# planet

#### demonstration

 a display or show, often of a particular skill or product, intended to convince or persuade others

#### license

#### traffic

# organ

# slight

# quote

# probable

# thoughtful

adj. characterized by careful and considerate thinking;

jerk

# monopoly

 exclusive control or possession of something, especially an area of business; a board game in which players try to gain a monopoly on real estate

# specific

adj. clearly defined or particular to a certain thing or situation; distinct, explicit, and precise

#### incident

an event or occurrence, often unexpected or unplanned;
 something that happens

synonym: event, occurrence, accident

#### routine

 a usual or habitual way of doing things; a set sequence of steps, part of a larger computer program

synonym: habit, custom, procedure

#### vandalism

n. the willful and malicious destruction or defacement of property that belongs to another person or the public; the act of deliberately causing damage or harm to something valuable or meaningful

# vandal

# principle

 a fundamental law or truth that explains or controls how something happens or works

objective

# religion
