synonym: situational, contextual, circumstantial

(1) ex- situ conservation, (2) in- situ control

Melanoma in **situ** is considered the earliest stage of melanoma and has a high cure rate with appropriate treatment.

unskilled

 adj. lacking the knowledge, training, or specialized skills required for a particular job or task; not having developed or cultivated a particular ability or expertise

synonym: inexperienced, untrained, amateur

(1) unskilled salesperson, (2) unskilled job

The **unskilled** worker struggled to keep up with the fast-paced manufacturing job.

undercover

adj. carried out or conducted in secret, with one's true identity or purpose concealed; disguised, incognitosynonym: covert, hidden, stealthy

(1) **undercover** operation, (2) **undercover** journalist The **undercover** police officer was able to gather crucial evidence without being detected.

medicinal

adj. of or relating to the treatment or cure of diseasesynonym: curative, therapeutic, healing

(1) **medicinal** chemistry, (2) traditional **medicinal**The **medicinal** properties of this herb have been known to help with various ailments.

vial

 a small glass container, especially one containing liquid medicine or perfume

synonym: container, bottle, flask

(1) glass vials, (2) insulin vial

This medication is sealed in a vial.

sterile

adj. free from living microorganisms, especially bacteria, fungi, and viruses; incapable of reproducing

synonym: clean, germ-free, hygienic

(1) **sterile** environment, (2) a **sterile** man

Surgeons must use **sterile** instruments to prevent infection during an operation.

prick

v. to make a small hole or puncture or to cause a slight, sharp pain; to stimulate or provoke a reaction or response; to use needles to administer a vaccine or medication

synonym: poke, jab, sting

(1) **prick** a balloon, (2) **prick** up her ears

He accidentally **pricked** his finger with the needle.

recycle

v. to sort and collect things to process them and produce valuable materials that can be used again

synonym: reclaim, reuse, reprocess

(1) **recycle** the cardboard boxes, (2) **recycle** milk packaging into new paper

We largely **recycle** the circuit board of cell phones because they contain a lot of valuable metals.

anecdote

 a short and amusing or interesting story about a real incident or person

synonym: story, account, tale

(1) personal **anecdote**, (2) funny **anecdote**

She entertained the guests with **anecdotes** about her travels and experiences.

pistol

n. a handgun, typically one that can be held in one hand synonym: revolver, handgun, firearm

(1) **pistol** grip, (2) **pistol** shot

The robbers were armed with **pistols** and demanded money.

afterward

adv. after the time mentioned

synonym: later, thereafter, following

(1) a few years afterward, (2) go there afterward
