreadful, terrible, awful

butler

- a male servant in charge of serving food and drinks and taking care of household duties
- synonym: valet, majordomo, manservant

passe

 adj. no longer fashionable or current; outdated; considered to be old-fashioned or out of date

compose

v. to write music, poetry, or formal writing; to constitute or make up a whole, or a specified part of it
