# heighten

# instability

# symptom

 any sensation or change in body or mind that is experienced by a patient and is associated with a particular disease

#### reaction

a response that reveals a person's feelings or attitude;

### ignore

### weave

v. to make cloth, a carpet, a basket, etc., by repeatedly crossing a single thread through two sets of long threads at a right angle to them

### economical

### planet

### smartphone

- a mobile phone that functions as a computer and connects to the Internet

### penetration

 the act or process of penetrating or entering something, often forcefully or with difficulty; the depth or extent to which something has been entered or understood

*synonym*: infiltration, entry, invasion

(1) **penetration** testing, (2) market **penetration**The spy's mission was to gather intelligence on enemy territories through covert **penetration**.

### passe

 adj. no longer fashionable or current; outdated; considered to be old-fashioned or out of date

synonym: outdated, old-fashioned, antique

#### cellular

adj. of or connected with the cells of animals or plants; of or connected with a mobile telephone system that uses several short-range radio stations instead of wires

#### device

### aspect

### governance
