### replicate

- v. to make an exact copy of something; to repeat a process or experiment to confirm the resultssynonym: duplicate, imitate, reproduce

### incapable

- adj. unable to do, control, or achieve something synonym: unable, incompetent, unskilled
- (1) drunk and **incapable**, (2) **incapable** of being resisted He seems **incapable** of understanding what she says.

## midday

- n. noon; twelve o'clock in the middle of the daysynonym: noon, meridian, noontime
- (1) **midday** meal, (2) **midday** glare of the sun We usually have a lunch meeting at **midday**.

## headquarter

 the central office or location from which a business or organization is managed

*synonym*: base, center, command

(1) administrative **headquarter**, (2) an emergency **headquarter** 

The company decided to move its **headquarters** to New York City.

#### executor

 a person appointed by a court to carry out the instructions of a will; a person who produces or enforces something or causes it to come into use

synonym: administrator, trustee, executrix

(1) testamentary **executor**, (2) appointed **executor**The will **executor** was responsible for distributing the assets to the beneficiaries.

#### delve

 to dig or excavate deeply; to investigate or research intensively; to rummage or explore in a thorough or careful manner

synonym: dig, excavate, uncover

(1) **delve** deeper, (2) **delve** into documents

Researchers must **delve** into the intricacies of the human brain to understand mental illness.

#### determinant

 a factor, circumstance, or condition that contributes to the shaping, influencing, or determining of a particular outcome or result

*synonym*: cause, factor, element

(1) environmental **determinant**, (2) a **determinant** of crop yields

One **determinant** of success is having a positive attitude and a strong work ethic.

#### recreate

v. to make something that existed previously happen or appear to exist again

*synonym*: renovate, vivify, revive

(1) **recreate** a single country, (2) **recreate** the feeling of the 1920s

She **recreated** the atmosphere of the pre-war age with her stage setting.

#### hands-on

 adj. actively involved, practical; having hands involved in the doing or making of something

synonym: practical, involved, hands-in

(1) **hands-on** activity, (2) take a **hands-on** approach The **hands-on** workshop allowed attendees to work with tools and materials, developing their skills in a hands-on environment.

#### memorize

v. to learn something carefully so that you will remember it exactly

*synonym*: learn, remember, remind

(1) **memorize** musical scores, (2) try hard to **memorize** the lines

Lawyers need to **memorize** even the most minor provisions of the law.

#### abacus

 a counting device consisting of a frame with rods or wires on which beads or stones are moved to perform arithmetic calculations

synonym: bead frame, counting frame

(1) **abacus** calculations, (2) wooden **abacus** beads
The child was learning how to use an **abacus** in her math class.

eureka

exclamation of triumph on discovering something;
 realization or sudden insight

synonym: discovery, breakthrough, aha moment

- (1) have a eureka moment, (2) shout "eureka!"
- " Eureka!" he exclaimed, finally solving the problem.

### smartphone

- a mobile phone that functions as a computer and connects to the Internet
- (1) **smartphone** app developer, (2) **smartphone** addict Internet traffic volumes have increased significantly with the advent of **smartphones**.

#### wildfire

 a large, uncontrolled fire that spreads quickly through a natural area such as a forest, grassland, or mountain slope

synonym: blaze, bonfire, flame

(1) **wildfire** spread, (2) arson-caused **wildfire**The **wildfire** destroyed hundreds of homes and forced thousands of people to evacuate.

#### instantaneous

adj. occurring or happening immediately or without delay;taking place in an instant or moment

synonym: immediate, prompt, rapid
