profanity

 a speech or behavior that expresses of lack of respect for God or holy things

synonym: cuss, expletive, crudeness

We do not tolerate any profanity or abusive language.

panther

 a large and powerful wildcat with a distinctive sleek black coat found primarily in the Americas, Africa, and Asia

synonym: panthera, big cat, feline

The **panther's** sleek black coat and piercing yellow eyes make for a striking vision in the forest.

supremacy

n. the state, condition, or position of being superior to all others in authority, power, or status

Newtonian

sentimental

riot

synonym: disturbance, unrest, upheaval

filmmaker

cower

troop
