### tragedy

### lighthearted

### **spirit**

#### confer

v. to have a meeting or discussion to come to a decision or agreement or exchange ideas; to bestow something

synonym: consult, meet, discuss

The leaders of the two countries met to **confer** on the issue.

#### crack

v. to break or cause to break without dividing into separate parts; (noun) a line on the surface of something along which it has separated without breaking

synonym: snap, burst, break

(1) crack an eggshell, (2) a crack in a board

He that would eat the kernel must **crack** the nut.

#### cocaine

n. a highly addictive stimulant drug that is derived from the leaves of the coca plant, often used recreationally for its euphoric effects but also used in medicine as a local anesthetic and vasoconstrictor

synonym: narcotic, coke, snow

(1) powder cocaine, (2) cocaine overdose

The drug dealer was arrested for possession of **cocaine**.

### epidemic

 n. the widespread outbreak of a particular disease in a large number of people at the same time

## glamorous

adj. highly attractive and exciting, and different from ordinary things or people

### jewelry

### bling

 a slang term that refers to flashy, showy, or ostentatious jewelry, often characterized by its high cost or precious materials

synonym: jewelry, accessories, ornaments

She loves to accessorize with lots of **bling**, but I prefer a different style.

### unique

*adj.* being the only one of its kind; unlike anything else *synonym*: one-of-a-kind, unparalleled, incomparable

### opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

#### gang

a group of people who organize and engage in criminal activity

synonym: crew, posse, group

(1) a motorcycle gang, (2) gang member

The street **gang** was known for its violent behavior.

#### realistic

adj. having or showing a sensible and practical idea that is possible to achieve

synonym: practical, pragmatic, down-to-earth

(1) a realistic goal, (2) a realistic goal

That story was so **realistic**, and it was scary.

#### convince

v. to persuade someone or make someone believe that something is true

*synonym*: persuade, win over, convert

### profound

### influence

### superficial

### association

### marijuana

 a psychoactive drug derived from the Cannabis plant, used for medicinal or recreational purposes; a drug that is illegal in some countries and states but legal in others for specific purposes

### powder

### invention

- n. the creation of a new device or process resulting from study and experimentation; the act of inventingsynonym: creation, design, innovation

### well-being

- n. the state of being happy and healthy and prosperoussynonym: health, welfare, happiness

### brilliant

#### efficient

adj. performing at the highest level of productivity with the least wasted effort or resources; capable of achieving maximum output with minimum wasted effort, time, or materials

*synonym*: productive, effective, competent

### mechanism

 a part of a machine, or a set of parts that performs a task; a natural or established process that occurs during a specific situation or reaction

synonym: means, method, system

He discovered unique **mechanisms** for photochemical reactions.

#### snort

 to forcefully inhale air through the nose in a loud manner, often to express amusement, derision, or disgust; to inhale drugs or other substances through the nose

synonym: sniff, inhale, snuffle

The horse **snorted** as I approached it in the field.

doll

 a child's toy that typically represents a human figure, especially a young girl; an attractive woman; a woman who is subservient or passive

### grateful

#### statistics

a person, company, or thing competing with others for the same thing or in the same area

synonym: adversary, competitor, contender

greet

to say hello to someone; to express welcome on meeting someone

synonym: welcome, salute, acknowledge

(1) greet a customer, (2) greet an idea

He **greeted** his friends with a warm smile and a hug.

### academic

- adj. associated with schools, colleges, and universities, especially studying and thinking, not with practical skills synonym: educational, scholarly, theoretical
- (1) academic probation, (2) an academic discussion An excellent historian must possess an academic mentality.

#### hook

a curved device used for suspending, holding, or pulling something, especially one attached to a surface for hanging things on; a sharp curve or crook

synonym: buckle, pin, curve

(1) a hat **hook**, (2) the curved shape of a **hook** Please hang your towel on a **hook**.

a person who is held by another as security, typically to n. fulfill certain conditions or demands; a person who is forcibly confined or controlled

synonym: captive, prisoner, detainee

(1) political hostage, (2) hostage negotiations

### hostage

The terrorists took several tourists as **hostages** in a bid to advance their demands.

### overnight

adj. lasting for or occurring during one night; occurring or changing extremely quickly or suddenly; happening or being achieved in a short amount of time

### gunfire

# philosophy

v. to talk about or examine in detail through conversation or debate; to exchange ideas, opinions, or information on a particular topic

#### threat

 a strong indication or likelihood of harm, danger, or adverse consequences; an expression of intent to inflict harm or injury on someone or something, often made as a means of coercion or intimidation

synonym: menace, danger, hazard

(1) economic **threat**, (2) environmental **threat** The **threat** of severe weather prompted the city to issue an evacuation warning.

#### shower

nap

a brief period of rain; a device that emits a spray of water for washing oneself; a party or celebration in which gifts are given to someone, often in anticipation of a major life event such as a wedding or the birth of a child

*synonym*: rain, sprinkle, downpour

- (1) take a quick **shower**, (2) bridal **shower** The weather forecast predicted a **shower** in the afternoon.
- a short sleep, especially during the day synonym: rest, doze, drowse

### dissertation

a long and formal written treatise or discourse, often n. presenting research or analysis on a particular subject or topic, in support of a degree or academic qualification

synonym: essay, treatise, paper

- the way two persons or groups of people feel and act relation toward one another

*synonym*: association, linkage, connection

jail

a facility where criminals are kept to be punished for their crimes; a prison

synonym: prison, slammer, penitentiary

(1) county jail, (2) be in jail

The police escorted the prisoner to the **jail**.

### apartment

 a self-contained living unit within a larger building or complex, typically consisting of one or more rooms or an open space used for living, cooking, and sleeping

synonym: flat, dwelling, unit

(1) rented **apartment**, (2) furnished **apartment**I am seeking a spacious **apartment** with a balcony and a parking spot.

disk

 a flat, circular plate, typically made of metal, glass, or plastic, used for storing data or playing music

synonym: record, platter, plate

(1) disk drive, (2) disk space

The computer's hard **disk** was full, so she had to delete some files.

### ultimate

- adj. furthest or highest in degree or ordersynonym: highest, maximum, foremost
