excite

obsess

sweep

v. to clean something, especially a floor or an area, by using a broom; move swiftly and smoothly

synonym: clean, clear, brush off

develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

consolation

 the comfort received by a person after misfortune or disappointment

ancient

adj. relating to the long ago, particularly the historical period preceding the fall of the Western Roman Empire; very old

synonym: archaic, age-old, obsolete

notion

 a general idea or understanding of something, particularly an abstract or complex concept; a belief or opinion, often one that is not based on solid evidence or facts

synonym: idea, concept, belief

cult

 a small religious group, especially one that is not part of a larger religion and that is regarded as outside the norm; followers of an exclusive system of beliefs and practices

honor

synonym: continue, outlast, survive

existence

- n. the state or fact of someone or something existingsynonym: fact, being, reality
- (1) the biggest tree in **existence**, (2) the struggle for **existence**

He was an atheist and therefore did not believe in the **existence** of heaven or hell.

lodestar

 a guiding star, especially the North Star (Polaris), used to determine direction; a person or thing that serves as a reliable guide or principle

significance

suffer

v. to experience pain, distress, or hardship; to undergo or endure something painful or unpleasant

congress

a formal meeting of the representatives of different countries, constituent states, organizations, trade unions, political parties, or other groups

fuel

eventually

synonym: legislature, parliament, assembly

Senate

a legislative body, especially the upper house of a parliament

victory

 success in a game, competition, election, or battle, or the knowledge that you have won

synonym: win, triumph, success

presidency

the office or term of the President of a country or organization

synonym: leadership, administration, governance

(1) presidency term, (2) presidency duties

Her candidacy for the **presidency** has been met with both support and criticism.

educated

adj. having received a high standard of education *synonym*: knowledgeable, erudite, enlightened

(1) educated adult, (2) educated speech

Excellent speech is a characteristic of an **educated** man.

celebrated

adj. renowned for possessing admirable attributessynonym: acclaimed, notable, prominent

(1) **celebrated** artist, (2) **celebrated** paper

Three **celebrated** tenors performed during the president's inauguration.

rival

 a person, company, or thing competing with others for the same thing or in the same area

synonym: adversary, competitor, contender

(1) **rival** bidder, (2) merge with a **rival** company He interfered with his **rivals** in various ways during the campaign.

elect

v. to choose someone for a specific position by voting for them; to decide or choose to do something

synonym: select, choose, prefer

(1) **elect** the school board, (2) **elect** death

Every five years, the provincial governors are **elected**.

stun

 to make a person or an animal unconscious or dizzy, especially by hitting them on the head; to make someone surprised or shocked greatly

synonym: shock, amaze, astound

(1) stun fish, (2) stun an audience

This sprinter **stunned** the world with his speed.

appoint

 to give someone a job or role, especially as a public official or member of an organization; to arrange or decide on a time or a place synonym: designate, assign, name

(1) **appoint** members, (2) **appoint** the day The court **appointed** a guardian for the child.

cabinet

n. a piece of furniture with doors, shelves, and drawers used for storage or display; a small group of senior members of a government who act as official advisers for the President or Prime Minister

synonym: cupboard, ministry, authority

(1) member of the **cabinet**, (2) the **cabinet** above the sink The prime minister decided to reshuffle his **cabinet** to regain support.

unprecedented

adj. never having been seen, done, or known beforesynonym: novel, outstanding, unparalleled

(1) **unprecedented** boom, (2) **unprecedented** business opportunity

Unprecedented amounts of heckling and slogan-shouting took place throughout the event.

figurehead

n. a person who holds a nominal or titular position of leadership or authority but who has no real power or influence; a symbolic representation, often in the form of a carved figure or a painting, that is mounted on the bow of a ship

synonym: puppet, emblem, symbol

(1) political **figurehead**, (2) **figurehead** company The mayor is only a **figurehead** in this town, with the real power being held by the city council

peril

- n. serious and great danger or risksynonym: hazard, danger, threat
- (1) the peril of the sea, (2) environmental perilDue to hunger, the lives of the refugees were in peril.

noble

 adj. having or showing excellent personal qualities or high moral principles that people admire synonym: dignified, aristocratic, benevolent

(1) a **noble** family, (2) **noble** gas

He is a **noble-minded** man

fashion

 a style that is popular at a particular time or place; the state of being popular

synonym: style, manner, fad

(1) go out of **fashion**, (2) new **fashion** trends

That style is no longer in **fashion**.

bet

v. to risk money on the result of an event or a competition, such as a race or game, to get more money; to have faith or confidence in something

synonym: stake, wager, gamble

(1) bet on a race, (2) bet my future

I bet that you know it.

emerge

v. to move out of or away from something and become visible

synonym: arise, occur, appear

(1) **emerge** as a butterfly, (2) **emerge** from poverty During colonial eras, new migratory patterns **emerged**.

dispute

- n. a disagreement, argument, or controversy between two people, groups, or countries, especially a formal one
- synonym: argument, disagreement, quarrel
- (1) a legal **dispute** over the title, (2) **dispute** settlement The **dispute** over the ownership of the land has been ongoing for years.

captain

 the leader of a group of people, especially who is in charge of a ship or aircraft

synonym: boss, director, leader

unruly

adj. difficult or impossible to manage or control; disobedient; disorderly

synonym: naughty, defiant, disobedient

possessed

adj. controlled or influenced by a strong emotion or belief *synonym*: controlled, influenced, consumed

unparalleled

adj. without parallel, equal in size, amount, quality, etc.; better or worse than any other

synonym: outstanding, phenomenal, remarkable

(1) **unparalleled** views, (2) an **unparalleled** achievement Several American technology companies have achieved **unparalleled** success in terms of customer numbers.

array

 a large group or collection of things or people, especially one that is impressive or attractive

synonym: collection, display, batch

(1) a two-dimensional **array**, (2) an **array** of troops

The customer on the Internet has to choose one from a formidable **array** of products.

emotional

adj. relating to people's feelings

synonym: affecting, impactful, impressive

(1) emotional health, (2) emotional distress

strength

n. the quality or state of being physically, or sometimes mentally, strong

synonym: resilience, power, muscles

external

adj. belonging to or situated outside of someone or something

résumé

 a summary of a person's education, work experience, and qualifications, often used in job applications as a way to showcase their skills and achievements

synonym: summary, outline, recap

(1) **résumé** template, (2) professional **résumé**

You need to update your **résumé** before submitting it for the job application.

uncanny

adj. strange or mysterious, often in a way that is unsettling synonym: arcane, astonishing, eerie

(1) in an **uncanny** manner, (2) **uncanny** resemblance She has an **uncanny** sense of who is telling a lie.

empathy

 the ability to share another person's feelings or experiences by imagining that person's situation

synonym: compassion, sympathy, tenderness

(1) full of **empathy**, (2) **empathy** for patients **Empathy** is also necessary to understand history.

injury

 harm done to a person's or an animal's body caused by an accident or an attack

synonym: wound, damage, hurt

(1) without injury, (2) a fatal injury

My accidental injury got better right away.

escalate

v. to increase in intensity, size, or severity; to make something greater, worse, or more serious

synonym: increase, intensify, expand

adv. all the time
