fetus

- an unborn or unhatched animal in the later stages of development showing the main recognizable features of the mature animal
- (1) development of the **fetus**, (2) an aborted **fetus**The female vagina is elastic enough to allow the passage of a **fetus**.

disguise

 to hide or alter someone's appearance to deceive or mislead others

synonym: mask, misinterpret, cloak

(1) **disguise** my feelings, (2) **disguise** his voice Later it turned out that the politician **disguised** the fact from the public.

fluctuate

 to rise and fall irregularly or unexpectedly; to vary or change often and unpredictably

synonym: vary, oscillate, sway

(1) **fluctuate** prices, (2) **fluctuate** rapidly Stock prices **fluctuate** daily based on market demand and supply.

disrupt

to prevent or stop something, especially an event, activity, or process, from continuing in the usual way by

causing a problem or disturbance

synonym: interrupt, disturb, break into

(1) **disrupt** a well-ordered condition, (2) **disrupt** sleep I'm so sorry to **disrupt** you when you're pretty busy.

synonymous

adj. having the same or a similar meaning as another word or phrase

synonym: equivalent, interchangeable, similar

(1) **synonymous** terms, (2) non-**synonymous** mutation The phrase "big shot" and "important person" are **synonymous**.

ovary

- n. either of the pair of organs in the female reproductive system that produces eggs; (of a plant) the organ that bears the ovules of a flower

uterus

 a hollow muscular organ in the body of a woman or other female mammal in which a baby or young animal develops before birth

policymaker

disservice

 an action that causes harm or damage; something that is detrimental or disadvantageous; the opposite of a favor

synonym: injury, harm, disadvantage

pediatrics

 the branch of medicine that deals with the care and treatment of children

synonym: pedology, child health

atypical

determinant

 a factor, circumstance, or condition that contributes to the shaping, influencing, or determining of a particular outcome or result

synonym: cause, factor, element

aspirin

- *n.* a drug used to reduce pain, fever, and inflammation

lifesaving

- the act or process of rescuing someone else's life, especially from drowning
