waltz

 a ballroom dance in triple time that originated in Vienna and is characterized by a flowing, graceful style and a strong accent on the first beat of each measure

*synonym*: ballroom dance, tango, foxtrot

define

 to state or explain precisely the nature, scope, or meaning of something

synonym: characterize, depict, express

titanic

 adj. of or having a great size, power, or influence; of or relating to Titanium (= a light, strong grey, lustrous, corrosion-resistant metallic element)

synonym: colossal, massive, immense

The titanic ship sank on its maiden voyage.

sink

v. to submerge or go down below the surface of a liquid or substance; to decline or deteriorate; to cause something to go down into a liquid substance or sink into something else

*synonym*: descend, drop, plummet

tip

### iceberg

### gradual

synonym: blend, hybrid, compounding

#### modern

adj. of or belonging to the present time or recent times synonym: contemporary, stylish, current

#### concourse

 a large open space or area, typically found in a public building, where people gather or pass through; a crowd or assembly of people; a junction or intersection

synonym: crowd, gathering, corridor

#### destination

 the place to which someone or something is going or being sent; the ultimate purpose or goal of a journey or action

#### efficient

adj. performing at the highest level of productivity with the least wasted effort or resources; capable of achieving maximum output with minimum wasted effort, time, or materials

#### imitate

### humming

adj. producing a continuous, low, vibrating sound like that of the bee

### companion

bust

crazy

adj. stupid or not sensible; very angry

a response that reveals a person's feelings or attitude;
 (in chemistry) a process in which one or more substances are changed into others

synonym: response, reply, answer

### disappear

- v. to cease to exist or be visible
- synonym: fade, evaporate, vanish

#### honor

#### huck

#### property

- n. a thing or things that belong to someonesynonym: belongings, possessions, equity

#### chase

### bury

#### accretion

#### communicate

### backstage

#### connote

### philosophy

 the study of general and fundamental questions, such as those about existence, reason, knowledge, values, mind

synonym: doctrine, attitude, creed

(1) **philosophy** of education, (2) western **philosophy** Ethics is a branch of **philosophy**.

### organization

n. a group of people who work together for a shared purpose

synonym: association, institution, community

(1) **organization** chart, (2) agricultural **organization**She is the president of a large international **organization**.

#### curtsy

n. (also "curtsey") a formal gesture of respect or deference, especially performed by women, involving bending the knees with one foot behind the other and lowering the body slightly; a show of politeness or courtesy

### president

### imaginary

adj. existing only in someone's mindsynonym: fictional, ideal, fantastical

### investigate

 to conduct a systematic or formal inquiry to identify and evaluate the facts of a crime, problem, statement, etc. to establish the truth

### quest

- n. a long or challenging search for somethingsynonym: exploration, inquisition, pursuit

#### institute

 an organization that has a specific purpose, particularly one dealing with science, education, or a particular profession; (verb) to initiate, introduce, or establish something

synonym: academy, university, college

### organic

adj. of or derived from biological substance; producing plants and animals for food and other items without the use of synthetic chemicals

synonym: biological

organic soils, (2) eat organic food
 the kidney is an organic component of the body.

#### poem

a piece of writing that emphasizes the expression of feelings and ideas by paying particular attention to diction (sometimes rhyme), rhythm, and imagery

synonym: ballad, lyric, verse

(1) a narrative **poem**, (2) **poem** to the dead A great **poem** is a fountain forever overflowing with the waters of wisdom and delight.

#### inmate

a person who is confined to an institution such as a prison, hospital, or mental health facility

synonym: prisoner, convict, detainee

#### norm

- something that is regarded as usual, typical, or standard synonym: criterion, mean, standard
