handful

figurine

 a small ornamental figure, typically made of clay, porcelain, or plastic and often depicting a person or animal

obvious

adj. easy to see, discover or understand synonym: apparent, conspicuous, evident

masterpiece

a work of art that is exceptionally good or highly skilled;
 a great achievement

strike

 v. to wallop somebody or something with the hand, fist, or weapon; to have an emotional or cognitive impact upon synonym: hit, impact, influence

culmination

the peak highest point or climax of something, especially happening after a long time

feat

a notable or impressive achievement, especially one that requires great skill or bravery

synonym: achievement, accomplishment, exploit

destroy

to ruin or damage severely or completely; to eradicate or eliminate completely

synonym: demolish, ruin, obliterate

dump

to deposit or dispose of something, such as trash, waste, etc., carelessly or hurriedly

synonym: throw away, dispose

devil

 a supernatural being typically represented in belief systems as an evil or mischievous spirit, often used metaphorically to describe a person or thing that is harmful, dangerous, or wicked

afford

- to have enough money or time to be able to buy or do something

racism

 a small metal or plastic device used for holding an object or objects together or in place; a short part of electronic media, either an audio clip or video clip

synonym: buckle, hook, pin

bubble

amphetamine

committee

 a group of people appointed or elected to perform a specific function or manage a particular task, often within a larger organization

vary

synonym: alter, contrast, differ

scream

bastardize

to give a loud, high shout suddenly, especially because of fear, anger, excitement, etc.; to utter or declare in a very loud voice

synonym: cry, shout, yell

- (1) **scream** a profanity, (2) **scream** at him to be quiet She kept **screaming** for an ambulance.
- to alter, modify, or degrade something in a way that ν. undermines or violates its original integrity or quality; to create a less authentic or less desirable version of something

synonym: corrupt, debase, pervert

(1) bastardize a recipe, (2) bastardize culture We do not want to **bastardize** the text's original meaning through poor translations.

stare

to gaze or look fixedly and intently at someone or something, often in a questioning, curious, or suspicious manner; (noun) a fixed, intense, and prolonged gaze or look

synonym: gaze, look, gawk

(1) **stare** blankly, (2) give a menacing **stare** He couldn't help but **stare** at the beautiful sunset over the ocean.

complicated

adj. involving a lot of different things or parts in a way that is difficult to understand or analyze

synonym: complex, convoluted, intricate

pregnant

adj. having a baby or young animal developing in the uterussynonym: expectant

crocodile

 a large, carnivorous reptile with powerful jaws and a long, scaly body; native to tropical regions and often found in rivers and freshwater habitats

cower

troop

honor

salute

 to show respect or recognition for someone or something, often by making a gesture or performing an action; to greet or acknowledge someone in a formal or ceremonious way

diamond

idiot

 someone who resists or opposes authority or control, especially by fighting against it

 the process of becoming or making somebody or something well again

synonym: recovery, recuperation, convalescence
