### shrimp

### absolutely

adv. without restriction or limitation; completely or utterly synonym: completely, utterly, definitely

### fascinating

adj. extremely interesting synonym: alluring, intriguing, captivating

### struggle

to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

(1) **struggle** against discrimination, (2) **struggle** to get the job

He could not **struggle** against temptation.

### appendage

a part attached to the main body or structure, often with n. a specific function or purpose; a limb or other body part that projects outward from the main body

synonym: extension, limb, attachment

- to make a request or petition to a higher power, especially in the form of a respectful or humble request

fee

extreme

- adj. very great in amount or degreesynonym: farthermost, outermost, fierce

synonym: affiliation, alliance, coalition

### spear

n. a weapon with a long shaft and a sharp metal point used for battle, hunting, and fishing in the past

synonym: javelin, pike, lance

### smashing

adj. very successful or impressive; causing something to be broken or destroyed

#### sand

#### overhead

#### frame

### spectacular

adj. striking or impressive to look at or in performance or achievement

synonym: breathtaking, impressive, grand

#### extension

n. a thing that is added to something to make it longer, larger, or wider; an educational opportunity provided by colleges and universities to people who are not enrolled as regular students; an additional telephone set that is connected to the same telephone line

synonym: addition, augment, supplement

(1) time **extension**, (2) telephone **extension**They are building an **extension** to the house to add more bedrooms.

### limb

- n. an arm and leg of a person or animal synonym: arm, appendage, branch

### explode

v. to burst or break open violently and noisily; to cause something to burst or break open

### upward

whack

stab

 someone who is morally reprehensible; (verb) to follow someone or something

### moving

adj. causing strong emotions or feelings, especially sadness or sympathy

synonym: emotional, poignant, touching

(1) **moving** experience, (2) **moving** ceremony His **moving** speech about his struggles with addiction brought tears to the audience's eyes.

#### darn

v. to mend a piece of clothing by sewing over a hole or tear with small, tight stitches

synonym: mend, repair, patch

### immediately

adv. now or without delay

synonym: directly, instantly, promptly

(1) **immediately** recall a product, (2) write him an answer **immediately**

### biology

- the scientific study of life and the natural processes of living things
- (1) evolutionary **biology**, (2) cell and molecular **biology** In junior high school, we had to dissect a frog in **biology** class.

### depart

- v. to go away or leave, especially to start a journey synonym: go away, leave, vacate
- (1) arrive and **depart** on time, (2) **depart** from the faith We **departed** before the temperature fell below zero.

#### movement

*n.* a group of people working together to achieve a shared goal, especially a political, social, or artistic one; the

process of moving or being moved, physically or figuratively

synonym: motion, progression, action

(1) a circular **movement**, (2) **movement** of troops

The **movement** of the dancers on stage was graceful and elegant.

### capture

 to catch a person or an animal and confine them in an area which they cannot escape

synonym: catch, arrest, imprison

### stymie

 to obstruct, hinder, or prevent something from succeeding or happening; to present an obstacle or impediment to progress or achievement

synonym: hinder, obstruct, impede

The new regulations will **stymie** the growth of small businesses in the area.

#### crew

 a group of people who work together, especially on a ship or airplane

synonym: team, group, squad

#### cruise

 a voyage on a large ship for pleasure; driving or traveling at a leisurely pace

synonym: sail, voyage, journey

(1) the **cruise** line, (2) adaptive **cruise** control

The family took a **cruise** to the Caribbean for their vacation.

#### incredible

adj. unbelievable; enormous

synonym: unbelievable, fantastical, inconceivable

(1) **incredible** amount, (2) at **incredible** speed Her response revealed **incredible** idiocy.

critic

 someone who expresses opinions about the quality of books, music, etc.

synonym: pundit, analyst, attacker

(1) art critic, (2) severe critic

Advocates for legal reform hear less harsh words from their **critics**.

fry

- v. to cook food, especially meat or fish, in hot fat or oil synonym: cook, roast, bake
- (1) fry an egg, (2) fry over low heat

She devoted herself to **frying** the chicken in a pan until it was crispy and golden brown.

stick

v. to put something, usually a sharp object, into something; to restrict yourself to doing or using one certain thing and not change; (noun) a thin piece of wood or other material

synonym: pierce, adhere, stay

activism

 the policy or action of using vigorous campaigning to bring about political or social change

synonym: advocacy, campaign

incredibly

adv. in a way that is very difficult to believe; exceedingly or extremely

synonym: enormously, exceptionally, extraordinarily

(1) incredibly cheerful character, (2) get incredibly

insecure

Several cities are experiencing **incredibly** high unemployment rates.

#### extend

- v. to broaden in scope, range, or area synonym: prolong, lengthen, advance
- (1) **extend** the warranty, (2) **extend** a line Her visit will **extend** from Monday to Friday.

#### flex

v. to show off one's strength, power, or possessions; to bend or be capable of bending easily

synonym: bend, stretch, extend

### backward

adv. at, to, or toward the direction or place that is behind or rear

*synonym*: back, rearward, in reverse

#### measured

adj. done with careful consideration or calculated precision;
 controlled or regulated in manner or speech; deliberate
 and thoughtful

synonym: calculated, deliberate, thought-out

(1) measured analysis, (2) measured tone of voice

Her **measured** response to the criticism showed her ability to remain calm and composed under pressure.

#### calculated

 adj. done with careful thought or planning; deliberate and intentional; based on a process of reasoning or estimation rather than on instinct or chance

synonym: premeditated, willful, deliberate

#### peak

meter

 the point to which something or someone is at its strongest, best, or most successful; the pointed top of a mountain

synonym: summit, vertex, apex

- n. a device used to measure the amount of a particular substance or attribute, such as length, volume, or time; (prosody) the accent in a metrical foot of verse

*synonym*: gauge, indicator, rhythm

### prefer

 a part of a machine, or a set of parts that performs a task; a natural or established process that occurs during a specific situation or reaction

#### consist

v. to be composed or made up of

synonym: lie in, comprise, exist

(1) **consist** mainly of cells, (2) **consist** only in knowing facts This examination **consists** of five problems to solve.

#### contract

 a legally binding agreement between two or more parties, setting out their rights and obligations to each other, typically in writing and enforceable by law

synonym: agreement, deal, arrangement

(1) employment **contract**, (2) **contract** law

The company signed a **contract** with the supplier for the delivery of goods.

#### latch

 a device for holding a door or gate closed, typically a sliding bar or bolt

synonym: lock, catch, bolt

### amplification

 the process of increasing the volume or intensity of something; the expansion or elaboration of a concept or idea

synonym: enlargement, expansion, intensification

#### nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

### backstage

adj. relating to or situated in the area behind the stage of a theater, concert, or other performance venues; relating to the private or hidden aspects of something, such as politics, business, or personal life

### preserve

v. to keep or maintain a particular quality, feature, etc., especially to prevent it from decaying, being damaged, or being destroyed

synonym: conserve, care for, maintain

#### saddle

- n. a seat for a rider on the back of a horse or other animal;(verb) to burden someone with responsibility or tasksynonym: seat, perch, mount

#### structure

 the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts

#### surround

- v. to be all around something or somebody synonym: encircle, encompass, envelop

#### membranous

- adj. resembling or relating to a membrane (= a thin, flexible layer); having a thin, flexible, or delicate structuresynonym: film-like, thin, diaphanous

### dynamic

adj. having a lot of energy, ideas, and enthusiasm, and a strong personality; of or relating to dynamics (= the branch of physics and engineering concerned with the forces that cause motions of bodies)

synonym: energetic, active, vital

#### flexible

adj. able to change or be changed to suit new conditions or situations; able to bend easily

synonym: adaptable, elastic, pliable

### scratch

v. to cut or damage the surface of something or the skin with a sharp or pointed object

synonym: claw, rub, scrape

#### calculation

 the act or process of using numbers to judge an amount of something synonym: analysis, computation, estimate

(1) make a **calculation**, (2) **calculation** of loss and gain The error in the **calculation** was attributable to rounding.

#### observe

v. to watch or notice something carefully, often to gather information or insights; to take note of something or someone; to celebrate or commemorate a special event or occasion

synonym: watch, monitor, scrutinize

observe a tradition, (2) observe wildlife
 is important to observe safety procedures in the workplace to prevent accidents.

### visualize

v. to form a mental image or concept of something; to make something visible

*synonym*: imagine, picture, envision

(1) **visualize** data, (2) **visualize** flying through space She tried to **visualize** the layout of the new house in her mind.

### compress

 to press or squeeze together to make something take up less space

synonym: condense, constrict, squeeze

(1) **compress** the chest, (2) **compress** gas

She **compressed** the files into a single ZIP archive to save space on her computer.

#### outline

 to describe the main facts or aspects involved in something

synonym: recap, summarize, digest

(1) outlined the plan, (2) outline the findingsThis page outlines our response planning for an emergency.

#### solid

adj. hard or firm; characterized by good substantial quality synonym: stable, reliable, hard

(1) **solid** ally, (2) **solid** employment measures

#### **function**

n. the purpose or use of an object, system, or process; a particular activity or operation that is designed to serve a specific purpose; a mathematical concept that describes a relationship between two sets of values, called the input and output sets; (verb) to operate or work in a specific way, or to perform a particular task or purpose

synonym: purpose, mapping, job

### (1) function properly, (2) immune function

The brain is an incredibly complex organ that controls the body's **function**.

### hyperbola

n. a type of geometric curve, similar to an ellipse, but with two separate and distinct branches that approach infinity; (of mathematics) the curve defined by the difference of the distances from any point on the curve to two fixed points called the foci

synonym: curve, ellipse, parabola

### (1) hyperbola equation, (2) geometric hyperbola

The astrophysicist analyzed the light spectrum emitted from the **hyperbola** nucleus of the distant galaxy.

### parabola

a symmetrical curve formed by the intersection of a cone with a plane parallel to its side; (of mathematics) a curve described by a quadratic equation (a type of polynomial equation of the second degree denoted as ax^2 + bx + c = 0)

synonym: curve, arch

### (1) parabola shape, (2) parabola equation

The trajectory of the cannonball followed a **parabola** in the air.

#### anticlastic

adj. relating to a curvature or surface that curves in opposite directions at different points, creating a saddle-like shape; characterized by a convex surface in one direction and a concave surface in the other

synonym: curved, convex, concave

The sculpture showcased intricate **anticlastic** curves that created a unique visual effect.

### engineer

 a person whose job is designing, building, or maintaining something such as machines, structures, or software

synonym: architect, creator, builder

#### architect

 a person whose job is to design plans to be used in making something, such as buildings

synonym: creator, designer, planner

(1) landscape **architect**, (2) **architect** of the peace accord The building **architect** tried to build the house above the tree.

### compression

the act or process of pressing or squeezing something together, often using force or pressure; (of physics) the reduction of volume or increase in pressure of a gas or fluid

synonym: condensation, squeezing, pressing

(1) **compression** garment, (2) data **compression**The doctor recommended a **compression** bandage to reduce swelling in the injured area.

#### curve

 a bend or angle in a line or surface that deviates from a straight or flat path; a gradual or smooth change in direction or shape

synonym: bend, arc, turn

(1) learning curve, (2) yield curve

The **curve** in the road was so sharp that I had to slow down to navigate it safely.

### opposition

 the act of disagreeing or resisting; the state of strong disagreement

synonym: resistance, hostility, antagonism

(1) opposition campaign, (2) meet with opposition

The **opposition** party strongly disagreed with the government's proposed legislation.

#### transverse

adj. lying or extending across something or from side to side synonym: crosswise, perpendicular, lateral

(1) **transverse** section, (2) **transverse** wave

The **transverse** beam provided additional support for the structure.

### perturbation

- n. a state of anxiety, confusion, or disturbance; a deviation or disruption from the normal or expected state
   synonym: disruption, disturbance, turmoil
- (1) seismic **perturbation**, (2) emotional **perturbation**The unexpected financial crisis caused a **perturbation** in the stock market, leading to widespread panic among investors.

### **jewelry**

n. decorative ornaments made of precious metals, gemstones, or other materials, worn as personal adornment, which can include items such as necklaces, bracelets, rings, earrings, and brooches

synonym: accessories, ornaments, adornments

### popularize

to make something more widely known, accepted, or adopted by the general public; to present or promote something in a way that increases its popularity or appeal

synonym: generalize, promote, spread

The celebrity's endorsement helped **popularize** the new clothing line.

### span

 the entire length of something, such as time or space from beginning to end; the amount of space that

### something covers

synonym: interval, period, length

(1) the **span** of a bird's wings, (2) the average life **span**He slightly modified the **span** of training because it was just before a match.

### principle

 a fundamental law or truth that explains or controls how something happens or works

synonym: rule, creed, code

(1) **principle** of treatment, (2) **principle** in business Efficiency isn't an essential **principle** here; fairness is.

### requirement

n. something that is needed or wanted

synonym: prerequisite, provision, condition

(1) meet **requirement**, (2) school **requirement** What is the entry **requirement** for this course?

### parallel

 adj. being everywhere equidistant and not intersecting; of or relating to the simultaneous performance of multiple operations

synonym: aligned, side-by-side, similar

(1) a **parallel** case, (2) **parallel** processing He walked a road **parallel** to the railroad.

### piezoelectric

adj. relating to or utilizing the property of certain materials that generate an electric charge when subjected to mechanical stress caused by the rearrangement of the material's atoms or molecules, which creates an imbalance in electrical charge and leads to the generation of an electric voltage or current

synonym: vibratory, electrically responsive, crystal-controlled

(1) **piezoelectric** material, (2) **piezoelectric** sensor The **piezoelectric** crystals generate electricity when pressure is applied to them.

crystal

 a solid material with many even sides that is formed naturally when the substance becomes solid and has a highly regular atomic structure; clear and colorless glass made of almost pure silica

### squeeze

v. to apply pressure from two or more sides; to hold someone or something tightly in your arms, usually with fondness

#### electrical

adj. relating to electricity

### proportion

 a part, share, or amount of something considered in comparative relation to a whole

synonym: ratio, balance, consonance

(1) direct **proportion**, (2) a building of vast **proportions**He is more concerned about the **proportion** of his body fat than usual because of an upcoming bodybuilding competition.

### aggressive

adj. behaving in an angry, energetic, or threatening way towards another person; tending to spread quickly

*synonym*: assertive, combative, threatening

(1) an **aggressive** war, (2) an **aggressive** tumor An **aggressive** tide wrecked the ship.

#### pasty

 a type of baked pastry that typically consists of a filling of meat, vegetables, or other ingredients, enclosed in a pastry shell; (adjective) pale, lacking in color, or dull

synonym: pastry, pie

(1) pasty face, (2) Cornish pasty

I plan to pick up a chicken **pasty** at that bakery on my way home from work.

#### measurement
