synonym: praise, glorify, honor

#### reunite

v. to bring two or more people together again after a period of separation

*synonym*: reconcile, reunify, reconvene

# underground

adj. under the surface of the ground; a secret group organized to achieve a specific purpose, such as overthrowing the government or occupying a force

synonym: subterranean, subsurface, confidential

(1) water flowing **underground**, (2) **underground** activist Having **underground** parking has been very beneficial throughout the winter.

# sight

n. the ability to see; anything that is seen

synonym: vision, spectacle, view

(1) an unexpected sight, (2) dull sight

Many famous **sights** are within walking distance.

# footstep

a step, or the sound generated by a person walking when their foot hits the ground

synonym: footfall, step

(1) **footsteps** in the corridor, (2) approaching **footsteps** The sound of oncoming **footsteps** grew louder, closer.

#### nowhere

adv. not in, at, or to any place; not anywhere

(1) **nowhere** else to go, (2) come out of **nowhere** I've been thinking all day and getting **nowhere**.

# pace

 the speed at which someone or something moves, or the rate at which something happens or changes

synonym: gait, rate, speed

at your own pace,
 the runner's pace
 the economy is growing at a supercharged pace.

# process

n. a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

synonym: procedure, method, system

(1) **process** improvement, (2) decision-making **process** The **process** for applying for a visa can be lengthy and complicated.

clap

v. to hit your hands together and make a short and loud noise, mainly to show your approval or praise

synonym: applaud, spat, acclaim

(1) **clap** my hands, (2) **clap** a book shut We **clapped** along with the singer's song.

#### drag

v. to pull or haul with force

synonym: haul, pull, draw

(1) drag a chair over, (2) drag a team down

He **dragged** the heavy suitcase behind him as he walked.

# repeatedly

adv. again and again; many timessynonym: frequently, over and over, constantly

(1) use cell phone **repeatedly**, (2) **repeatedly** nod He claims that his legitimate requests were **repeatedly** ignored.

pave

v. to cover something with a hard, flat material such as stones, bricks, or concrete, to make it suitable for travel or use

synonym: surface, coat, cover

(1) **pave** a new path, (2) **pave** a smoother road They **paved** the courtyard with bricks, giving it a more polished appearance.

assault

- a violent physical attack; the crime of forcing someone to submit to sexual intercourse against their will
   synonym: attack, raid, attempt
- (1) **assault** aircraft, (2) victim of sexual **assault** We got caught up in an **assault** case.

rip

- v. to tear something or be torn violently or suddenly synonym: tear, cut, slit
- (1) **rip** a notebook apart, (2) **rip** a hole in the roof During transit, the stuff may **rip** off the luggage tag.

struggle

v. to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

(1) **struggle** against discrimination, (2) **struggle** to get the job

He could not **struggle** against temptation.

smack

 to hit something or someone with force, often making a loud noise; to deliver a sharp criticism or rebuke synonym: hit, slap, strike

(1) smack on the lips, (2) smack his knee

The baseball player **smacked** the ball out of the park, securing a home run.

#### concrete

 adj. existing in a physical or material form rather than an abstract one; based on facts rather than ideas or guesses; made of or covered with cement

synonym: actual, factual, hardened

(1) a **concrete** noun, (2) **concrete** examples

The president asked for a more **concrete** plan.

#### echo

 a sound heard after being reflected off a surface, such as a wall or a cliff

*synonym*: reverberate, repeat, reflection

(1) the **echo** of a person's footsteps, (2) sound **echo** 

A thunderous boom **echoed** throughout the valley.

#### haunt

v. to frequent or visit repeatedly, often in a way that is disturbing or unsettling; to occupy or fill the mind, often in a way that is unpleasant or persistent

synonym: stalk, spook, obsess

(1) haunt memories, (2) haunt my conscience

The crowd's boos and jeers continued to **haunt** the performer long after the show ended.

# standing

 adj. existing or remaining upright; having a vertical position; (noun) social, financial, or professional status or reputation

synonym: upright, vertical, (noun) position

(1) standing water, (2) his social standing

The **standing** concert was packed with fans.

# topless

 adj. lacking a top or covering, typically used to refer to clothing, vehicles, or establishments that do not have an upper part

synonym: sleeveless, bare-chested

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# (1) topless car, (2) topless pool

The beachgoers were surprised to see a **topless** sunbather on the otherwise family-friendly beach.

#### bare

 adj. not covered or clothed; lacking embellishment or decoration; mere or basic; undisguised or open; empty or devoid of something

synonym: naked, exposed, uncovered

(1) bare minimum, (2) bare essentials

She wore a simple dress with a bare neckline

#### bruise

 a mark caused by a blow, typically one that is purple or black on the skin

synonym: contusion, injury, wound

(1) livid **bruise**, (2) earlier emotional **bruise**She had a **bruise** on her arm from where she fell on the playground.

# photograph

 a picture or image that is produced by a camera; a visual representation or record of a person, object, or scene that has been captured electronically or on film

*synonym*: photo, picture, snapshot

photograph album, (2) photograph memories
 I found an old photograph of my grandparents from their wedding day.

#### forensic

adj. relating to the use of scientific methods and techniques to investigate and solve crimes or legal disputes; pertaining to or involved in legal or criminal proceedings; using scientific evidence to support a claim or argument in a court of law or other formal settings

synonym: legal, juridical, judicial

(1) find **forensic** evidence, (2) **forensic** team

**Forensic** scientists analyzed the DNA evidence to solve the crime.

# all-consuming

adj. taking up all of a person's attention, energy, or resources; having a powerful or overwhelming impact or influence

*synonym*: engrossing, immersive

(1) **all-consuming** flame, (2) **all-consuming** passion His **all-consuming** love for her made him forget about everything else in his life.

#### vulnerable

adj. capable of being hurt or influenced physically or mentally

synonym: susceptible, exposed, weak

(1) a **vulnerable** bridge, (2) **vulnerable** parts of the body Infants and pregnant women are particularly **vulnerable**.

#### sham

 something that is not as good or true as it seems to be and is intended to deceive people; a person who pretends to be something they are not

synonym: bogus, counterfeit, fraudulent

(1) a **sham** battle, (2) turn out to be all **sham** The data he prepared was completely **sham**.

#### upset

adj. causing or marked by anxiety, uneasiness, trouble, or grief; (verb) to make someone anxious, unhappy, or angry

synonym: disturbed, bothered, resentful

(1) get **upset**, (2) have an **upset** stomach He was awfully **upset** by the news.

# injustice

- n. a violation of the rights of others or the laws of a societysynonym: unfairness, bias, discrimination
- (1) gross **injustice**, (2) **injustice** system

  The **injustice** of the court's decision angered many people and led to protests.

#### condense

to reduce the volume or size of something, often by removing water or other liquid; to make something shorter, more concise, or more concentrated synonym: compress, compact, shorten

#### decide

- v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering optionssynonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

#### catharsis

 a release or purging of emotional or psychological tension, often through artistic or creative experiences or expressions

synonym: cleansing, purification, purging

(1) **catharsis** of grief, (2) spiritual **catharsis**Many people find that physical exercise provides a sense of **catharsis**, helping to relieve stress and anxiety.

# humming

adj. producing a continuous, low, vibrating sound like that of the bee

synonym: buzzing, droning, vibrating

# identify

v. to recognize someone or something and say or prove who or what they are

synonym: determine, specify, recognize

#### communal

adj. belonging to or used by a group rather than individuals; for common use

*synonym*: collaborative, combined, collective

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(1) **communal** swimming pool, (2) **communal** combination of funds

**Communal** elections were held in several European countries.

#### violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

synonym: aggressive, intense, turbulent

(1) victim of a **violent** crime, (2) **violent** incident The protesters became **violent** when the police tried to disperse them.

# abuse

- *n*. the use of something in an incorrect or harmful manner *synonym*: misuse, misconduct, vilification
- (1) the problem of drug **abuse**, (2) victim of sexual **abuse** Our company has an audit team that monitors directors for **abuse** of authority.

#### tide

 the cyclical rise and fall of sea level caused by the moon's gravitational pull

synonym: ripple, surge, swell

(1) **tide** cycle, (2) ride the **tide** of change Red **tide** is often harmful to the local ecosystem.

# pupil

 the black circular opening in the center of the iris of the eye, through which light enters the eye; a student in school or university

*synonym*: iris, eye aperture, student

(1) pupil constriction, (2) attentive pupil

The **pupil** of your eye dilates in response to different light levels.

#### cousin

n. the child of your aunt or uncle

synonym: relative

(1) cross- cousin marriage, (2) cousin's familyI used to play with my younger male cousins when I was a

little girl.

#### niece

- a daughter of one's sibling, brother-in-law, or sister-in-law
- a bouncing niece, (2) play with her niece
   My niece is a talented artist who has won several awards for her drawings.

# employee

- n. a person who is hired to work for a business or organization in exchange for wages or salary; a worker synonym: worker, staff, personnel
- (1) **employee** benefits, (2) **employee** evaluation

# railway

 a transportation system consisting of tracks and trains, usually used for the transportation of goods or passengers over long distances

synonym: train line, rail line, track

#### relation

*n.* the way two persons or groups of people feel and act toward one another

*synonym*: association, linkage, connection

viol

- a stringed instrument, typically with six strings and frets,
   played with a bow, also called a viola da gamba

#### cease

v. to stop an action or event

synonym: stop, end, terminate

(1) cease to exist, (2) cease drinking

The company decided to **cease** production of the product.

### represent

v. to speak, act, or be present on behalf of another person or group; to form or constitute

synonym: depict, express, describe

(1) **represent** by a diagram, (2) the characters that **represent** numbers

We elected him to **represent** us at the international conference.

#### infinite

*adj.* unlimited or very great; impossible to measure *synonym*: boundless, countless, limitless

(1) **infinite** appetite, (2) **infinite** in supply

The battle had an **infinite** impact on the nation.

#### determinant

 a factor, circumstance, or condition that contributes to the shaping, influencing, or determining of a particular outcome or result

*synonym*: cause, factor, element

(1) environmental **determinant**, (2) a **determinant** of crop yields

One **determinant** of success is having a positive attitude and a strong work ethic.

#### incident

an event or occurrence, often unexpected or unplanned;
 something that happens

synonym: event, occurrence, accident

(1) traffic incident, (2) security incident

The incident at the airport caused a delay in my flight.

#### faith

n. complete trust in something or someone's ability or knowledge; a strong belief in religion, divine power, etc.

synonym: belief, trust, confidence

(1) religious **faith**, (2) **faith** in government He kept his robust **faith** in his company.

# solidarity

- n. unity or agreement of feelings or actions among a group, especially among individuals with a common interestsynonym: unity, cooperation, mutual support
- (1) **solidarity** among union members, (2) **solidarity** action The workers showed **solidarity** in their strike for better working conditions.

# humanity

 all people living on the earth; the quality or state of being human rather than an animal, a machine, etc.

synonym: humankind, society, human race

(1) **humanity** at large, (2) mass of **humanity**They donated large sums of money for the development of **humanity**.

recall

- v. to remember somethingsynonym: remember, retrieve, recollect
- (1) **recall** the incident, (2) **recall** his name
  She vividly **recalls** getting laid off several years ago.

terror

- n. intense fear; a state of intense fear or alarmsynonym: fear, alarm, horror
- terror attack, (2) terror group
   The bomb blast spread terror among the people.

**bomb** 

- n. a weapon that explodes and is used to kill or injure people or to cause damage to somethingsynonym: missile, explosive, ammunition

### transport

n. a system for moving people or products from one location to another using automobiles, roads, and so on synonym:

#### submit

- v. to give or offer a document, proposal, etc. to a decision-maker for examination or consideration
- synonym: hand in, present, propose
- (1) agree to **submit** the bill, (2) **submit** an application Please **submit** the assignment to me.

#### threaten

to utter intentions of injury or punishment against someone

*synonym*: endanger, terrorize, intimidate

(1) **threaten** a healthy relationship, (2) **threaten** national security

Various artificially induced causes are **threatening** our ecosystem.

#### writ

- n. a written legal order or commandsynonym: legal document, order, legal process
- (1) a **writ** of summons, (2) issue a **writ**He was served with a **writ** of eviction, giving him the notice to vacate the property.

#### isolate

v. to physically or socially separate someone or something from other people or things

synonym: separate, sequester, insulate

isolate a compound, (2) isolate a patient
 You should not isolate them from the community.

### statistics

 the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data (1) statistics for cancer, (2) official statistics

The **statistics** demonstrate that poverty and unemployment are genuine problems.

# spontaneous

adj. happening or being done naturally, often unexpected way, without being made to happen

synonym: willing, impulsive, intuitive

(1) a **spontaneous** behavior, (2) **spontaneous** labor The crowd broke out into **spontaneous** laughter.

#### decision

 n. the act or process of making up someone's mind about something; a choice or judgment reached after considering options

synonym: choice, determination, judgment

(1) decision authority, (2) a selfish decision
She was struggling to make a decision between two job offers.

# hop

v. to jump lightly and quickly on one foot or both feet; to move rapidly from one place to another; to travel using an aircraft, bus, etc.

*synonym*: jump, bounce, skip

(1) **hop** on one foot, (2) **hop** from one place to another The rabbit **hopped** over the fence.

# hashtag

- a word or phrase preceded by the symbol #, used on social media websites and applications to identify messages on a specific topic
- (1) marked with a **hashtag**, (2) trending **hashtag**Our brand's campaign uses a unique **hashtag** to track engagement and reach.

# emphasize

- v. to give or show particular importance to something synonym: highlight, accentuate, stress
- (1) **emphasize** her words, (2) **emphasize** a direct relationship

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Use italics or capitals to **emphasize** a word in a piece of writing.

#### survivor

a person who remains alive after an event in which others have died

synonym: subsister

(1) ovarian cancer **survivor**, (2) a single **survivor**The shipwreck **survivor** was rescued after floating in the ocean for three days.

### guilt

 the fact of having committed something illegal; the negative feelings caused by believing or knowing that you have done something wrong

synonym: regret, remorse, blame

(1) criminal guilt, (2) feeling of guilt

Shame and **guilt** have significant social influences.

# anticipate

v. to expect or predict that something will happen; to tell in advance

*synonym*: forecast, predict, expect

(1) **anticipate** your kind cooperation, (2) **anticipate** a black future

We anticipate heavy snowfall tomorrow.

# overnight

adj. lasting for or occurring during one night; occurring or changing extremely quickly or suddenly; happening or being achieved in a short amount of time

synonym: all-night, sudden, immediate

(1) overnight parking, (2) overnight success

The **overnight** package delivery arrived at my door this morning.

#### viral

adj. relating to or caused by a virus

(1) fight viral infections, (2) detect a viral code

This device can more accurately detect viral pathogens.

### grab

to take hold of something or someone suddenly with a hand, especially in a violent way

synonym: clutch, snatch, grasp

(1) grab an audience, (2) grab an opportunity

Shall we **grab** a bite to eat?

#### crotch

the part of the body between the legs where they join the torso, including the area around the genitals

synonym: groin, loin, genitals

(1) **crotch** portion, (2) **crotch** of trousers

She kicked him hard in the crotch.

#### mess

a state of confusion, dirtiness, or untidiness; (verb) to fail to do something or to make something dirty or untidy

synonym: disarray, confusion, predicament

(1) have a whole **mess**, (2) get into a **mess** 

He made a frightful **mess** in his room.

### contribution

the act of giving something, especially money, to a n. particular cause or organization; a voluntary gift as of money or service or ideas made to some worthwhile cause

synonym: donation, gift, offering

(1) make a positive **contribution**, (2) **contribution** to society

His **contribution** to the charity was a generous donation of money.

to harass, bother, or annoy someone, often sexually; to touch or handle someone in an unwelcome or inappropriate way

synonym: harass, harm, abuse

(1) **molest** a woman on a train, (2) sexually **molest** his stepchild

The organization campaigns for stricter penalties for those who molest children.

#### molest

### empower

- v. to give someone the power or authority to do something synonym: authorize, endow, entitle
- (1) **empower** my life, (2) **empower** the secretary to do the same

The company **empowered** employees to buy low-price items without approval to achieve efficient purchasing.

#### victim

 a person who has been harmed, injured, or otherwise negatively affected by a particular action, circumstance, or event

synonym: prey, target, sufferer

(1) **victim** support, (2) **victim** compensation

The **victim** of the crime deserves justice and support to recover from the trauma.

# inspire

- v. to make somebody fill with the desire, confidence, or enthusiasm, especially to do something creative
   synonym: boost, encourage, enlighten
- (1) **inspire** a feeling of curiosity, (2) **inspire** him to write a novel

The unique style of this martial arts **inspired** many action film producers.

#### tweet

- a short, high sound made by a small bird; a message sent using Twitter, the social media application
- synonym: peep, chirp, post (on Twitter)
- (1) a chick's **tweet**, (2) his latest **tweets** We could hear the **tweet** of baby birds.

#### nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

(1) nation-state, (2) a seafaring nation

The **nation** of Japan is known for its unique culture and advanced technology.

#### translate

- v. to convert or change words into another language synonym: convert, transcribe, render
- (1) **translate** a document into English, (2) **translate** the emotion to a movement

**Translate** the text from Italian into English.

#### strike

- v. to wallop somebody or something with the hand, fist, or weapon; to have an emotional or cognitive impact upon synonym: hit, impact, influence
- (1) strike up a conversation, (2) strike a blow We strike to achieve more wages and safer working conditions.

#### attract

- v. to draw or entice someone or something towards them through the qualities they have, especially positive ones synonym: lure, entice, draw in
- (1) attract attention, (2) attract customers

The government is eager to **attract** international investment.

#### assume

v. to think or accept something to be true without having proof of it; to take or begin to have power; to begin to exhibit a specific quality or appearance

synonym: guess, presume, suppose

(1) **assume** a lousy attitude to his boss, (2) **assume** an important role

The following example **assumes** that the capacity of each battery is the same.

#### frame

- a strong border or structure of the wood, metal, etc. that surrounds something such as a picture, door, or window synonym: body, skeleton, scaffolding
- (1) a picture frame,(2) the frame of the policyThe detective looked for fingerprints on the window frame.

#### firsthand

adv. from the source; directly; (adjective) received directly from a source

synonym: direct

(1) hear customer's voices **firsthand**, (2) conduct **firsthand** research

The manager tried to hear customers' voices firsthand.

#### affected

adj. influenced; feeling or showing emotion, especially exaggerated emotion; not natural or sinceresynonym: artificial, pretentious, stilted

(1) **affected** way of walking, (2) the **affected** part Her **affected** accent made it difficult to take her seriously.

# platform

n. the raised flat space close to the track at a train station where passengers get on or off the train; (technology) a computational or digital environment in which a piece of software is executed

synonym: stage, podium, forum

(1) an arrival **platform**, (2) a digital **platform** for enterprise The speaker mounted the **platform** and started to speak.

#### reassurance

- n. the act of giving advice or help to make someone feel less worried; the act of giving someone confidencesynonym: encouragement, comfort, support
- (1) give **reassurance**, (2) **reassurance** of my commitment He needed **reassurance** that everything would be alright.

# blame

- v. to think or say that someone or something did something wrong or is responsible for something badsynonym: condemn, rebuke, find fault with

#### discuss

 to talk about or examine in detail through conversation or debate; to exchange ideas, opinions, or information on a particular topic

synonym: talk about, converse, debate

# meeting tomorrow.

# stigma

 a mark of shame or disgrace associated with a particular circumstance, quality, or person

synonym: mark, blemish, disgrace

(1) social **stigma**, (2) **stigma** against obesity

The mental health **stigma** often prevents people from seeking treatment.

#### forefront

 the leading or most important position or place; the forefront of a movement or cause

synonym: vanguard, lead, front line

(1) **forefront** technology, (2) the **forefront** of an air mass Education is at the **forefront** of our society's priorities for ensuring a better future.

# journalist

 a person who collects and writes news stories or articles for newspapers, magazines, radio, television, or other online media

synonym: reporter, newsperson, press

(1) a China-based **journalist**, (2) **journalist** on a magazine Foreign TV crews and **journalists** can go as they please in various locations during the Olympics.

#### commentator

a person who provides commentary or analysis,
 particularly about a specific event, topic, or field, such as sports, news, or politics

*synonym*: announcer, analyst, presenter

(1) television **commentator**, (2) political **commentator** The sports **commentator** provided detailed analysis throughout the game.

# incredibly

adv. in a way that is very difficult to believe; exceedingly or extremely

*synonym*: enormously, exceptionally, extraordinarily

(1) **incredibly** cheerful character, (2) get **incredibly** insecure

Several cities are experiencing **incredibly** high unemployment rates.

#### interconnect

v. to connect similar things

*synonym*: interlink, complect, annex

(1) directly **interconnect** with those systems, (2) human activities **interconnect** with the environment

# proliferation

 a rapid or uncontrolled increase in the number or amount of something; the process of growing, producing, or spreading rapidly and excessively

synonym: spread, expansion, increase
